And now the unpleasant news of how much this event cost the Barony, yes, that's right the attendance was down from what was promised and so the Barony once again lost money on a Fighting event. So here is an estimate, not final numbers, of our costs:

Site & Insurance \$375.00

Porta Johns \$287.00

Food \$135.00

Misc \$ 20.00

Expenses \$817.00

Site Fees \$528.00

Loss (\$289.00)

Fighter Practice expenses September – December were \$840.00 for lights only. The new contract is now due for lights that cover the months of January – May that cost is \$1260.00. The field will be closed from June 1 to August 31 for field maintenance, so we will need to relocate.

Seneschal (Open Until January 1)

The Barony of Atenveldt is accepting applications for the position of Seneschal. The term of office will begin in January 2009 and a 2 year duration is requested. This is a warranted office and is one of the mandatory offices for a Barony to sustain group status. Interested parties should contact myself for more details of the office and should submit letter of intent to perform the duties to by myself and their Excellencies.

Specific duties of the Seneschal include:

- Legal representative of the SCA at the Baronial level and is responsible for oversight on the day to day operations of the Barony and its officers
- Coordinates and signs all contracts for the Barony including practice field allocations, storage locker rental, and event site rentals
- Must work closely with the Baron and Baroness as their ceremonial functions have substantial overlap with the business functions of the SCA
- Collects reports from all the officers in the group and submits a consolidated report to the Kingdom Seneschal on a monthly basis as well as the yearly "Doomsday" report
- Member of the group financial committee and is responsible for the proper operation of the financial committee per SCA guidelines
- Reviews and certifies the quarterly and annual reports from the Exchequer prior to their submittal to the Kingdom Exchequer
- Coordinate with their Excellencies the event schedules for the coming year for discussion and coordination at the annual Kingdom Event Calendar Meeting
- Maintain open communication with the populace to ensure harmonious interactions among the membership and minimize the extent of the inevitable disagreements when they do occur

Regalia Officer (Open Until Filled)

The Regalia Officer is responsible for the storage, transportation, and upkeep of the regalia and trailers. The Regalia Officer is also encouraged to recruit any deputies that may be needed. The position does involve some heavy lifting and moving. Interested individuals should have a vehicle available to them that can haul the trailer to events. The trailer has brakes installed and requires a brake controller in the vehicle pulling it.

The Regalia Officer reports to the Kingdom Regalia Office, as well as the Baronial Exchequer and Seneschal. All interested parties should submit a letter of intent to Their Excellencies and the Baronial Seneschal.

I will be available as a deputy officer for coaching and assistance until the end of this next Estrella War.

Chancellor of the Youth (Open until Filled)

The young are the future of the SCA but without activities to provide them diversions at events they will have no desire to continue in the SCA. The office is responsible for coordinating youth activities and ensuring compliance of the youths and their guardians with Society policies in coordination with the Seneschal staff at events. The job is what you would make of it and benefits from a large selection of deputies. As part of the ongoing improvements in the Society youth activity programs volunteer can expect a background check to be conducted by the SCA. Please contact the Seneschal for specific details of the background check program and what the background check would involve if this causes any concern.

Chirurgéon (Open until February 1)

Taken from the Chirurgéon's Handbook:

The Chirurgéonate is the volunteer first-aid organization of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc., a non-profit educational organization devoted to the study of the Middle Ages and Renaissance. It is part of the "living history" movement, where members try to reproduce various aspects of the culture and technology of their period, as well as pursuing more traditional historical research. The SCA sponsors events such as medieval tournaments and feasts, where members dress in Medieval and Renaissance styles, and participate in activities based on the civil and martial arts of the Middle Ages.

We use the medieval term "Chirurgéon" instead of "first aider," "first responder," or "medic" in our efforts to maintain a medieval atmosphere at SCA events. We also use the Medieval blood-letting device, the fleam, as the symbol of the Chirurgéonate instead of the modern red short-armed cross whose use is restricted by international treaty to organizations affiliated with the International Red Cross and the military.

The members of the Chirurgéonate include Red Cross-trained first aiders, medical doctors, military medical corpsmen, nurses, paramedics, St. John's and St. Andrew's ambulance volunteers, and many other medical volunteers and professionals. We come from all walks of life and from many countries around the globe. We are united as members of the Chirurgéonate for one purpose: to provide first aid at SCA events.

The members of the Chirurgéonate provide first aid on a volunteer basis at SCA events. First aid performed in the SCA is Good Samaritan in nature, and is provided to anyone who asks at no cost to the recipient. This has been our tradition ever since Bjo of Griffin, arguably the first-known Chirurgéon, started bringing her first-aid kit to SCA events, back in the days when there was but a single Kingdom.

From the Baronial Scribe/Herald



Scriptoriums, Heraldry Consultations, Sewing Workshops and More!!!

Hi Everyone,

I would like to announce that the Barony of Atenveldt has a wonderful new site for our Scriptoriums. We will be holding scriptoriums in the Art Classroom at Glendale High School located at 6216 W Glendale Ave, Glendale, AZ 85301 (at 62nd Ave and Glendale Ave.) on the 2nd and 4th Friday of each month with some exceptions. Because the site is fairly large and has great resources, we are opening the space up for a few other activities at the same time. Please read about all of the great activities planned. A tentative schedule is posted below.

Every other month, we will be holding a Heraldry Consultation Night during scriptorium. This classroom has its own computer lab where the consultations will take place. This gives the heralds that come a chance to check for conflicts during the consultations. It also can be a resource for those who are waiting for time with a Herald to do some research on their names or devices. Forms will be available on site. As Baronial Herald, I will be there but will be bouncing between that and the Scriptorium since I am also Baronial Scribe and may be teaching. So, Lady Helena de Argentoune from Twin Moons has graciously agreed to be present. Other Heralds are more than welcome to join in the fun and consultations! I will still be out at Fighter Practice as much as possible to help with heraldry questions in between the Consultation Nights as well.

Now that we are heading into fall, Estrella War is once again on everyones minds. In preparations for War, Mistress Ealasaid nic Suibhne is offering a workshop on quick and easy warm garb. This will be held each scheduled scriptorium until War. Please remember that this is a shared room, so noise is a concern. So most of the work will be discussions on patterns, pattern cutting, questions and answers and hand sewing. If you need to bring a sewing machine to work with, we do ask that it be a reasonably quiet machine. Please bring your own fabric, thread and sewing supplies with you. Limited supplies of needles and scissors will be available for those that forget. If you have any questions, please contact Mistress Ealasaid at ealasaid@cox.net or 480 773-9920.

Now, if you are interested in painting or calligraphy, this is the time to get started! Starting October 10th, we will be holding a series of workshops in calligraphy and illumination. Whether a returning scribe or someone who is just looking to get started, these workshops are designed to help scribes grow and learn more about period designs and techniques. I will have some pens, ink, paints and brushes available for new comers that just want to check it out and see if they like it before investing in supplies. I will also have some pre-drawn designs specific to the topic of the illumination workshops.

Others are welcome to join us too! You can come and sit at the desks to work on small projects that are separate from the classes. So, illuminators who don't want to learn calligraphy, calligraphers who don't want to learn the illumination, scribes from other Baronies or working on Kingdom stuff can all work there. Likewise, if someone wants to bring smaller A&S projects like embroidery, inkle weaving, beading etc can all join us too.

The room will be open from 6-9pm. The Scribal workshops will start at 7pm. This will give everyone a chance to arrive and settle in before the workshops begin. This will give people a

chance to take advantage of multiple activities if they choose, finish projects, ask questions, get stuck in traffic, use the light tables or simply enjoy the time to chit chat before getting down to business. To get to the classroom, it is recommended that you park in the teachers and visitor parking which is the parking lot closest to 62nd Ave. We will open the gate and post signs to direct you from there. It is basically straight in from the gate, so no one should be getting lost. However, if you wish to join us and do get a little off track, you can reach me at 602-295-8283.

After scriptorium, generally several of the scribes go out for food and/or pie afterwards. Currently we have been going to Village Inn (more variety and better desserts than Denny's) located at I-17 and Northern. If you have other ideas, please let us know. Everyone is welcome to join us.

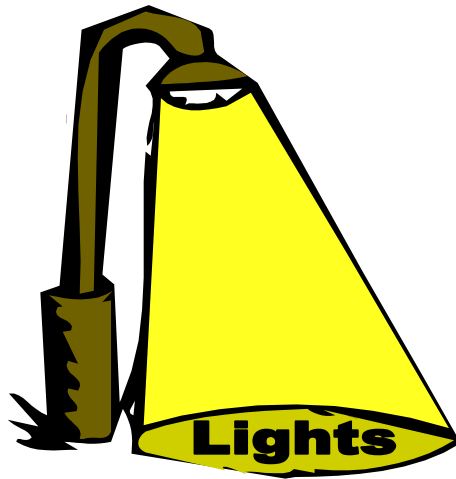

Officers' Reports:

Accidental 3 Bean Chili

Garnish with shredded cheese and chopped onion, if desired.

Prep Time: 10 minutes

Cook Time: 25 minutes

Makes 14 cups

Ingredients:

4 tablespoons olive oil	2 cup chopped onion
2 green bell pepper, coarsely chopped	6 tablespoons Chili Powder
2 teaspoon Garlic Powder	2 teaspoon Ground Cumin
2 teaspoon Oregano Leaves	2 teaspoon Basil Leaves
4 teaspoons sugar	1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon McCormick® Seasoned Pepper Blend	

3 cans (14 1/5 ounces) diced tomatoes
2 cans (15 ounces) black beans
2 cans (15 ounces) red kidney beans
2 cans (15 ounces) great Northern (or pinto beans)

Directions:

1. Heat oil in large saucepan on medium-high heat. Add onion and green bell pepper; cook and stir 5 minutes.
2. Stir in spices and remaining ingredients. Bring to boil. Reduce heat to low; simmer 20 minutes, stirring occasionally.

Directions to site for Sunday: Take your best route to Greenway Road. Go East on Greenway Road to 52nd street. Turn south and go 4 blocks to Marilyn Rd., turn right and look for school and SCA signs. It can also be reached from 52nd Street and Thunderbird.

WINKELMAN Flats is a 42 acre campground on the banks of the Gila River. Enormous cottonwood and eucalyptus trees provide shade throughout the campground, and potable water is available from spigots on-site. There are "limited" permanent showers and permanent restrooms. Nine RV hookups are also available on a reserved basis (contact Site Autocrat for reservations and restrictions). Site is wet, with smoking & fires allowed (subject to current fire restrictions). There are motels within 9 miles of the site. A Winkelman, Arizona minors' curfew requires that minors 18 and under be in their own camp or escorted by an adult after 10 PM. Pets are allowed on leashes. Site opens Noon, Thursday, Nov 6th & closes Noon, Mon, Nov 10th. Admittance after troll hours will only be allowed for those who are preregistered, so please visit ACCEPS to register for the event!

DIRECTIONS FROM NORTH, WEST & PHOENIX: Take best route to US 60 (Superstition Freeway) & go east away from Phoenix/Tempe towards Superior, AZ. Travel approx 2 hours from I 10 & US 60 into Superior, & turn South (right) onto Hwy 177. Proceed to & through WINKELMAN, AZ (past Hayden and the mine), to the intersection of Hwy 177 & Hwy 77 (the Arizona Fuel Minit Market will be on your right). Go straight across Hwy 77, & make an immediate left (north) down the off-ramp on the other side. At the bottom, curve right & follow the road over two speed bumps. At the end turn right & the troll shade pavilion will be up ahead on the right.

DIRECTIONS FROM SOUTH & EAST: Take I-10 to Tucson, exit on Grant Rd & travel east (right) to the first major light at Oracle Rd. Turn north (left) on Oracle Rd (Hwy 77) & travel approx 68 miles to WINKELMAN, AZ. At the intersection of Hwy 177 & Hwy 77 (the Arizona Fuel Minit Market will be on your left), turn east (right) & proceed down the off-ramp. At the bottom, curve right & follow the road over two speed bumps. At the end turn right & the troll shade pavilion will be up ahead on the right.

ESTRELLA WAR 2009

TREATY SIGNED AND ONLINE!!

The three Principal Kingdoms for the next Estrella War XXV (Feb 9-16, 2009) published the Estrella War Treaty negotiated at a meeting held by the Crowns and Heirs of the Kingdoms of Atenveldt (www.atenveldt.org), Caid (www.sca-caid.org), and the Outlands (www.outlands.org) on October 18, 2008. The guidelines in the treaty govern the medieval activities held at the Estrella War, including heavy combat scenarios, rapier scenarios, target archery shoots, and the Estrella War Arts and Sciences Competition.

The Crowns and Heirs also added an additional day of war point scenarios and archery shoots to the Treaty this year. Since the event opens a day earlier than in prior years (MONDAY FEB 9th for pre-registered attendees and TUESDAY FEB 10th for General Admission), the treaty reserves WEDNESDAY FEB 11th for tournaments and special combat, and THURSDAY FEB 12th through SATURDAY FEB 14th for war scenario activities and archery shoots. Additional fighting "for the Glory of Combat" is also scheduled for SUNDAY FEB 15th.

The Estrella War Treaty is negotiated annually to outline how the medieval war between two "Allied Realms" will be conducted, and how each Principal Kingdom can win the Right for their Populace to display one or more of four Estrella War XXV Victory Pennants. Announcements in this year's treaty include the following:

- Allied Realm I in the conflict shall be the Kingdom of Atenveldt and the Kingdom of the Outlands and their allies. Allied Realm II shall be the Kingdom of Caid and their allies.

- The dates, times, locations, setup and objectives for the heavy combat scenarios, rapier scenarios, target archery shoots.

- Judging criteria used in the Estrella War Arts & Sciences Competition.

- The rules and guidelines a Principal Kingdom must use to win the Right for their Populace to display an Estrella War XXIV Armored Combat Victory Pennant, an Estrella War XXIV Arts & Sciences Victory Pennant, an Estrella War XXIV Rapier Victory Pennant, or an Estrella War XXIV Archery Victory Pennant.

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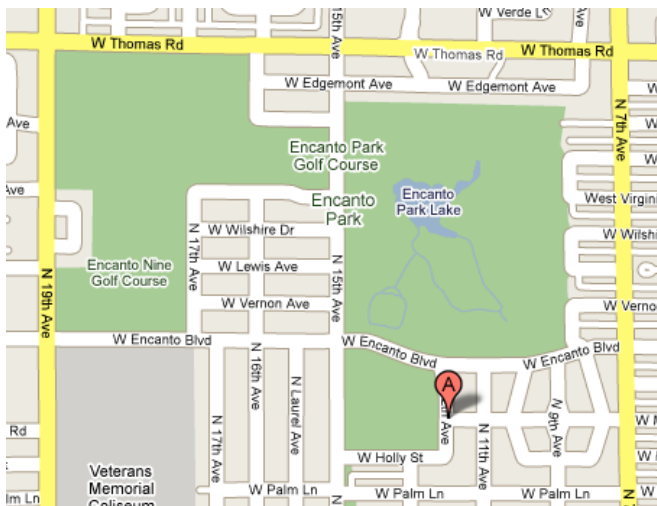


Atenveldt Baronial Fighter Practice

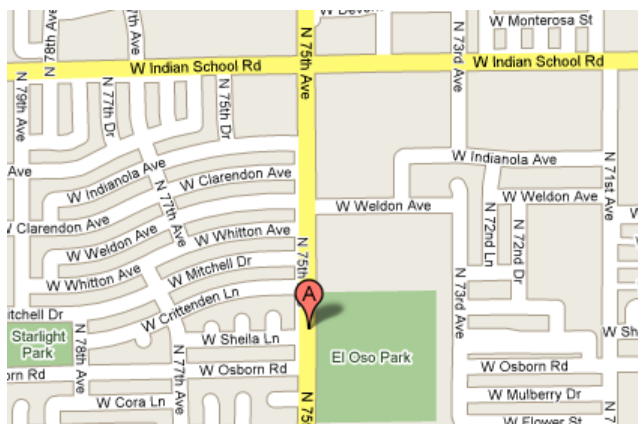
