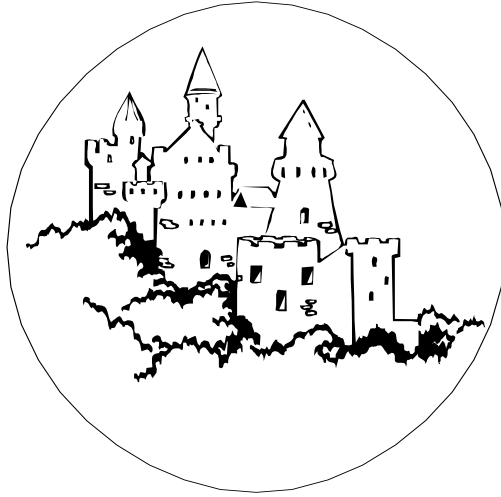

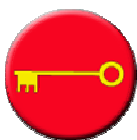

From the Seneschal



A proposal from the BOD has been generated concerning the status of the water bearer's office in the SCA. In short there are concerns about compliance between local food safety laws and the water bearers. The BOD is considering elimination of the office as a way to reduce the legal exposure to the SCA due to illness transmitted through the water bearer's efforts. The BOD is asking that members comment on the proposal by October 1. Issues to be considered in an individuals review of the proposal and in any comments to it:

- Can the water bearers office be mandated by the SCA to be in compliance with local health regulations without undue burden on the local groups?
- Can alternates to the current protocols be implemented to eliminate the health code risks?
- Will the proposal actually provide any reduction in risk to the SCA from fines and or lawsuits?
- Should the SCA provide any water service at all to its participants?
- Will this proposal be the first step down the path of eliminating feasts at events due to similar concerns?

As a group in a desert environment the availability of water at events is of substantially higher safety concern than in many Kingdoms and the potential for impact to our activates is greater than for most locations. While this topic has been halted on the online discussion groups by no means should the debate be considered closed. Participants should remember that this is an inflammatory topic, that there will be strongly held beliefs counter to any comments, and that even the best of ideas can have consequences that were not apparent in formulating the argument. Any argument that cannot be resolved satisfactory with wet sponges at 15' in August heat is probably being taken more personally than necessary for this topic. The BOD will welcome any and all comments to this proposal. As it is not uncommon for a proposal to receive less than a few dozen responses; please take the time to send in your opinions.

### The OP You need to Check!

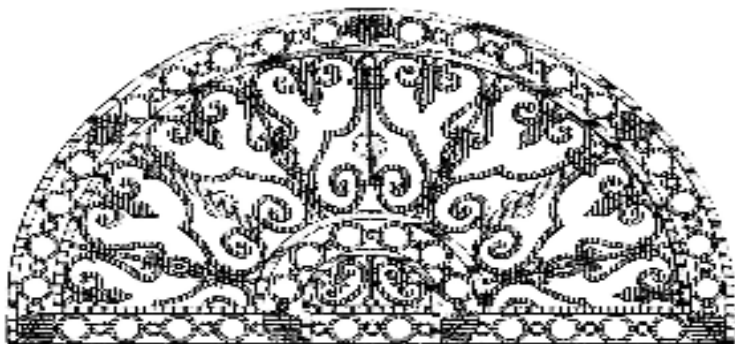

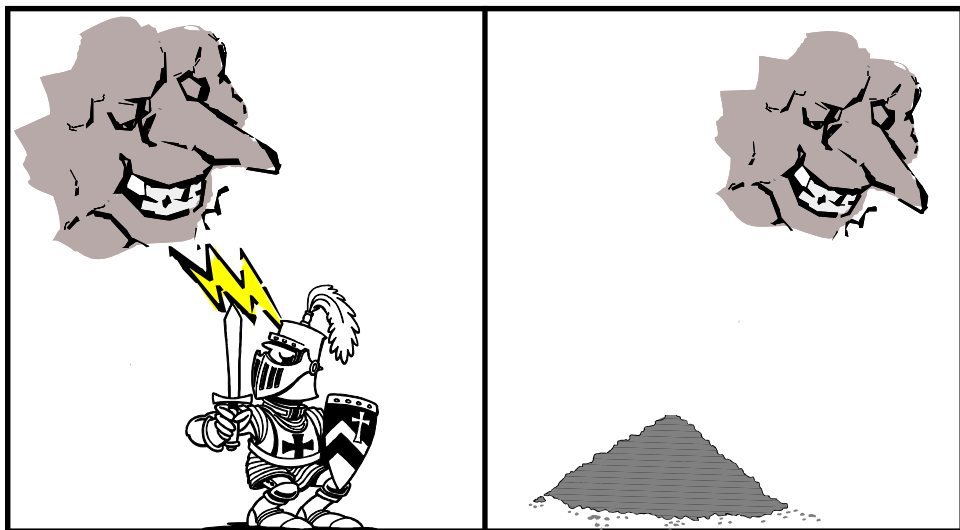


## *Outdoor Events In Atenveldt*

It's that time of year again when both the temperature and humidity compete to be first to reach triple digits each day. It's the rainy season for Atenveldt and along with the rain comes lightning. As a general rule anyone outdoors should be following a 30/30 rule. If you see a flash of lighting and thunder follows within 30 seconds move indoors, and do not come back until 30 minutes after the lighting stops. Sound travels roughly 5 miles per second so if there is 15 seconds or less between a flash and the thunder that strike was less than 3 miles away, the next strike could very easily be you. It's only a single fighter practice, only a single event; why risk your life. After all we're holding another practice next week anyway.

### **Other safety hints from NOAA**

- Stay away from tall trees - they are much more likely to be hit by lightning than almost everything shorter in the area. You are not safe until you are twice as far away from a tree than it is tall.
- Do not be the tallest thing around. Waving a spear in the air is generally not the way to be the shortest thing in the field.
- Stay away from groups of people. Remember that lightning forks frequently, if one person is hit those around them will be also.
- Do not keep any metal objects on you. Helmet, knees, elbows, scale armor... should be obvious. Keep in mind that lightning is also very hot, 50,000 Deg F hot. Do you really want to be wearing a metal can on your head that just got zapped by a 50,000 Deg F blowtorch? How long do you think it will take for that helmet to cool down? How long does it take you to take a helmet off?

"GPS is not recommended to find Mormon Lake Lodge, as there have been many people stranded by the bad roads these routes can take you on. Be forewarned: the most direct routes (and therefore GPS routes) often traverse unmaintained forest service roads!

Volunteers are needed for all areas! Please view the website for the Staff List of venues that may be of interest to you.

Mormon Lake Lodge is proud to be an all green facility! Please do recycle when possible and please take all large items BACK home with you! (We would really like to keep this site for years to come)

**Site fees are as follows:** Adult with proof of membership arriving on Thursday = \$35, Friday = \$30, Saturday = \$25. If you do not have proof of membership you will need another \$3. Children 9-18 = \$10. Children 8 and under are free.

**Site information:** No water is available on site, please bring plenty of water for drinking, cooking and extinguishing camp fires. Water must be screened. This means you must remove all large particles from water before placing grey water on the ground.

All fires must be in a contained above ground fire pit. No open flame. Torches, candles and the like must have a wire mesh. All camps are required to have one fire extinguisher for every fire pit and one for every kitchen. Disposal of ashes, partially burnt wood, or un-burnt wood must be removed to designated points. Minor curfews will be in effect as per SCA regulations and all minors will require correct and up to date waivers. Pets will be allowed with proof of rabies vaccine, tagged with owners name and must be leashed at all times.

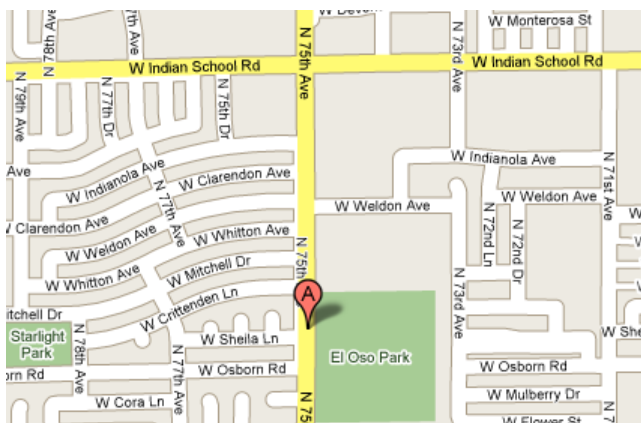

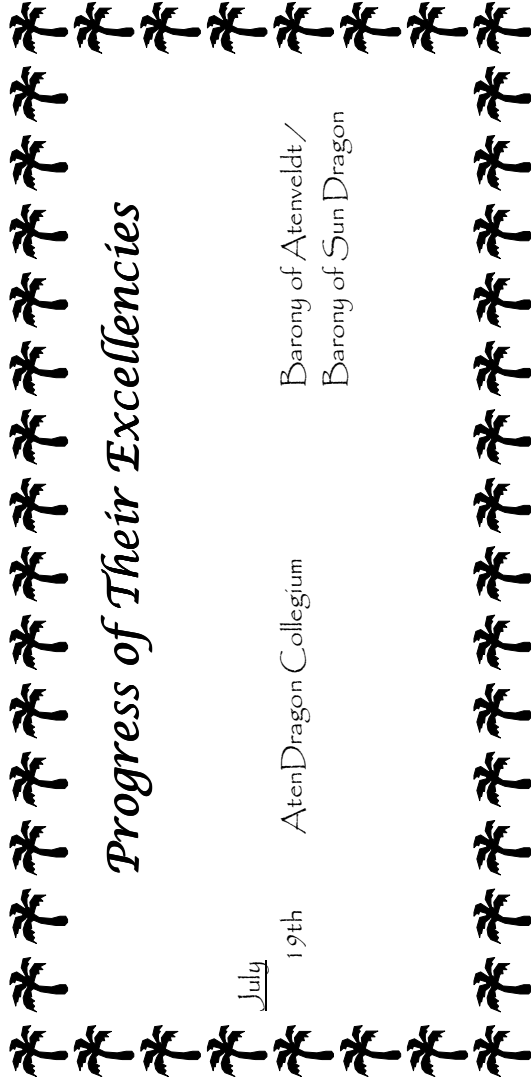
