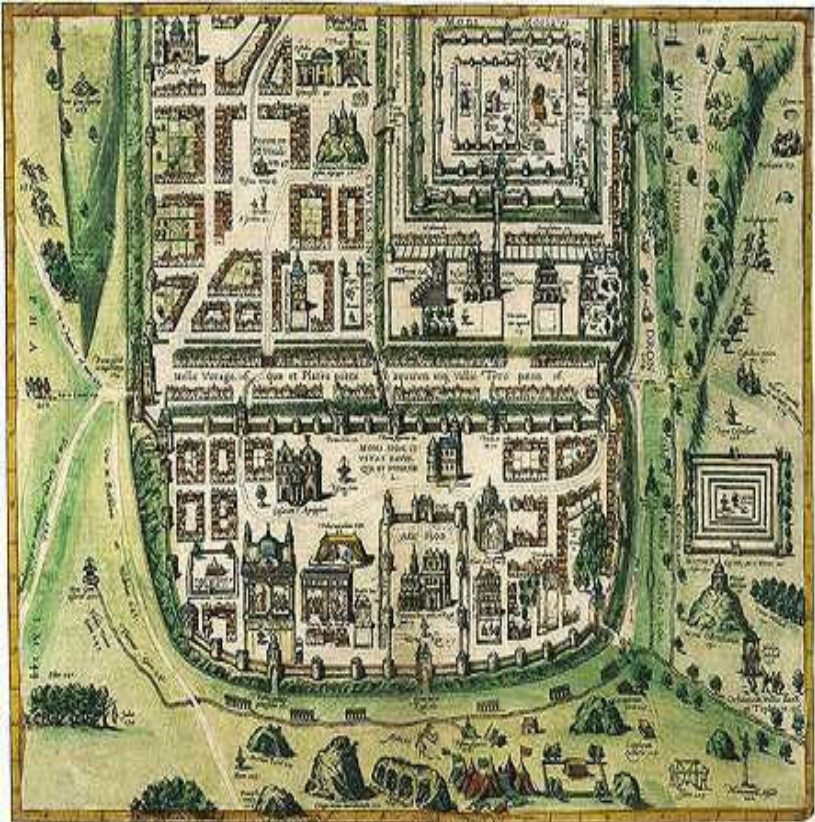

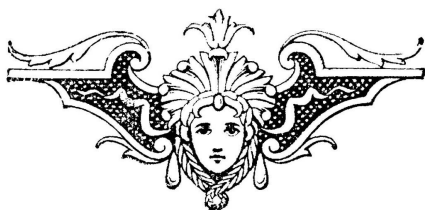

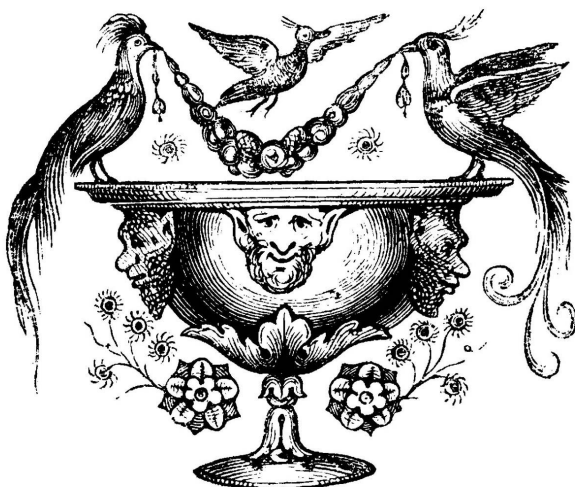

Unto the Populous of this "The Grand Barony of Atenveldt" doth Baron Otto and Baronessa Lisabetta send warm greetings and well wishes.

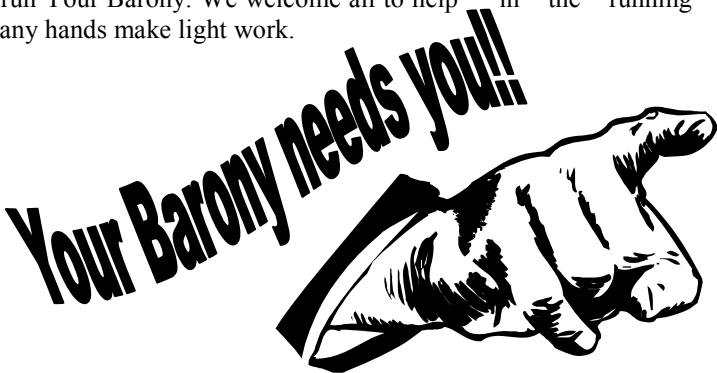
ESTRELLA WAR is now many memories of the old friends we saw again and the new ones we made. We hope you have as many memories as we do and that you

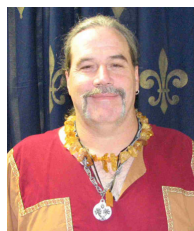

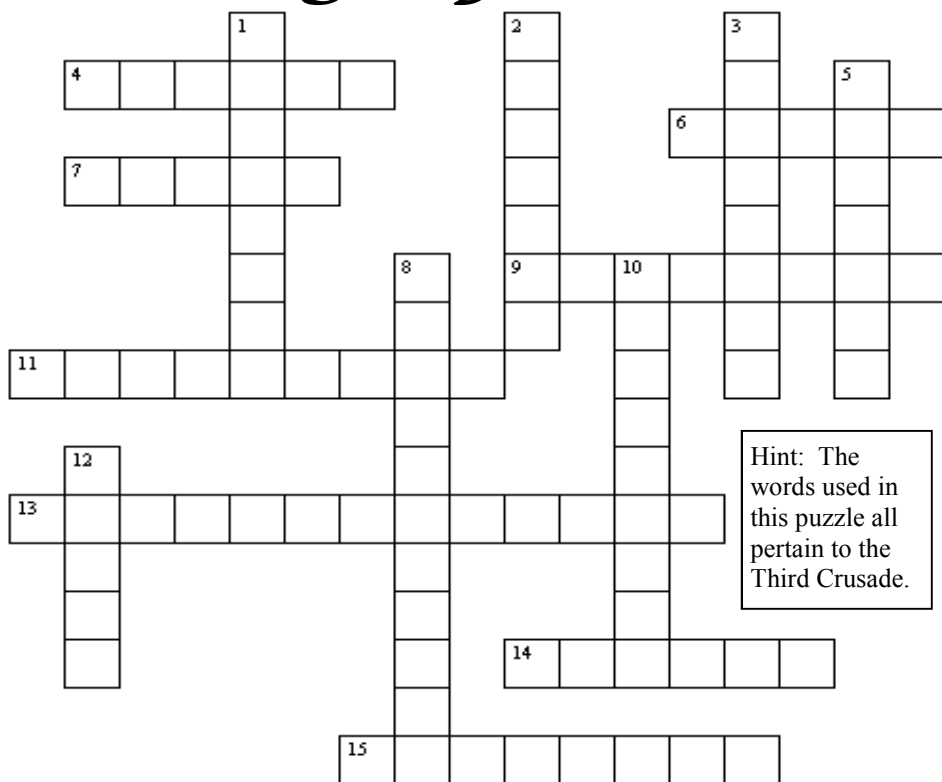

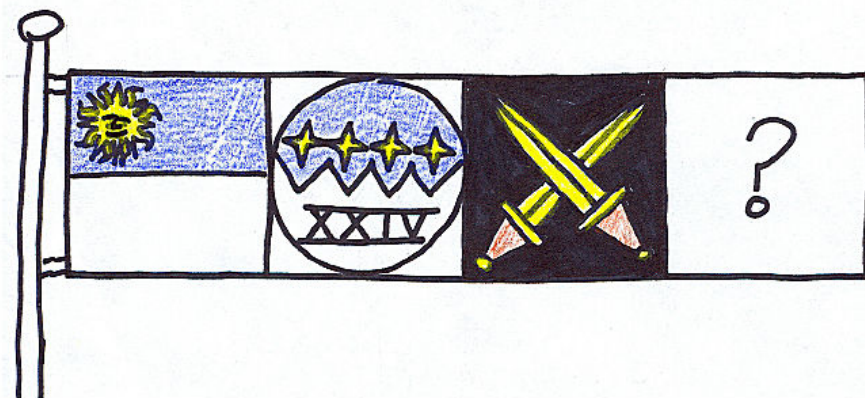
Populace Victory Pennants

Any member of the populous of a kingdom that wins a war point at Estrella War is now eligible to make and display a “populace victory pennant” for the area in which his or her kingdom was victorious.

Each pennant must contain the following elements, described from the banner-pole edge outward:

1. Populace Badge: the first element of each pennant must be the populace badge of the pennant bearer. Please note that the populace badge is not the same as the kingdom arms.
2. Estrella War Badge and year: the second element must be the badge of Estrella War, including the year at the bottom in roman numerals.
3. Category badge: the third element must be the badge associated with the victory, i.e. two crossed swords for hardsuit, two crossed rapiers for rapier, a candle under and arch for Arts & Sciences, three crossed arrows for archery.
4. Additional elements: if desired, the pennant may contain additional elements describing the bearer’s personal arms, unit, household, guild, barony, etc.

This banner should be 6 inches tall and at least 18 inches long – each of the three required sections should be 6” x 6”.

Appendix A: Populace Victory Pennants

excerpt from the Estrella War XXIV Treaty

A Estrella War XXIV shall be fought to earn the right for the populace of a kingdom to bear victory pennants as follows:

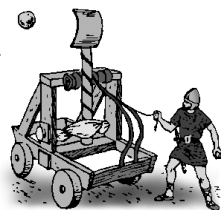
1. The populace of the Principal Kingdoms comprising the Allied Realm winning the Armored Combat Scenarios explained in this treaty shall have the Right to display an Estrella War XXIV Armored Combat Victory Pennant. The dimensions and design of this pennant will be available on the Estrella War website on February 20, 2008.
2. The populace of the Principal Kingdoms comprising the Allied Realm winning the Arts & Sciences Competition explained in APPENDIX A shall have the Right to display an Estrella War XXIV Arts & Sciences Pennant. The dimensions and design of this pennant will be available on the Estrella War website on February 20, 2008.
3. The populace of the Principal Kingdoms comprising the Allied Realm winning the Archery explained in APPENDIX B shall have the Right to display an Estrella War XXIV Archery Pennant. The dimensions and design of this pennant will be available on the Estrella War website on February 20, 2008.
4. The populace of the Principal Kingdoms comprising the Allied Realm winning the Rapier explained in APPENDIX C shall have the Right to display an Estrella War XXIV Rapier Pennant. The dimensions and design of this pennant will be available on the Estrella War website on February 20, 2008.

The Last Crusade: The Siege of Atenveldt



April 5 - 6, 2008

Empty Acres, AZ

The cross has been taken up by the King. All of England prepares to send off their husbands, brothers, fathers and sons to defend the Holy Land. Come join in as we follow King Richard on his Crusade to retake Jerusalem from the army of Saladin. All warriors shall meet upon the field Saturday morning to prepare the assault on the enemy.

The time has come, my brothers. The army of Salah al-Din (Saladin), may Allah bless him always, must gather to protect our lands from the invaders. From the north comes the great and fearsome Richard of the Lions. His wrath is great and his army is strong. But Allah will guide us to victory. We must gather at the city of Acre to defend it from the invaders. May Allah bless us.

On Saturday, there will be a series of melee battles following the progress of King Richard the Lionhearted during the 3rd Crusade. We will conduct all manner of battles from Castle siege to Bridge to Resurrection. Each battle will have special goals that could change the entire outcome of the fight. You may choose to fight for King Richard against the Saracens or with Saladin against the European invaders. Sides will be determined by kit and preference to which army you wish to fight for as well as to even the sides for the sake of fun. Please bring your Crusader Kits, your Saracen Kits, or whatever you have as well as all manner of banners and pennants to create the best atmosphere.

Along side the hardsuit battles, will be the Rapier soldiers whose scenarios will mirror and assist those of the hardsuit. The outcome of one battle could turn the tide of the other. Whereas hardsuit has mostly been the "on land" battles, the rapier fighters are the warriors of the sea. All scenarios are geared to represent the sailors and ships crew fighting at sea to clear a path for the Crusaders to land. There will be Ship to Ship battles and landing assaults. As well as during the hardsuit Bridge battle, The Rapier warriors will help to determine who has control of the river crossings.

There will also be target archery designed to aid in the battles, as well as Siege engines trying to bring down the Castle walls and rain destruction down upon the enemy. Archer's will help to clear out the towers defenders and provide cover for the assaulting soldiers. Targets will be setup to represent the various special events that can help turn the tide of the battles.

Come join us as we relive the glory and honor achieved during the 3rd Crusade by Richard and Saladin and their armies.

On Sunday we will hold a day of Tournaments, starting with a William Marshal Tourney and ending with a Crusaders Cross Bear-pit Prize Tourney for the hardsuit Fighters. The William Marshal Tourney is a ransom tourney in which those you defeat on the field must buy back their freedom through payment or trade of services. The winner will be the one whose coffers are the most full at the end of the allotted time to be determined by the fighters themselves. Optional coinage to be used for payment of ransoms will be available for purchase with the funds going to help pay for the Encanto Park Fighter Practice Lights. The Crusaders Cross Tourney will be held as a 1 hour Bear-pit to determine the top 8 warriors. These will then compete in a standard best two out of three, single elimination tourney to determine the overall winner. That person will carry the banner of the Cross until the next year. There will also be Rapier & Archery Tournaments for those interested.

For the non-combat participants we have many things for you to enjoy besides watching the battles of the day.

All artisans please come and explore the many colors of the Crusades as you paint your own Persian/Turkish Tile(s). Lady Damaris will have all the supplies necessary for you to participate in this activity. Also, join the Artisan Showcase (display and/or admire works) highlighting Middle Eastern and Crusader themed projects (armor, scribal, costume and scientific arts to name a few).

Calling all Bards to come and join in on our "Thousand and One Nights" Bardic Circle. Come and share your own re-telling of your favorite Shaharazhad stories, bring songs of the Crusades, or even write an original story about our own Arabian "Knights" and the events of the day. If you feel even more inspired, please bring any other Middle Eastern stories or songs that you can find. This will begin shortly after feast.

For the children, we plan to build and paint a Castle large enough for the children to play in when it's complete. There will also be Horse Races, a May Pole and any other activities that will entertain our children throughout the day. If you have anything you would like to include please contact Lady Arianna at drseuss_14@hotmail.com or bring the items with you to the event.

Enjoy the complex, rich flavors and foods from the Middle East as we offer a meal of rice, cuscus, hummus, vegetables, chicken and/or other meats. 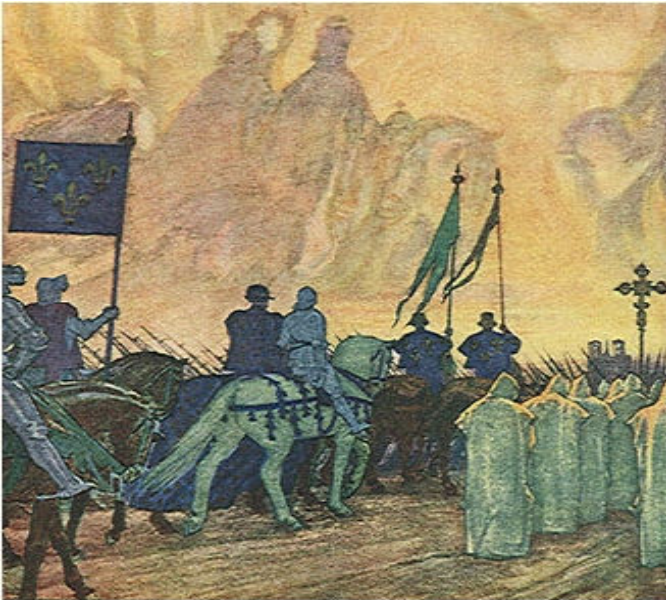
