### Officers' Reports:

I Seneschal: The application is in for Encanto Park for October thru December 2008. This week he will be putting in the application for January to July, 2009. We will hear about the October application in September and the January application in October.

II Exchequer: The Quarterly report is completed. We need to get storage for the Baronial trailer. We need to get a storage area and an antitheft boot.



- III Chronicler: All past minutes of the Business Meetings will be posted to the Baronial website this month. All minutes from now on will be posted to the Baronial Website soon after Jean Andre' is able to complete them.
- IV A&S: Youth and dance classes were taught this month. Youth classes will continue in August. New banners are being started for "Big Red". They are still looking for a free location to hold A&S or classes.
- V Herald: Lady Safaya is still trying to figure everything out. There were 2 new name submissions, two new device submissions and one resubmission this month. Her monthly report has been submitted.
- VI Chatelaine: Her reports are in. She has received the banners and equipment that go with the office but has to do an inventory on them. She has talked to several newcomers and may have to set up her table before the end of the summer heat. She also needs more pamphlets.
- VII Chirurgion: Everything is good. There are no major injuries to report. Lord Olaf will be the Chirurgion in Charge at Highlands War.

Old Business:

- I Highlands War: Baronial Land will be in between the quiet area and the noisy area. The new Dragon Fly Baronial Pavilion is completed and will be set up at this event. There will be a Sunday morning pancake breakfast.
- II Fools Faire: a day of jesting and jousting: This event will be held at the Croatian Center on September 13<sup>th</sup>. It was suggested that we invite merchants to come out. There will be a planning meeting at Highlands War Sunday morning during the pancake breakfast. Lord Ritchyrd will lead the dancing. There will be a feast. There will also be a dessert auction. Lady Morgaine will talk to the champions to see if they have any plans for the event.
- III Baronial Championships: The event will be held October 24<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>. We are still unsure of the site because the Buckeye Equestrian Center has still not given us a price. The site fee is \$12.00. Children will get in for free. There will be a pot luck dinner with the Barony supplying the meat and the populace supplying the rest.
- IV Yule: The Baronial Financial Committee has received a bid. The event will be held at the Croatian Center. The theme will be red and white. There will be story telling, dancing and games.
- V Coronation: We still do not have a site. Lord Jean Andre' is looking for backup sites and His Grace Aaron is looking into the school he works at. The Buckeye Equestrian center still has not given us a price but things do not look good there.

### New Business:

I Charters, etc.: Lord Ritchyrd reports that 2 award charters have been approved. These are the Baron's Henchman and the Sisters of the Black Swan. Their Majesties are requesting award nominations especially for archery and rapier.

II Café Press: Lady Morgaine reports that an anonymous donator is willing to pay for our store to become a superstore for one year. She needs ideas for "one liners" for t-shirts and other possible merchandise. Lord Michael of Kilkenny is willing to help with the graphics and designs. The Barony is going to except this donation.

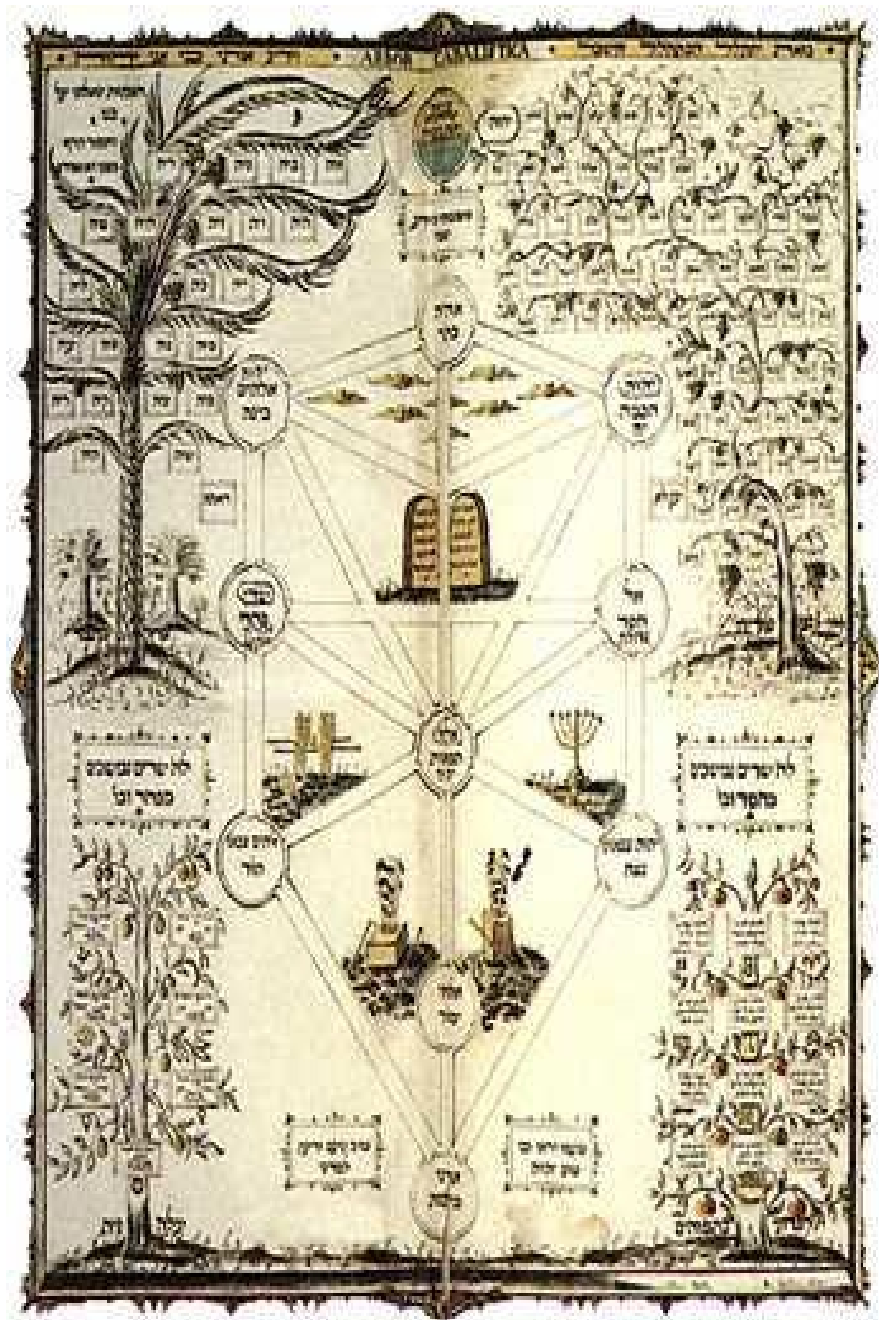

# *SCA Myths & Absurdities*

By Alianora da Lyshåret

★ **Pachelbel's *Canon in D* is a period composition.**

Johann Pachelbel was born in 1653, half a century after the end of our period.

★ ***Chronicles of Atenveldt* is the official history of the Kingdom.**

This was a private publication written by an individual member. The book has no official status. Further, it is riddled with error, especially regarding everything pre-1985. Far better to check out Arthur of Lockhaven's *Atenveldt as I Remember It* or ask Count Richard Ironsted or another founding member.

★ **Wooden embroidery "hoops" ('tambour', or drum like frames) are period.**

I have never been able to document a round, two-piece embroidery "hoop" to a date earlier than the end of the 17<sup>th</sup> century (1600s—Almost a hundred years out of our period.) The 17<sup>th</sup>/18<sup>th</sup> Century "tambour" frame was actually a hoop that was tightened over a half-sphere for an embroidery technique that uses a special needle to form a continuous chain stitch.

Period embroiders used rectangular frames in which the ground cloth was either "laced" (Whip-stitched) or tacked into place. Hoops are cheap, but unsatisfactory for fine needlework.

## **Guest Myths**

Passed on by Mistress Ealasaid nicSuibne:

★ **Volunteer hours can be directed to your household –or- "Group within Atenveldt" includes households.**

Households are purely personal, and not any official part of the SCA. Your "group" is the official branch of the SCA, Inc. in which you live and/or participate. If it's not a barony, shire, college, kingdom or canton, it's not eligible for volunteer hours funds.

★ **You have to donate your volunteer hours to the group in which you live.**

You may donate your hours to any branch of the SCA within the Kingdom of Atenveldt.

★ **Internal household officers are official and are recognized by the SCA and its branches**

Once again, households are purely personal arrangements. If your household members choose to set up an officer corps that shadows SCA office structure, nobody else is going to recognize them.

The only position that *might* be recognized is that of the household "head". That is, if your household bothers to have one. (It's not required.) But nobody is going to defer to the "authority" of a "household seneschal", "household chirurgeon", or any other position that you and your friends decide to have.

Please, if you like the idea of serving in an office, we're in need of good officers within the official Atenveldt. Volunteer to help an officer or apply for one of the open positions.

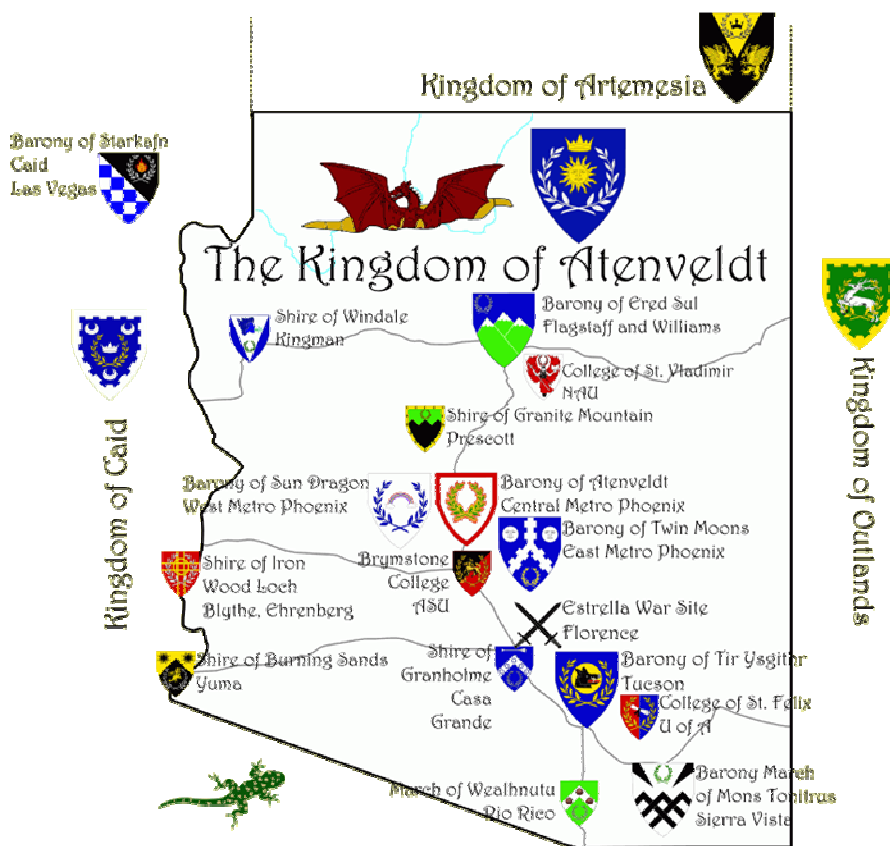
★ **All ladies must wear a circlet.**

Hmmm? First, the circlet doesn't necessarily go with the headdress of all of our period. A circlet works from early period into the gothic era, though the styles vary. Regardless, A circlet is not required, though it might help keep your veil on and looks good with the right outfit.

★ **A circlet is a shiny metal band.**

A circlet is a band that goes around your head. Many are shiny metal, though the right to wear an uncovered metal band made of yellow or silver colored metal is restricted to barons and royal peers in Atenveldt. The last time I checked, copper was allowed if the band was ½ inch or narrower.

But circlets of covered metal bands, and bands made of other materials are just fine. Leather works as does woven bands, strings of beads, shell and other materials. These may be decorated with jewels, beads and other pretty things.

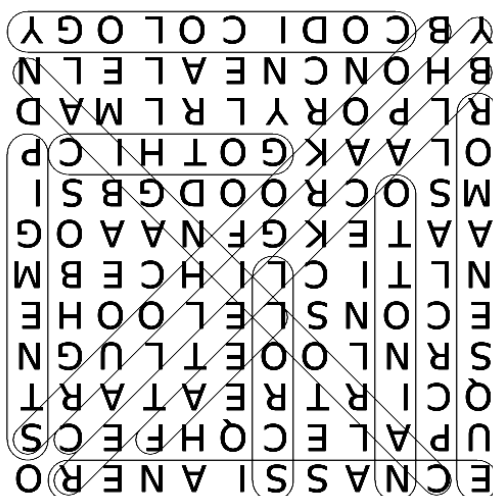

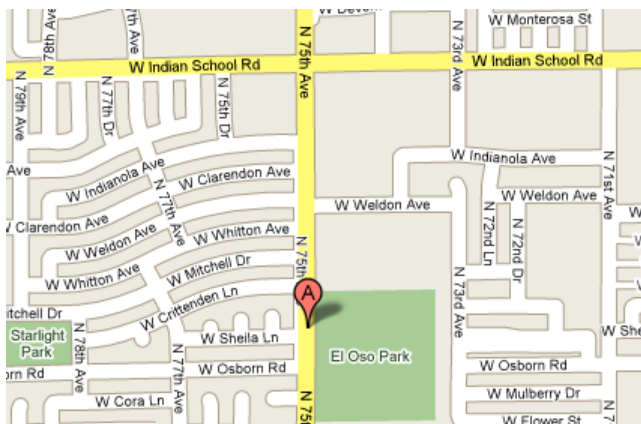
