We, the autocrats, want this year to be a celebration of the accomplishments of this amazing populace over the last 4 years. We will be providing a lunch time feast prepared by Master Voron for everyone to enjoy! If you have someone you want to bring out to introduce them to the SCA this event is one that will enamor them with the "stardust". There will be a youth corner with crafts & games to entertain your young ones. A&S display area and Merchants are welcome; we just ask that they contact an autocrat for details.

Archery tournament will be held on January 26th at the normal Atenveldt/Sundragon practice.

Artisans and masters from all over the kingdom have in the past donated amazing and beautiful works of artistry, to the silent auction. We are excited to receive their donations again this year. This is a magnificent opportunity to own amazing pieces of hand crafted art as well as the occasional random or amazing bits of Atenveldt history.

For those who may not have heard of Rett Syndrome here is a brief description of this syndrome and how it affects these Angels.

Rett Syndrome is a severe neurological disorder the primarily affects girls. Rett Syndrome is the most physically disabling of the autism spectrum disorders. Rett Syndrome is caused by a mutation in the gene MECP2 –a protein that regulates the expression of other genes by turning them off at the appropriate time. The mutation is spontaneous and the effects are seen in early childhood between 6 to 18 months of age. The disorder destroys speech, movement, and functional hand use. Many children lose the ability to walk, they struggle daily with severe seizures, scoliosis, breathing abnormalities, and often the child becomes dependent on others for a lifetime of care. These children's normal life expectancy is to the age of 14 to 17.

Estrella War Knowne World Rapier Camp
So you came to Estrella War early. So you get to fight early. Join the other early arrivals and enjoy the camaraderie. The Early Bird Tournament is for those Rapier fighters who are on site and ready to fight early in the War. It will be a five weapons style prize tourney. Bring a prize valued at \$10-\$20 to enter. There will be as many fights as possible, with everyone fighting every round, and prizes will be given out based on the number of fights won. Heavy Rapier is the standard, but Cut & Thrust is encouraged for those authorized.

Atenveldt allowable blade conventions will be observed. Parrying devices, armor, and weapons will be inspected before each tournament by Tournament Marshals and designees. Armor standards are those of your home kingdom.

All authorized rapier fighters must provide proof of their authorization in Heavy Rapier / Cut & Thrust Rapier, or else have a Marshal from their Kingdom vouch for them. Sponsored by the Company of the Sable Blade

An SCA Heraldic Consultation center is operated at Herald's Points so attendees may consult with SCA Heralds to select an appropriate SCA name and/or design a unique heraldic device that they can register with the SCA College of Arms. This consultation is free to everyone in the SCA, although the SCA College of Arms does charge a small registration fee when the name or device you wish to use is sent to them for review and registration. Please note that sign-up for Consultation closes one hour before the Table closes for the day.

Barres Wednesday, February 26, 2014, 3:00pm & Sunday, March 2, 2014, 1:00pm
Town Square, Sports Field
Barres is an adult game played thusly:

The game is played on a rectangular field. At both ends, in each of the corners a base square is laid out. Base A is in the upper right hand corner and Base B is in the lower right corner. Opposite end of the field the bases are reversed, Base A is in the lower left corner and Base B is in the upper left hand corner. Base A and B on the right side of the field represent the teams prison and the opposite side of the field their freedom.

The game is played with two Captains and two Lieutenants, each with ten players. Both teams start with all of their team members in prison. The Captains are both placed in the center of the field. The Lieutenants to the sidelines, only one prisoner can try and escape from their prison at a time. They must avoid being tackled by the opposing Captain and make it to their freedom square on the opposite side of the field. If they are brought to ground, they go back to prison to wait their turn to try an escape again, and the next prisoner attempts to escape. The Captains can choose to be replaced by their Lieutenant

(but only once during the course of play). The team who gets all of their prisoners out of prison and into the freedom square first wins.

Badminton, bocci and croquet will be set up and awaiting your pleasure to play, daily between the hours of 8 AM - 5 PM. No check out required this year.

Shuttlecock was played with a cork with feathers stuck into it and was batted about by a wooden paddle, later to develop into paddles strung with fiber. With the addition of a net, shuttlecock became badminton. Bocci ball has its origin in period lawn bowling games in which involved each player to roll a ball down the lawn and try to knock over his opponent's cone in the fewest moves. There were several variants of croquet in the middle ages known as Ring-Ball, Club-Ball and Trap Ball.

You are invited to bring your personal board games and play them as well. The board/table games will be set up and awaiting your pleasure in the Food Court pavilion, from 8 AM - 5 PM. No check out required this year.

Chess was invented in India, spread by the Persians and by the eleventh century made it into every upper class home in Europe. Backgammon has its ancient roots in Roman times, and it too was spread throughout the Mediterranean and was introduced into Europe. As with chess, many, many versions were in existence. The earliest mention of dominoes is from Song Dynasty China. Dominoes first appeared in Italy during the 18th century, it is speculated that Italian missionaries in China may have brought the game to Europe.

Men's Skirts Tournament will be a five weapons style prize tourney (Bring a prize valued at \$10-\$20 to enter.). Everyone will fight every round, and prizes will be given out based on the number of fights won. As the name suggests, only males can sign up and they must wear a skirt. Acceptable skirts include dresses, full length skirts, and kilts (all exposed skin must be covered according to SCA Rapier armor standards). Fighters and their consorts may add other "accessories" as they wish.
