After dark, due to unforeseen weather issues at Barmaids, we will be holding the adult Barmaids competition. This will be an adults-only portion of the event. There is expected to be fierce competition, bring on your best!

Sunday: The Baron's Champion, Baroness' Champion, and Baronial Archery Champions will be determined. While only members of Mons Tonitrus may declare for Championship, all are invited to compete. Closing court to follow. Site closes at 3:00 pm.

Site is wet, but has no water, so bring your own, as well trash bags to carry yours out. Leashed pets are welcome. If no fire restrictions are in place, then fires in above ground pits only. Special needs attendees or those seeking hotel information or crash space should contact the Event Steward.

Directions: Take I-10 East to Exit 302 (Hwy 90 to Ft. Huachuca/Sierra Vista). Drive South on Highway 90 and turn right at Hwy 90 and Fry Blvd to the Ft Huachuca Main gate. After entering Ft. Huachuca, follow signs to Lower Garden Canyon.

All adults required to show government-issued identification, and possibly registration and proof of insurance. Foreign nationals must be signed in by an ID Card holder, please inform the Event Steward as soon as possible to ensure ease of access. The Barony of Granite Mountain welcomes you to attend Their Aten Majesties, Craven and Elzbieta as they witness the trials of these noble fighters during Atenveldt Crown List.

The battlefield is Watson Lake Park, four miles north of Prescott, Arizona. The day is September 6, 2014. Crown list will take place on Saturday, followed by Warlord Tournament on Sunday. The site fee is \$10 for members with a \$5 non-member surcharge. The park will charge \$2 per car for parking. Young people under the age of 18 may attend free of charge. The site is wet and smoking is permitted in designated areas unless the park determines fire hazards are high. We welcome well-behaved pets on leashes. Water spigots offer potable water. The neighboring campgrounds are open for camping with a fee of \$15 per campsite, payable to the park ranger.

Special note: The park does allow us to stake our tents, but please exercise caution to avoid marked water lines.

From Flagstaff: Take I-40 west toward Los Angeles for 44.8 miles to exit 146 for AZ-89 S toward Ash Fork/Prescott. Turn left onto AZ-89 S for 37.5 miles. At the traffic circle, star on AZ-89 S. Continue 9 miles to 2nd traffic circle. Take the 3rd edit onto Watson Lake Park Road.

From Kingman: Take the I-40 for 96.3 miles to exit 146 for AZ-89 S toward Ash Fork/Prescott. Turn right onto AZ-89 S for 37.5 miles. At the traffic circle, star on AZ-89 S. Continue 9 miles to 2nd traffic circle. Take the 3rd edit onto Watson Lake Park Road.

It is part of the "living history" movement, where members try to reproduce various aspects of the culture and technology of their period, as well as pursuing more traditional historical research. The SCA sponsors events such as medieval tournaments and feasts, where members dress in Medieval and Renaissance styles, and participate in activities based on the civil and martial arts of the Middle Ages. We use the medieval term "Chirurgeon" instead of "first aider," "first responder," or "medic" in our efforts to maintain a medieval atmosphere at SCA events. We also use the Medieval bloodletting device, the fleam, as the symbol of the Chirurgeonate instead of the modern red short armed cross whose use is restricted by international treaty to organizations affiliated with the International Red Cross and the military.

The members of the Chirurgeonate include Red Cross-trained first aiders, medical doctors, military medical corpsmen, nurses, paramedics, St. John's and St. Andrew's ambulance volunteers, and many other medical volunteers and professionals. We come from all walks of life and from many countries around the globe. We are united as members of the Chirurgeonate for one purpose: to provide first aid at SCA events.

The members of the Chirurgeonate provide first aid on a volunteer basis at SCA events. First aid performed in the SCA is Good Samaritan in nature, and is provided to anyone who asks at no cost to the recipient. This has been our tradition ever since Bjo of Griffin, arguably the first-known Chirurgeon, started bringing her first-aid kit to SCA events, back in the days when there was but a single Kingdom.
