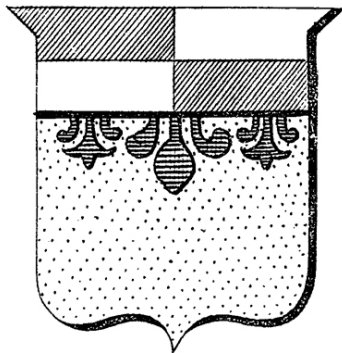

This week only, BofA Wednesday FP is at my place, as a post-Highlands bring-your-own barbecue Baronial relaxappractice. (The rest of the summer through August, we are indeed at Barrios Unidos. Come September, we're back at Encanto.)

Location: NE corner of Longview and Osborn in Phoenix, park on Longview, enter the large, lighted, barbecue-equipped back yard through the carport on that side. (Longview is between 12th and 16th St on Osborn. See Baronial website for clearer directions.

Word of the Month!

Carpe Diem

This month's word or, more accurately, phase is commonly mis-translated as, "seize the day." The more accurate translation of carpe is 'pluck'.¹ There is a more extended version of the phrase which is 'carpe diem, quam minimum credula postero' and translates to 'Pluck the day, trusting as little as possible in the future'.² This phrase we would assume to be quite ancient and in fact while the phrase originally seen in Latin in the *Odes Book 1* by the poet Quintus Horatius Flaccus its translation and more common usage in English is much newer. The English use is so new that it actually dates outside of our Current Middle Ages time frame and places it in 1817 with the works of Lord Byron. Even with these discrepancies of sorts, we shouldn't hesitate to take advantage of the opportunities presented to us and let us 'pluck' our days while they are ripe for the taking.

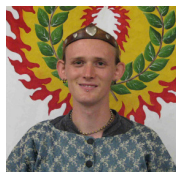

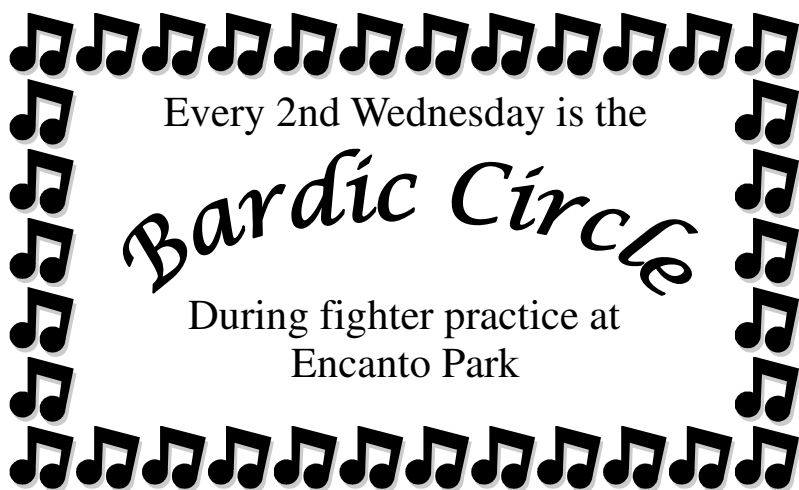

A Suggested Time Table for any Future, First Time Autocrats

From a first time autocrat that learned
the hard way and is still learning

This is an overview of all the suggestions made to me by those far more experienced to correct my rookie mistakes before, during and after the event. There were many people that helped me along the way and the after-the-event autocrat staff meeting was truly enlightening. This is where I learned the most. I have also had several people make suggestions since the event to help me streamline the process in the future and this is by no means my work, but a collection of all the good advice that I received. Some of it took repeated reminders from several people who will be thanked at the end of this article to finally get through.

The first thing I will say is that the time table can be condensed if you have the staff to do so by shortening things from 10 months down to eight. Just take everything from the list for 10 months, 9 months, and 8 months and do all of it in the 8 month area. You should not attempt to condense it down any further because this would make it very difficult to get the bid completed and turned in on time. You will also find that you want to be able to spread things out and double check yourselves as often as possible between the time the bid is approved and two months before the event.

The day before the event:

If possible, have everyone on your staff load their vehicles so that you and your staff can be the first ones on site. It will help if you are there early to direct the set up and talk to the officers and group leaders before things get too busy. Be prepared for a lot of last minute questions. And relax, by know everything is so well prepared and planned out that there should be hardly any problems if any and they should be minor ones. As much as you have worked with everyone and talked with them, everyone should know exactly what they are doing and there is nothing more that can be done at this point until something comes up.
