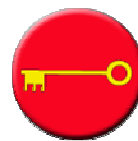

## *From the Baronial Seneschal*



Greetings...

Below is an excerpt from the Presidents Report on the October 2008 Board meeting:

1. The Board approved the following change to Corpora to be effective January 1, 2009:  
"The activity of providing beverages to combatants and spectators at SCA Combat activities is not regulated, warranted, organized, controlled, or sanctioned by the SCA, Inc. or any affiliate or subsidiary entity. Any warrants, authorizations, or other formal recognition of this activity which may currently exist are by publication of this change revoked. This change does not address or restrict any volunteer activities regarding providing beverages to combatants or spectators at SCA Combat activities nor the methods by which such provisions may be made. This does not preclude or affect SCA award recognition."

The immediate impact of this statement is that the SCA no longer recognizes the Water-Bearers as SCA sanctioned volunteers; these activities may continue but are not regulated by the SCA. The statement can be read to say that the SCA may not purchase water or provide the reservoirs to hold the water. Until the extent to which the SCA is distancing itself from providing beverages during combat activities is given by the Society Seneschal the Barony will continue to purchase the water but it will be up to the individuals to pour the water from the cooler into a cup or bottle.

## *From the Baronial A&S Minister*



I'd like to share my thoughts with you about Arts & Sciences Competitions. Some people say that Art can't be judged and that competition is against their principles. I can understand and respect that point of view.

Some people say that artists are delicate souls whose feelings are so easily hurt that they would be devastated by the slightest hint of criticism. I reject this line of thought absolutely! Over the last thirty-five years I've had the chance to watch quite a few people take up sword and shield combat in the SCA. I've watched experienced fighters show the newbies how to hold their swords and shields. I've watched them explain how to guard their bodies with the shield, and how to block and throw a shot. I've watched them sparring at half speed (or slower) and gradually learn the tempo of fighting.

Then the day comes when the teacher judges that the pupil is ready to learn what it is really all about and they begin to land blows at speed and with full force. One blow that almost always lands is the dreaded "butt wrap." All the talking in the world about guarding with your shield is not as effective as one butt wrap, for teaching a newbie about fighting. That butt wrap usually separates those who really want to fight from those who don't. Some people never armor up again after that first time and others go on to win the Crown.

I think that A&S judging sheets are just like that "butt wrap" shot. Just when you think you've covered everything in your documentation, when you think you have created a masterpiece that should fill everyone with awe, you read your judging sheets and you feel that sting that comes with a judge pinpointing the weakness of your documentation or seeing where your technique fell short of the perfection you aimed for.

Just like the "butt wrap" you don't enjoy the sensation, but you do learn from it. You really learn from it! None of the praises your friends heap on your project will ever tell you as much as a judge who points out the weakness in your project.

I've never had a judge deliver a low blow or an undeserved criticism. Even when a judge missed the point I was trying to make, it made me realize that my writing needed to be clearer. All the little stings helped me learn and not one of them left a bruise!

I believe that artisans are just as strong and brave as newbie fighters. I believe we can learn and grow and get better as artists from the criticism we receive from A&S judges. I believe that we can and do benefit from competition, not just to see who is "best" or "Champion" but to challenge ourselves to be the best we can be, and to get better and stronger for our next go-around. So what if you don't win your first time, or second or third. How many Crown Lists does it take for someone to win the Crown? How many people enter the Crown List every six months knowing they don't have a chance of winning, but just being glad of the chance to try?

I want to challenge everyone to make something to enter in the next A&S competition at Kingdom or Baronial level. I'll help you any way I can, but the greatest help you'll receive will be in your dreaded "judging sheets." Oh, and you get to keep the spiffy things you make.

## *Seneschal (Open Until January 1)*

The Barony of Atenveldt is accepting applications for the position of Seneschal. The term of office will begin in January 2009 and a 2 year duration is requested. This is a warranted office and is one of the mandatory offices for a Barony to sustain group status. Interested parties should contact myself for more details of the office and should submit letter of intent to perform the duties to by myself and their Excellencies.

Specific duties of the Seneschal include:

- Legal representative of the SCA at the Baronial level and is responsible for oversight on the day to day operations of the Barony and its officers
- Coordinates and signs all contracts for the Barony including practice field allocations, storage locker rental, and event site rentals
- Must work closely with the Baron and Baroness as their ceremonial functions have substantial overlap with the business functions of the SCA
- Collects reports from all the officers in the group and submits a consolidated report to the Kingdom Seneschal on a monthly basis as well as the yearly "Doomsday" report
- Member of the group financial committee and is responsible for the proper operation of the financial committee per SCA guidelines
- Reviews and certifies the quarterly and annual reports from the Exchequer prior to their submittal to the Kingdom Exchequer
- Coordinate with their Excellencies the event schedules for the coming year for discussion and coordination at the annual Kingdom Event Calendar Meeting
- Maintain open communication with the populace to ensure harmonious interactions among the membership and minimize the extent of the inevitable disagreements when they do occur

### *Regalia Officer (Open Until Filled)*

The Regalia Officer is responsible for the storage, transportation, and upkeep of the regalia and trailers. The Regalia Officer is also encouraged to recruit any deputies that may be needed. The position does involve some heavy lifting and moving. Interested individuals should have a vehicle available to them that can haul the trailer to events. The trailer has brakes installed and requires a brake controller in the vehicle pulling it.

The Regalia Officer reports to the Kingdom Regalia Office, as well as the Baronial Exchequer and Seneschal. All interested parties should submit a letter of intent to Their Excellencies and the Baronial Seneschal.

I will be available as a deputy officer for coaching and assistance until the end of this next Estrella War.

### *Chancellor of the Youth (Open until Filled)*

The young are the future of the SCA but without activities to provide them diversions at events they will have no desire to continue in the SCA. The office is responsible for coordinating youth activities and ensuring compliance of the youths and their guardians with Society policies in coordination with the Seneschal staff at events. The job is what you would make of it and benefits from a large selection of deputies. As part of the ongoing improvements in the Society youth activity programs volunteer can expect a background check to be conducted by the SCA. ## *Chirurgion* (Open until February 1)

Taken from the Chirurgion's Handbook:

The Chirurgionate is the volunteer first-aid organization of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc., a non-profit educational organization devoted to the study of the Middle Ages and Renaissance. It is part of the "living history" movement, where members try to reproduce various aspects of the culture and technology of their period, as well as pursuing more traditional historical research. The SCA sponsors events such as medieval tournaments and feasts, where members dress in Medieval and Renaissance styles, and participate in activities based on the civil and martial arts of the Middle Ages.

We use the medieval term "Chirurgion" instead of "first aider," "first responder," or "medic" in our efforts to maintain a medieval atmosphere at SCA events. We also use the Medieval blood-letting device, the fleam, as the symbol of the Chirurgionate instead of the modern red short-armed cross whose use is restricted by international treaty to organizations affiliated with the International Red Cross and the military.

The members of the Chirurgionate include Red Cross-trained first aiders, medical doctors, military medical corpsmen, nurses, paramedics, St. John's and St. Andrew's ambulance volunteers, and many other medical volunteers and professionals. We come from all walks of life and from many countries around the globe. We are united as members of the Chirurgionate for one purpose: to provide first aid at SCA events.

The members of the Chirurgionate provide first aid on a volunteer basis at SCA events. First aid performed in the SCA is Good Samaritan in nature, and is provided to anyone who asks at no cost to the recipient. This has been our tradition ever since Bjo of Griffin, arguably the first-known Chirurgion, started bringing her first-aid kit to SCA events, back in the days when there was but a single Kingdom.

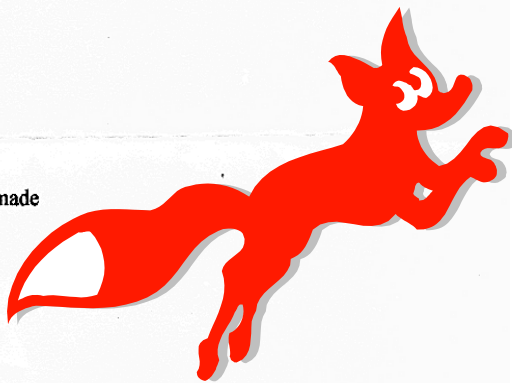


# *Farm Animals, the Mouse, and the Fox*

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## *Shoes for SCA*

Shoes are often the last item of garb SCA folk acquire. Usually cost is the main reason for this. Good quality, ready made shoes can be purchased from such vendors as Bohemund's Boots, Armlann boots, Historic Enterprises or Revival Clothiers, but the cost ranges from about \$80 to \$500. The thrifty SCAdian may need a cheaper alternative. One way to get good shoes is to make your own. The second way is to buy modern shoes that will pass the "eight pace rule" - that is the item looks ok from 8 paces or 10 feet away.

## *Ideas for "Store Bought Shoes"*

Here are some ideas for "store bought shoes" that look enough like shoes from the middle ages or the 16<sup>th</sup> century to pass at 8 paces.

Gymnastic shoes - these work well (indoors) as shoes circa 1550-1600.

"Kung Fu" shoes will also pass the 8 pace test. Most have rubber soles so they can be worn outdoors. They work as 16<sup>th</sup> century shoes as well. You can use a magic marker to darken the edges of the soles to make them look less "rubbery"

Cheap canvas slip on shoes, in the style of the Keds Champion are pretty good outdoor shoes similar to the "kung fu" shoe. You can often find them at Wal-Mart or other discount stores. Look for white with white sides or get black ones and use a black marker to color the white rubber edge.

"Kung Fu" boots will also work as a generic "don't look too closely" boot. Try to get the ones that don't have the leather toe reinforcement. Don't use "ninja boots" though. They look waaaay too "anime" to pass.

“Mary Jane” style shoes will work for Ladies from 1490 to 1600. Stick to black or white. Men also wore shoes like these around 1500-1510 so if you have smaller feet, you might be able to wear them. Remember, mens sizes are 2 sizes larger than Ladies. Men’s 8 equals Ladies 10. Women’s shoes do run narrower than most men’s shoes so try them on before you buy if you can!

“Garden clog” shaped shoes work well for 1490-1540 overshoes. Get them big enough to fit over a ballet slipper like shoe and you are ready for indoors and outdoors as well. Period shoes of this type were usually leather or with a fabric or leather upper and a wooden sole. (Avoid ones that look like rubber or plastic!)
