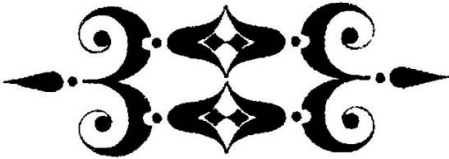

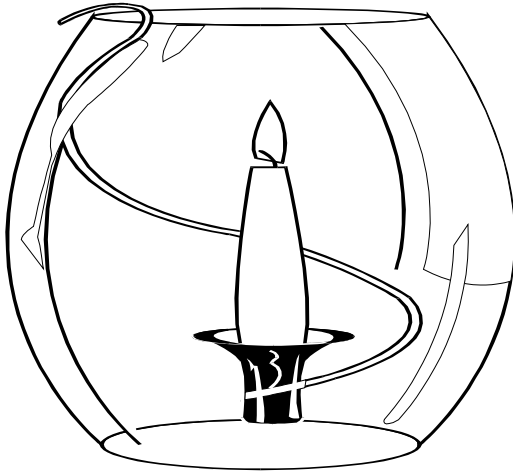

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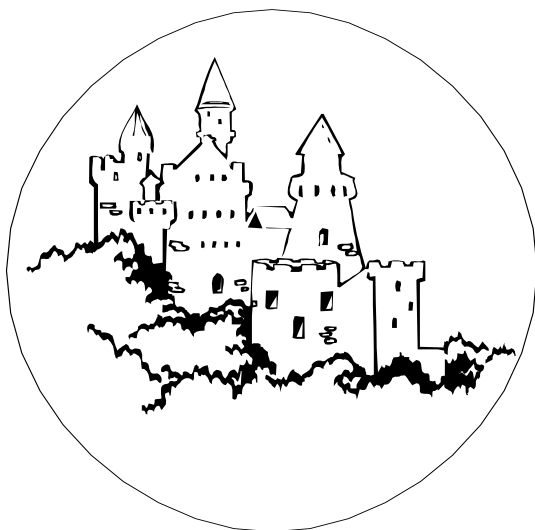
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GREETINGS FROM

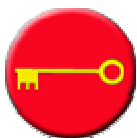

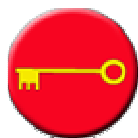

Fighter Practice Relocation

By now everyone has realized that the fighter practice is not being held at Encanto Park. Based on the last information received it is unlikely that we will be able to return to the park before mid to late July. Our current home is La Pradera Park at 40th Ave and Glendale. The Barony is still considering alternate locations and input concerning different parks will be reviewed.

At this time the Barony is at a junction and must make a decision for the path forward. Do we return to Encanto Park when the field repairs are complete or do we make a new home elsewhere. This is not as simple a question as it may seem on the surface as the relationship with Encanto Park is not as good as we would hope. Over the last 6 months the City of Phoenix has implemented several new policies concerning use of the parks system and the Encanto Park staff has only informed the SCA of one of those changes.

We have found out about the new policies either through other users of the park or from the research into using other park locations for events. We also know that the center of the Barony is no longer Encanto Park and a new location for the fighter practice would serve the current members better.

So our issue is this:

Should we stay with our home of 20+ years even though the current park management is not acting in a manner that indicates our use of the park is desired and is a location that is not the best for the population. Use of the Park would require rental of the soccer field for costs ranging from \$20-\$60 per night depending on how many other groups we can negotiate a rental agreement with.

Or should we find a new home in a more centralized location that does not require rental of the athletic fields, La Pradera being the current candidate. Whether we would attempt to rent lights (i.e. a softball or soccer field) all year or just during melee season and whether we would purchase or borrow a generator to augment the non athletic field lighting are questions that would follow depending on the location selected.

Baronial Exchequer (Open until Filled)

The Barony will need a new Baronial Exchequer in May, 2008. Responsibilities include keeping the Baronial Checkbook, reconciling the bank account monthly, monthly reports to the Baronial Financial Committee, overseeing the Regalia Officer, Chronicler and Book Reeve, quarterly reports to the Kingdom Exchequer, the annual Domesday Report and having one vote on the Baronial Financial Committee. Requires 1 to 2 hours work a week, with an addition 2 hours or so monthly. This is a warranted position.

There are forms set up for all reporting requirements and I will be available to train my successor and to help with reports, especially the 2008 Domesday. The Kingdom Exchequer and her deputies are also always available to help with reports or any questions you may have.

Requirements: Must be a paid SCA member. Basic knowledge of Excel required (or willingness to learn to use Excel). Bookkeeping experience is a plus. Must be organized and willing to do paperwork in a timely fashion. Access to email required.

Baronial Chatelaine (Open until Filled)

This officer is responsible for the welcoming and orienting of newcomers to the Society for Creative Anachronism and/or to our Barony & Kingdom.

The Baronial Hospitaler of Atenveldt is not responsible for demonstrations or loaner costumes. These are handled by the Office of the Seneschal and the College of Brymstonne, respectively.

Duties Include:

- Interacting with the general public and explaining the purposes and activities of the SCA.
- Being aware of current SCA policies and practices.
- Welcoming newcomers and transplants from other kingdoms, and introducing them to local members.
- Providing orientation to newcomers, and educating them in the structure, protocol and culture of the SCA.
- Providing accurate information about SCA practices and historical fact, and debunking inaccurate information, both from SCA rumor and entertainment media.
- Keeping a stock of written materials for distribution at practices and events.
- Answering email from interested parties.
- Attending Baronial fighter practices and events.
- Coordinating with other Baronial and Kingdom Hospitalers/Gold Key Officers.
- Attending monthly officer meetings and submitting monthly reports to the Kingdom Gold Key Officer, the Baronial Seneschal and the Baron & Baroness of Atenveldt.

The Baronial Hospitaler should:

- Have a “clean cut” appearance and wear accurate period dress.
- Be articulate and able to interact with the general public.
- Have accurate general knowledge of medieval history
- Be well-versed in mainstream SCA practices and policies.

# SCA Myths & Absurdities

## Jewelry Jumbblings

- **Medieval jewelry was crude and finely made jewelry isn't period.**

Exquisitely made jewelry was common throughout our period. (And well before it.)

- **Cameos aren't period. ✠ ✠**

Cameos were manufactured in Europe from ancient times and a number of famous period pieces include them.

- **Pewter isn't period.**

It was commonly used in SCA period.

- **Vikings didn't use gold -and/or- Vikings didn't use any stones but amber.**

Many Norse of the Viking age seem to have had a fashion preference for silver and amber, but they valued and wore gold and many, various precious stones.

- **Faceted stones aren't period.**

For all but approximately the last century of our period this is true until the invention of dops. Stones were sometimes hand etched, carved or cut as early as ancient Egypt. For the vast majority of the period, unfaceted stones were the rule.

- **You can't wear Christian Crosses or Stars of David because religion is banned in the SCA.**

Religion is not banned in the SCA, and religious symbols were probably the most common themes in period jewelry.

- **Pentagram pendants were worn a lot in period. ✠**

It surprises many to learn that the pentagram was (And is) a Judeo-Christian protective symbol. It wasn't a period jewelry theme. I've yet to see a credible reference to such necklaces being made or worn in our period.

## **New Myth of the Month:**

- **Masters at Arms may not wear spurs, only knights**

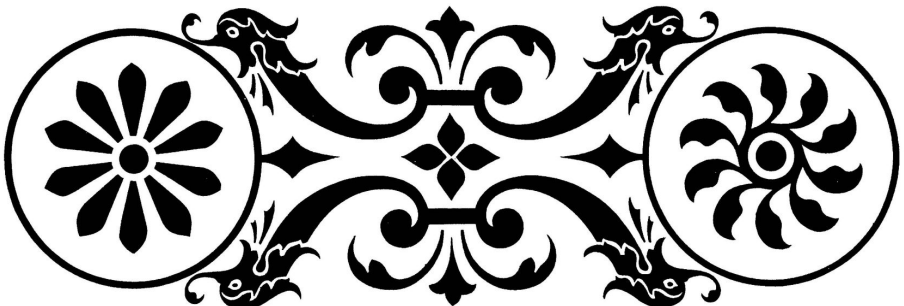

## **Kingdom Arts & Sciences Collegium**

**June 7-8, 2008**



Come one and all to the biggest, most fun two-day Kingdom Collegium held in Atenveldt in many years! The site is in the Barony of Tir Ysgithr at the privately owned, Green Fields Country Day School ([www.greenfields.org](http://www.greenfields.org)) at 6000 N Camino de la Tierra, Tucson, AZ 85741, less than a mile from I-10 at the Orange Grove exit. The site includes 14 classrooms, an auditorium for Court, a gymnasium for rapier (athletic shoes required), an onsite playground, a soccer field, and more. There are numerous restaurants and hotels nearby and ample parking. Crash space is available.

**Two Days Of Classes:** The Collegium will offer over 100 classes on SCA related topics (classes to run Saturday from 9:30AM to 5:00PM and Sunday from 9:30AM to 3:00 PM), with an emphasis on these tracks: All Things Viking, All Things Middle Eastern, Rapier from Head to Foot, Peers and Royalty, SCA Service/Administration/Officers, Performing Arts, New to the SCA, Brewing (yes, onsite brewing is allowed!!), Garb/Accessories/Fiber Arts, Calligraphy/Illumination, Youth (5 to 9 years), and Youth (10 to 15 years). THL Aurelia Chrysanthina Dalassene, the Kingdom Arts & Sciences Champion, will be hosting a "Costuming & Needlework Artisan's Display", and a medieval fashion show ("La Promenade d'Histoire"). TRM Phelan and Amirah, King and Queen of Atenveldt, have let it be known that They will hold Kingdom Court at Noon on Saturday, and a Chivalry Circle at Noon on Sunday.

**Food /Evening Activities:** Finger foods and drinks will be offered during the lunch breaks on Saturday and Sunday, so plan to supplement these by bringing a picnic lunch or visiting a nearby restaurant (a list of restaurants will be available at troll). Pavilions will be setup in the center of the campus as a place for people to sit and eat lunch, or relax between classes. The Barony of Tir Ysgithr will be hosting an offsite Saturday evening Bar-B-Que and revel (garb optional and children allowed), and all attendees and instructors are invited. A map to the evening revel will be available at troll.

**About the Site:** The SCA has rented the entire school campus for this event. That allows us to simultaneously hold classes in 18 separate locations at the site (site maps will be provided at troll). 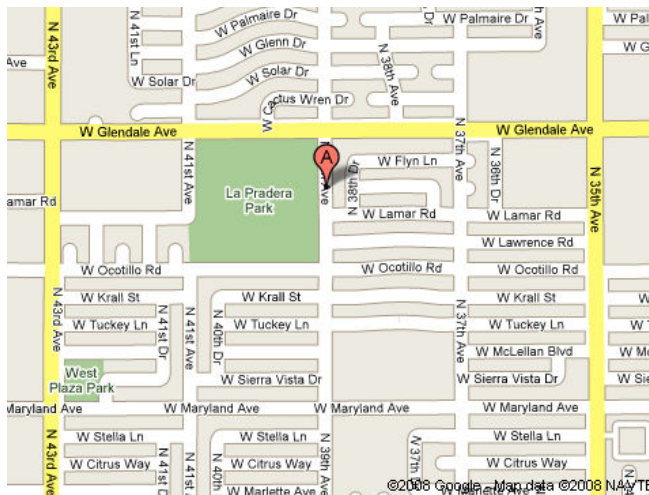

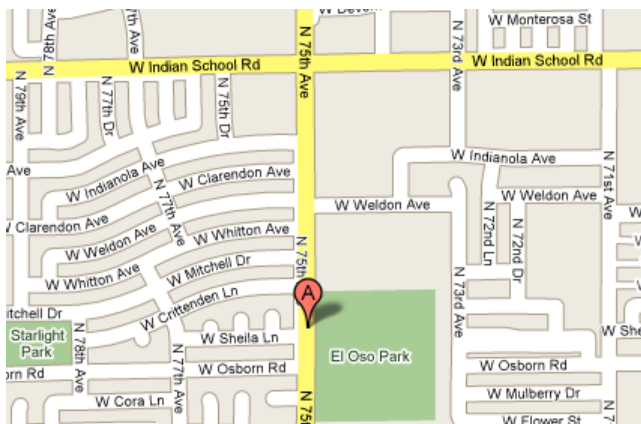
