
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*GREETINGS FROM

## **Guidelines for Baronial Letters of Intent and Baronial Polling**

Unto the populace of the Barony of Atenveldt:

### **Letters of Intent**

Their Excellencies Otto and Lisabetta will soon complete their three-year warrant. Therefore, in accordance with Kingdom Law, Their Royal Majesties, Walrick and Cecilia are accepting Letters of Intent from qualified couples who wish to be considered as candidates for the position of Baron and Baroness. To be eligible for this position, candidates must be paid members of the SCA and reside within the zip codes assigned to the Barony of Atenveldt. Letters of Intent should be sent to the Crown and Heirs (when known) with copies to the Kingdom Seneschal and the current Baron and Baroness of Atenveldt. Letters may be sent by either US Mail or email. **Letters of intent must be received by April 30, 2009.**

The following information must be included in your Letter of Intent.

- Full contact information that includes both modern and SCA names, complete mailing address, phone number(s), and email addresses
- Proof of current membership
- A statement of your reasons for seeking the position
- A statement of your plans and dreams for the future of the Barony
- A brief statement of your history of participation in the Barony and within the SCA
- A statement that you fully understand the responsibilities of the positions of Baron and Baroness and that you are willing to commit to a three year term of office
- A statement that you understand that, if accepted as a candidate by the Crown and Heirs (when known), your Letter of Intent will be published in the May Baronial newsletter.

### **Polling**

A polling of the current paid members of the Barony of Atenveldt will be conducted on June 6th, 2009 at Kingdom A&S Collegium, hosted by the Barony of Atenveldt. The polling will be held from 12:30 pm to 2:30 pm. If the results of that polling do not show a clear preference, a second run-off polling will be held immediately following the closing and tabulation of ballots from the first poll. Members are encouraged to remain onsite should a second poll be necessary.

To participate in the polling, you must possess a valid SCA membership that is listed in the zip codes assigned to the Barony of Atenveldt and be eighteen years of age or

older. Current membership will be verified on a membership list at the polling site, or you may present an online membership renewal confirmation that is dated after the Milpitas Registry Office List was generated. **A driver's license or government picture ID will also be required to be shown to prove age and identity.**

There may be some SCA members who do not reside within the zip codes currently assigned to the Barony but who play exclusively in the Barony and consider themselves as active members of the group. These individual will be allowed to cast a ballot of a different color after signing a statement agreeing to not participate in the polling of any other group in the kingdom for the next three years.

### **Absentee Ballots**

Proxy ballots are NOT allowed. If you are unable to attend the polling, you may follow the procedures below to submit an Absentee Ballot Letter. **No exceptions** will be made to the timeline or contents for an Absentee ballot to be counted, so review the requirements carefully, and send your letters in as soon as the candidates are announced.

You must write a letter to the Kingdom Seneschal stating your preference in the poll. Your absentee ballot must be RECEIVED by May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009 to be counted. DO NOT require a signature at delivery on a mailed ballot, as that will delay delivery. If there is a second polling, absentee ballots will only be counted if the preferred candidates remain in the run-off polling. Your letter must include ALL of the following

- The names of one and only one couple you prefer as candidates.
- Your modern and SCA name and the mailing address for your membership, including zip code.
- Proof of membership (Any one of membership number, photocopy of membership card, photocopy of *Southwind* label, photocopy of confirmation printout from online membership renewal)
- Photocopy of a driver's license or government ID showing your modern name, zip code, and proof that you are 18 years of age or older.
- If you do not reside within the zip codes currently assigned to the Barony but consider yourself as a member thereof, your absentee ballot must include the following signed statement: "I consider myself a member of the populace of the Barony of Atenveldt and promise the Crown of Atenveldt that I will not cast a ballot in any polling for another group within the Kingdom for three years following June 6th, 2009."



This year we will be at a new site, Washington High School located at 2217 W Glendale Ave Phoenix, AZ 85021. This is an excellent location, situated just East of I-17 on Glendale Ave. So, it is fairly centralized and easy to get to. Approximately one mile to the North is a series of budget hotels that continues for several miles making it easy for those traveling from out of town to find accommodations. Dame Jennifer Trethewy has graciously agreed to be our “Crash-space Coordinator“ for those looking to ease their budget.

The site will open at 8:00am on Saturday with Troll opening at 8:30 and classes beginning at 9:00am. There will be a one hour lunch break at 12:00 noon where a small side board will be offered. Classes will resume at 1:00pm and continue to 4:00pm. Kingdom Court will commence from 4:00pm to 6:00pm or at Their Majesties discretion. Site will close at 6:00pm or when court ends. The following day site and Troll will open at 8:30am with classes beginning at 9:00am. Classes will continue for 4 hours, ending at 1:00pm and the site will close at 1:30pm.

Because this is a public high school, this will be a dry site and there is no smoking

allowed on premises. However, brewing classes will be permitted as long as there is no drinkable alcohol used on site.

The October and November ledgers are ready for inspection. Parks cost \$ 2700.00 and sites cost \$ 3400. The budget was discussed.

IV List: There are no tournaments done during war season. There will be a hard-suit tournament in March. The baldrics for the youth fighters came out great.

V Arts & Sciences: February was quite. She has plans for the April 11<sup>th</sup> event. Lady Susanna has agreed to take over the Waiver Table.

VI Heralds/Scribe: There was one submission on Wednesday. Thank you for the prizes for the siege tournament and the Bardic. Scriptoriums are the second and fourth Fridays. Dame Jennifer and others will be teaching classes.

VII Hospitler: She will be unavailable for the next six weeks. She is looking for somebody that can talk to the newcomers in the mean time.

VIII Sherriff: His warrant has been renewed and his name has past it is now Morgan Mc Duff.

Old Business:

I Estrella War: Things went excellent at the War. WE won all four banners.

II April Event: This event will be held at dessert horizon. This is located on 56d street north of Greenway. There will be a bake sale, basket auction and possibly other fundraising activities. IV Breads: Breads were made at East Valley. They are willing to let us use the ovens.


V Dance Classes: THL Ritchyrd reports that dance classes will be the second to last Wednesday of each month. He also says to send all the newcomers his way.






