Here below is a list of Baronial Champion Duties

Know all who hear these words that Seelos and Elena, Baron and Baroness of the Grand Barony of Atenveldt will soon host many and varied competitions to choose new Champions suitable for the Barony. Let it be known that Peers of the Chivalry, the Laurels and the Pelicans are welcome to enter these competitions and are encouraged to enter with intent to become our Baronial Champion. Herein lists the duties of said Champions.

ALL SHOULD:- Know basic heraldry such as colors, basic shapes, one's personal heraldry, and those used by the Barony and Kingdom of Atenveldt.- Be a paid member of the Society.- Enjoy the grand show that is Court and have a desire to make it more fun for everyone.- Be prepared to help plan, organize and host the next Baronial Champions event.

Arts and Sciences Champion:-

Regularly represent the Barony of Atenveldt in competitions. This does not mean the champion must enter EVERY available competition, but that they should set an example for the populace with regular activity in the Arts and Sciences. It is expected that the champion enter a minimum of 2 competitions outside of the Barony of Atenveldt.- Create an item of Baronial Regalia during their term of service. The champion will consult with Their Excellencies to determine what items are needed, taking into account the talents and temperament of the champion.- Teach classes in the Arts and Sciences in their area(s) of expertise. It is expected that a minimum of 2 Baronial Level classes will be taught at an A&S collegium.- Advise Their Excellencies on matters relating to the Arts and Sciences and seek ways to advance the Arts and Sciences in the Barony.- Promote Activity in the Arts and Sciences within the Barony of Atenveldt by encouraging and inspiring the artisans and potential artisans to participate in the available competitions, classes, and other events.

Rapier Champions:-

Stand court at Baronial events (Spring, Fall, Anniversary, and also Yule if possible). If the champion is attending an event where the Baron and Baroness are also in attendance, be prepared to stand with them during courts.- Expected to enter a minimum of 2 tournaments outside of the borders of the Barony as the representative of the Barony of Atenveldt . These may be Kingdom or Baronial level, preferably smaller tournaments in other Baronies, as well as King's Champion, Queen's Champion, or Crown Tournament.- Will plan and coordinate bi-monthly tourneys at the Wednesday night fighter practice. The tourneys will alternate between Rapier and Hardsuit and will fall on the last Wednesday of the month. Will boldly and often wear the colors and regalia of the position, attend courts whenever possible, and meet challenges as needed.

Hardsuit Champions:-

Stand court at Baronial events (Spring, Fall, Anniversary, and also Yule if possible). If the champion is attending an event where the Baron and Baroness are also in attendance, be prepared to stand with them during courts.- Expected to enter a minimum of 2 tournaments outside of the borders of the Barony as the representative of the Barony of Atenveldt . These may be Kingdom or Baronial level, preferably smaller tournaments in other Baronies, as well as King's Champion, Queen's Champion, or Crown Tournament.- Will plan and coordinate bi-monthly tourneys at the Wednesday night fighter practice. The tourneys will alternate between Rapier and Hardsuit and will fall on the last Wednesday of the

month.- Will boldly and often wear the colors and regalia of the position, attend courts whenever possible, and meet challenges as needed.

Archery Champion:-

Will submit a minimum of 1 IKAC each quarter, and will encourage others to do the same.- Attend regular Baronial archery practice a minimum of once per month.- Will advertise and lead a minimum of 2 introduction classes about “How to get started in Archery in our Barony” at Wednesday fighter practices.- Organize and plan a minimum of one archery competition at a Baronial event during their tenure.- Will boldly and often wear the colors and regalia of the position, attend courts whenever possible, and meet challenges as needed.

Bardic Champion:-

Regularly represent the Barony of Atenveldt in competitions. This does not mean the champion must enter EVERY available competition, but that they should set an example for the populace with regular activity in the Bardic Arts It is expected that the champion enter a minimum of 1 competitions outside of the Barony of Atenveldt.- Create one items of Baronial Regalia during their term of service. The champion will consult with Their Excellencies to determine what items are needed, taking into account the talents and temperament of the champion.- Teach classes in the Bardic Arts in their area(s) of expertise. It is expected that a minimum of 1 Baronial Level classes will be taught at an A&S collegium or the College of Atenveldt at Fighter Practice.- Advise Their Excellencies on matters relating to the Bardic Arts and seek ways to advance the Bardic Arts in the Barony.- Promote Activity in the Bardic Arts within the Barony of Atenveldt by encouraging and inspiring the artisans and potential artisans to participate in the available competitions, classes, and other events.

Thrown Weapons Champion:-

Attend regular Baronial Thrown Weapons practice a minimum of once per month.- Will advertise and lead a minimum of 2 introduction classes about “How to get started in Thrown Weapons in our Barony” at Wednesday fighter practices.- Organize and plan a minimum of one Thrown Weapons tournament during their tenure.- Will boldly and often wear the colors and regalia of the position, attend courts whenever possible, and meet challenges as needed.-Create one item of Baronial Regalia during their term of service. The champion will consult with Their Excellencies to determine what items are needed, taking into account the talents and temperament of the champion.

Youth Champions:-

May stand court at Baronial events. If the champion is attending an event where the Baron and Baroness are also in attendance, may stand with them during courts.- Expected to enter a minimum of 1 tournaments outside of the borders of the Barony as the representative of the Barony of Atenveldt . These may be Kingdom or Baronial level, preferably smaller tournaments in other Baronies.- Will boldly and often wear the colors and regalia of the position, attend courts whenever possible, and meet challenges as needed.
