Emergency Deputy Herald - assist with field heraldry, court heraldry and possible book heraldry. Position open till filled


Emergency Deputy Rapier Marshall - assist the marshal as needed, may need to become qualified as an authorizing marshal. Position open till filled


A&S Corner


Barony of Atenveldt Fighter Practice


Barony of Atenveldt Archery Practice

Thrown Weapons practice is held at 4500 N. 13th Pl. Phoenix, AZ. Practice starts at 6pm. Next practice will be on November 21st.





Barony of Atenveldt Scriptorium
