# BARONIAL WANT ADS



## *Seneschal (Open Until January 1)*

The Barony of Atenveldt is accepting applications for the position of Seneschal. The term of office will begin in January 2009 and a 2 year duration is requested. This is a warranted office and is one of the mandatory offices for a Barony to sustain group status. Interested parties should contact myself for more details of the office and should submit letter of intent to perform the duties to by myself and their Excellencies.

Specific duties of the Seneschal include:

- Legal representative of the SCA at the Baronial level and is responsible for oversight on the day to day operations of the Barony and its officers
- Coordinates and signs all contracts for the Barony including practice field allocations, storage locker rental, and event site rentals
- Must work closely with the Baron and Baroness as their ceremonial functions have substantial overlap with the business functions of the SCA
- Collects reports from all the officers in the group and submits a consolidated report to the Kingdom Seneschal on a monthly basis as well as the yearly "Doomsday" report
- Member of the group financial committee and is responsible for the proper operation of the financial committee per SCA guidelines
- Reviews and certifies the quarterly and annual reports from the Exchequer prior to their submittal to the Kingdom Exchequer
- Coordinate with their Excellencies the event schedules for the coming year for discussion and coordination at the annual Kingdom Event Calendar Meeting
- Maintain open communication with the populace to ensure harmonious interactions among the membership and minimize the extent of the inevitable disagreements when they do occur

## *Knight Marshal (Open Until January 1)*

Greetings to all,

I am Lord Heinrich von Swartzenberg, the Baronial Knight Marshal. My warrant is coming due in a few months and I may be leaving this fair Barony and Kingdom. Thus, Their Excellencies need to find a replacement for me. Please read the below information and if you are interested in this position, please send a letter to Their Excellencies and the Seneschal as well as to me with your qualifications.

This position entails several responsibilities as follows. The Baronial Knight Marshal is responsible for the safety and authorization of all martial aspects of the Barony. The KM will follow direction from both the Kingdom Earl Marshal and the B&B of the Barony in regards to this. The KM will be present at the weekly Fighter Practices, and any weekend events sponsored by the Barony. If the KM cannot be in attendance, it is their responsibility to ensure that one of their deputies is present. Each month, the KM will provide a written report to the Earl Marshal, the B&B of Atenveldt, and the Baronial Seneschal. This report will include details of the weekly fighter practices, additional events that occurred that month, and any additional information that needs to be passed onto the Earl Marshal and Seneschal such as injuries and new authorizations. This report should also include the sub-reports of the Rapier, Archery, and Youth combat marshals. The KM is responsible for making sure these reports are received and entered into the final report.

The KM is responsible to authorize all new fighters, inspect armor and weapons to ensure they conform to the SCA minimum standards and the Atenveldt addendums, and ensure a safe fighting area for the fighters. The KM is responsible for knowing, understanding and enforcing armor and weapon requirements and ensuring that all fighters participate safely.

## *Keeper of the Ropes (Open Until Filled)*

One of the requirements for use of Encanto Park is the erection of barricades to keep spectators from wandering into the practice field. This has traditionally been accomplished through use of the Barony's 4' stakes and ropes.

The previous volunteer that transported, erected, and took down these items for the hardsuit eric is no longer available to perform this task. The Barony is in need of an individual or group to take up the reigns and fill this position. Without the barricades in place there will be no practice.





The equipment is stored relatively close to the park at Dascha's house and continued storage there MAY be an option but she is unable to transport them. Individuals interested in assisting the Barony should contact their Excellencies or the Seneschal.

## *Regalia Officer (Open Until Filled)*

The Regalia Officer is responsible for the storage, transportation, and upkeep of the regalia and trailers. The Regalia Officer is also encouraged to recruit any deputies that may be needed. The position does involve some heavy lifting and moving. Interested individuals should have a vehicle available to them that can haul the trailer to events. The trailer has brakes installed and requires a brake controller in the vehicle pulling it.

The Regalia Officer reports to the Kingdom Regalia Office, as well as the Baronial Exchequer and Seneschal. All interested parties should submit a letter of intent to Their Excellencies and the Baronial Seneschal.

I will be available as a deputy officer for coaching and assistance until the end of this next Estrella War.



Greetings to all Fighters:

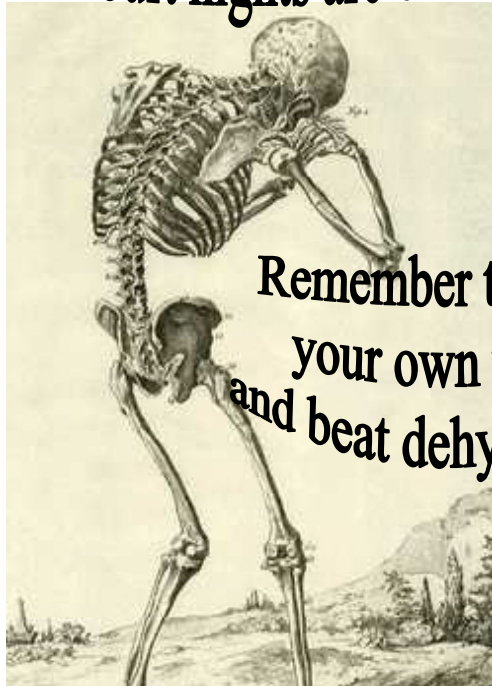

# *SCA Myths & Absurdities*

## Holidays from fact:

- ★ **Halloween was the day that pagans took revenge, so the Church outlawed it.**

??? Halloween, hallow'evn, is a contraction for "All Hallow's Eve", meaning the day before the Feast of All Saints. The idea that all the evil stuff might come out the night before the day celebrating all those who are Holy makes superstitious sense, especially if you can have some fun with it.

In period, the folks who to have had real fun with All Hallows Eve were the Gaels, especially the Irish. Some festival activities of the day were derived from pre-Christian customs, but were in no way "Pagan revenge" as paganism was wiped out in Gaelic lands quite early. Halloween as it is celebrated today in the U.S. is a purely American custom, partially inspired by Irish immigrants. The Church has never outlawed Halloween, though the clergy have been known to speak out against violence, animal cruelty and vandalism perpetrated on that night.

- ★ **The Carol "Twelve Days of Christmas" is a learning device invented for Catholic children during their persecution in England.**

This one is false. See: <http://www.snopes.com/holidays/christmas/12days.asp> Though the intensity of the persecution of Catholics in England varied, it was very real. It was also official policy. During and long after the Henry's break from Rome, attending mass was a crime. Priests and some Catholic laity were hunted down, tortured and either "executed" or murdered on the spot. (The reason for all those "priest holes" in English manor houses. Catholic persecution after the Oath of Supremacy came in waves, but a general anti-Catholic attitude remained and exists in the British Constitution in the present.

Mnemonic learning devices have been in constant use in Catholic education for millennia, and music was/is often used. As Snopes confirms, the 12 Days of Christmas wasn't among them. It is simply a secular Christmas season entertainment.

- ★ **The Church outlawed Christmas in period –or- Christmas wasn't celebrated in period.**

Actually, the outlawing was the work of Lord Cromwell. That homicidal scumbag was seriously NOT Catholic and did his damage in the century after SCA period. Catholics love Christmas and have celebrated it joyously for 17 centuries or so.

Period Christmas celebrations usually kept the celebration purely religious on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. The partying was done after the first day and reached its peak at Twelfth Night (January 6, the Feast of the Epiphany and the final day of Christ's Mass.) - ★ **Medieval people really celebrated Yule/Winter Solstice instead of Christmas.**

As educated Christians today are aware, the celebration of the birth of Christ was arbitrarily set at this time because the true date of Christ's birth is unknown. They were also aware that their pagan forbears had celebrated the Winter Solstice at around the same time of the year and that the "Yule log" was originally a pagan custom.



Many pre-Christian customs lived on as secular and cultural customs. In spite of the fact that some clerics got their tonsures in a knot over them, these were not intended as pagan religious observances. See: <http://www.newadvent.org/cathen/03724b.htm> This is another version of the ludicrous notion that medieval Christians were some kind of pagan “Conversos”.

## More Brass Hats

I suspect that this one stems from a recent change in Kingdom Law regarding Territorial Barons. One set of the latter who have Elizabethan personae did not wear their coronets much of the time. Some interpreted this as willful disrespect for the Crown, and so Kingdom Law now requires reigning Landed Barons to wear their coronets at all times during events. There is no such requirement for Court Barons or Thegns.

- ★ **Barons and royal peers who don’t wear coronets do it so they can play “gotcha” when someone fails to bow to them or call them by the right title –or- Royal peers who don’t wear their coronets are doing it so everybody will say how humble they are.**

These are true as applied to a tiny minority. For the rest, the reasons for not wearing a coronet are myriad:

1. My coronet doesn’t go with or fit over my hat.
2. It’s heavy and gives me a headache
3. I just don’t feel like it today.
4. Oops, I left it on: the kitchen table, the bust of Lincoln, a towel hook, the toilet tank, my needlework frame, Denny’s check stand, Chirurgeon’s point, Catherine’s basket, Casca’s pickup, Nootka’s golf cart, etc., etc., etc.
5. Kristoff ran over it with his golf cart and it now looks like a piece of modern art.
6. I grabbed my spouses’ coronet by mistake and it doesn’t fit.
7. I’m divorcing the jerk and won’t be seen wearing a coronet that matches his.
8. My shaman says malachite is bad for my aura. I need to get a new coronet.
9. All these people bow and scrape when they see my coronet — I’m not the Queen and it makes me uncomfortable.
10. Last time I wore it I ran into a tent pole and had to have stitches. (True of a very special Aten Duchess)
11. I lost it at Pennsic.
12. It isn’t period (or modern) practice to wear a coronet except for state occasions. (TRUE)

*Personal Note: I wear my coronet most of the time, for a number of reasons:*

1. My husband really wants me to.
2. It goes well with my veilings and helps keep them in place. (Hint—A non-metal circlet is allowed to any lady and does the same thing.)
3. Many newer members say they are much more comfortable when coronet holders wear their coronets. It helps them figure out who’s who.
4. Quite honestly, I also like the way it looks.

Kingdom curfew for minors will be observed. Site is wet, no glass containers, please. Pets are welcome, must be on leash and you must clean up after them. Fire pits must be 12 inches off the ground and have some kind of protector under them.

**Saturday night Pot Luck:** The Barony of Atenveldt will provide a well cooked beast (the meat) for the populace. We request you bring a dish that will feed 6-8 people. The first initial of your mundane last name should determine your offering: A-H Salads; I-P Other Side Dishes (non-salad); Q-Z Desert. 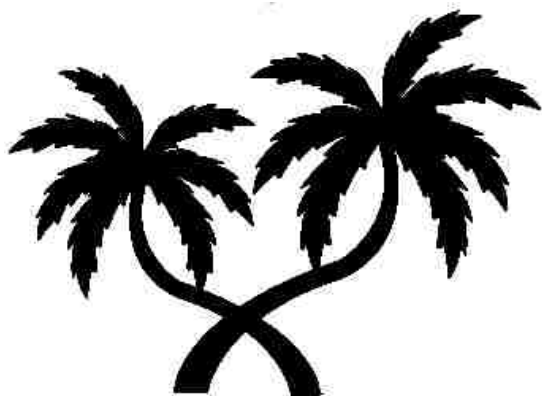

Herein lists the duties of said Champions.

### **ALL SHOULD:**

- ★ Know basic heraldry such as colors, basic shapes, one's personal heraldry, and those used by the Barony and Kingdom of Atenveldt.
- ★ Be a paid member of the Society.
- ★ Enjoy the grand show that is Court and have a desire to make it more fun for everyone.
- ★ Be prepared to help plan, organize and host the next Baronial Champions event.

### **Arts and Sciences Champion:**

- ★ Regularly represent the Barony of Atenveldt in competitions. This does not mean the champion must enter EVERY available competition, but that they should set an example for the populace with regular activity in the Arts and Sciences. It is expected that the champion enter a minimum of 2 competitions outside of the Barony of Atenveldt.
- ★ Create two items of Baronial Regalia during their term of service. The champion will consult with Their Excellencies to determine what items are needed, taking into account the talents and temperament of the champion.
- ★ Teach classes in the Arts and Sciences in their area(s) of expertise. It is expected that a minimum of 2 Baronial Level classes will be taught at an A&S collegium.
- ★ Advise Their Excellencies on matters relating to the Arts and Sciences and seek ways to advance the Arts and Sciences in the Barony.
- ★ Promote Activity in the Arts and Sciences within the Barony of Atenveldt by encouraging and inspiring the artisans and potential artisans to participate in the available competitions, classes, and other events.

### **Rapier Champions:**

- ★ Stand court at Baronial events (Spring, Fall, Anniversary, and also Yule if possible). If the champion is attending an event where the Baron and Baroness are also in attendance, be prepared to stand with them during courts.

This does not mean the champion must enter EVERY available competition, but that they should set an example for the populace with regular activity in the Bardic Arts It is expected that the champion enter a minimum of 1 competitions outside of the Barony of Atenveldt.

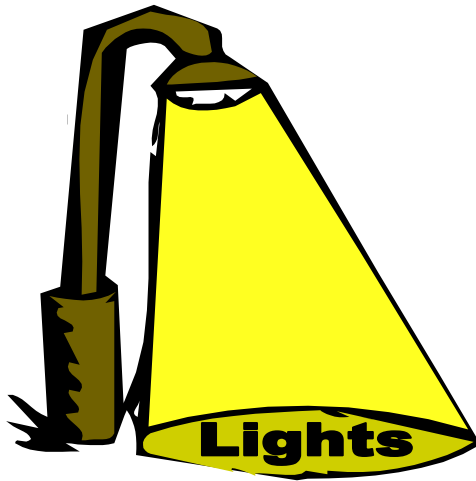

**A&S Competition: All open and novice division entries** for the Kingdom of A&S Sciences Competition **must be pre-registered** (postmarked) **by 3 September 2008**—a registration form is available on the Atenveldt A&S Website ([arts.atenveldt.org](http://arts.atenveldt.org)). In addition, **those with intent to become Kingdom Arts & Sciences Champion must submit a letter of intent to the Crown and the Kingdom A&S Minister (also due by 3 September 2008)**. Due to site restrictions, **the Brewing category judging will be off site**. Please contact Lady Flavia before leaving home for the brewing judging site directions. Entrants in any Brewing subcategories **must** drop off entries at the designated judging site **before** arriving on the WHS campus. **Wickenburg High School is a DRY site**. There will be no smoking on the site. Only assistance animals are permitted and must be leashed at all times. Weapons are not allowed on site except those used as part of Kingdom regalia or specifically as Competition entries.

**Schedule:** The troll and entry registration will open at 8:00 AM. A court is expected mid-morning, and entry registration will close at that time. The site closes at 6:30 PM.

**Luncheon:** Generous groups in the Kingdom have contributed toward a FREE LUNCH just for you! A varied luncheon will be provided from 11:00 AM–1:00 PM (separate foods for the judges will be presented in the judges' lunchroom). Lists of ingredients will be available on site. We will have a diverse mix of once-in-a-lifetime offerings (read as, “Many different items in small amounts—visit often...”)! **Directions:** Wickenburg High School is located at 1090 S. Vulture Mine Road, Wickenburg, AZ 85390. **From Phoenix:** You will be coming in to Wickenburg on Hwy 60 (Grand Ave). This is a 4-lane highway. When you see Burger King, Kentucky Fried Chicken, and Taco Bell, you need to get in the left lane because the right lane will turn off in ½ mile to go to Las Vegas. **Do not go toward Las Vegas.** Continue straight through the first stoplight and under the railroad tracks bridge to the second stoplight—about 1 mile away. Continue for about 1½ miles to the third stoplight and turn left (south) onto Vulture Mine Road (Safeway will be on your left at this stoplight). Go south on Vulture Mine Road for about ½ mile. Vulture Peak Middle School will be on your right, **Do not turn here**—instead, continue approximately 100 yards to the entrance gate with a lighted sign to Wickenburg High School on your right. Turn right and follow the drive to the parking areas.

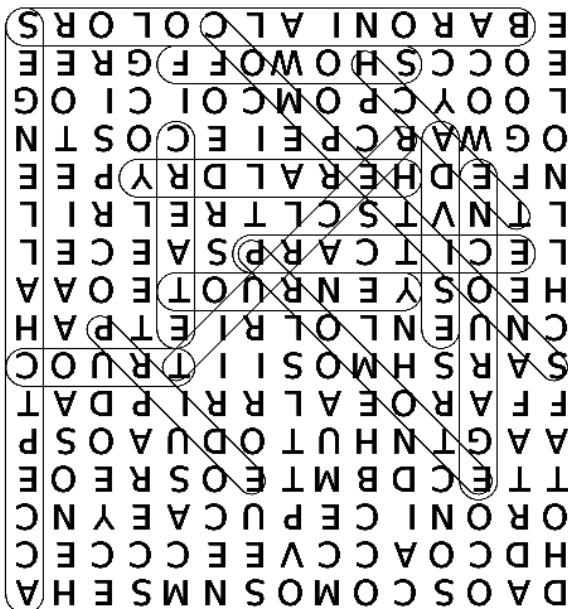

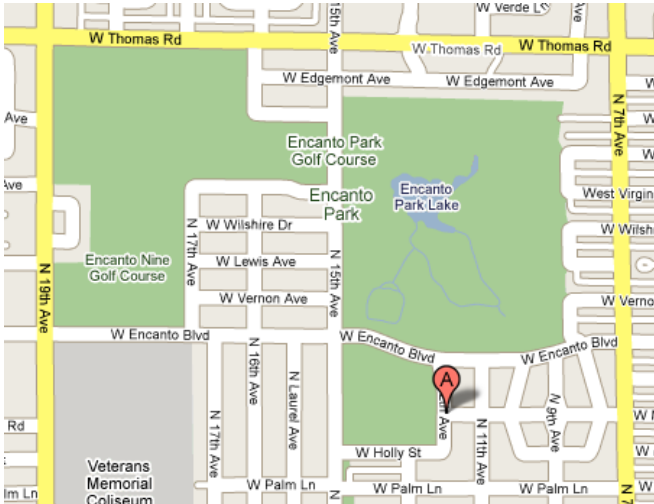

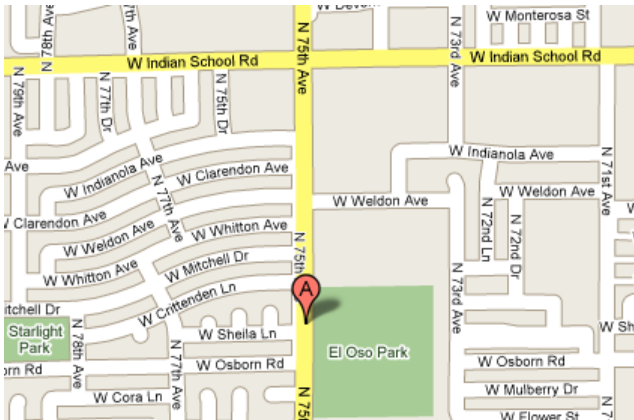
