GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION AS A BARONIAL CANDIDATE:

Baronial candidates must be current paid members, and must receive their Southwind or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt.

Candidates must be at least 18 years old.

Candidates must have **Letters of Intent** in the hands of the Crown, the Kingdom Seneschal, and the Baron and Baroness no later than **October 28, 2016**. Letters should be written with the understanding that (if accepted by the Crown), the letters will be published in The Palm Prints for the populace to review prior to the polling.

Candidates must include the below information in their Letter of Intent:

- Full contact information, including SCA and modern names, addresses, phone numbers, email, and membership numbers and expiration date

- Their reasons for seeking the position

- Their history of participation in the SCA and the Barony of Atenveldt

- Their plans for the future of the group

- Their understanding of the responsibilities of the position of Baron and Baroness.

- Their statement that they are willing to be installed with a three-year warrant in the position, and understand their Letter of Intent will be published in The Palm Prints if their candidacy is accepted by the Crown.

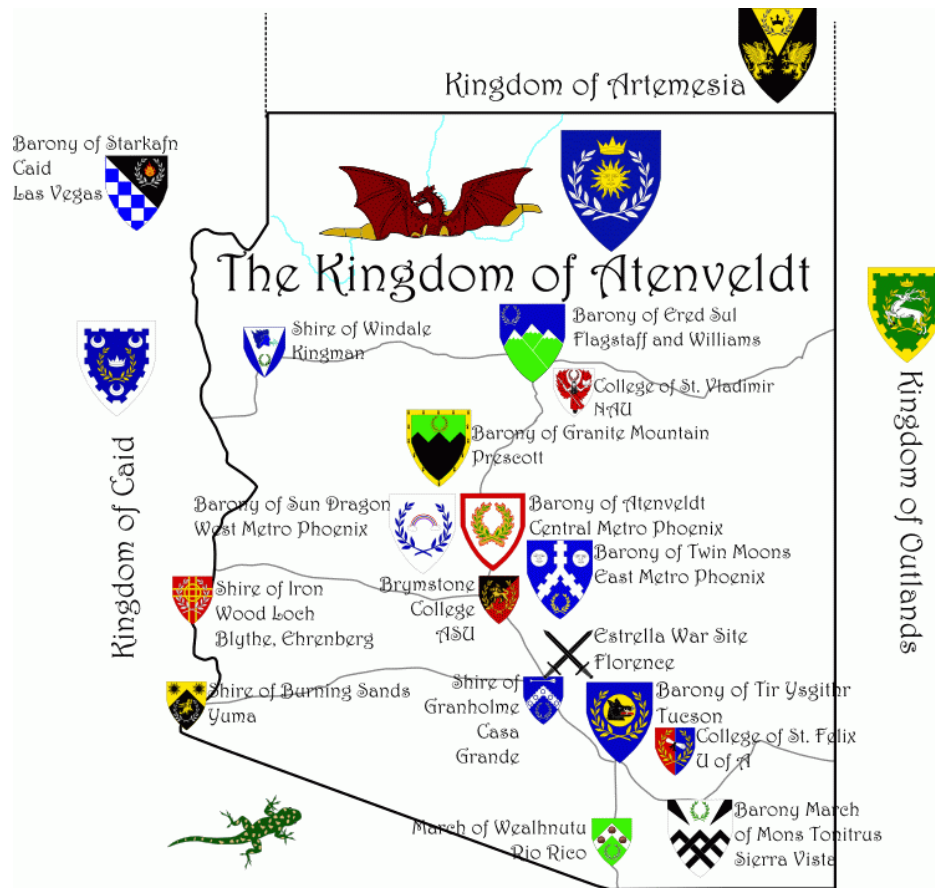

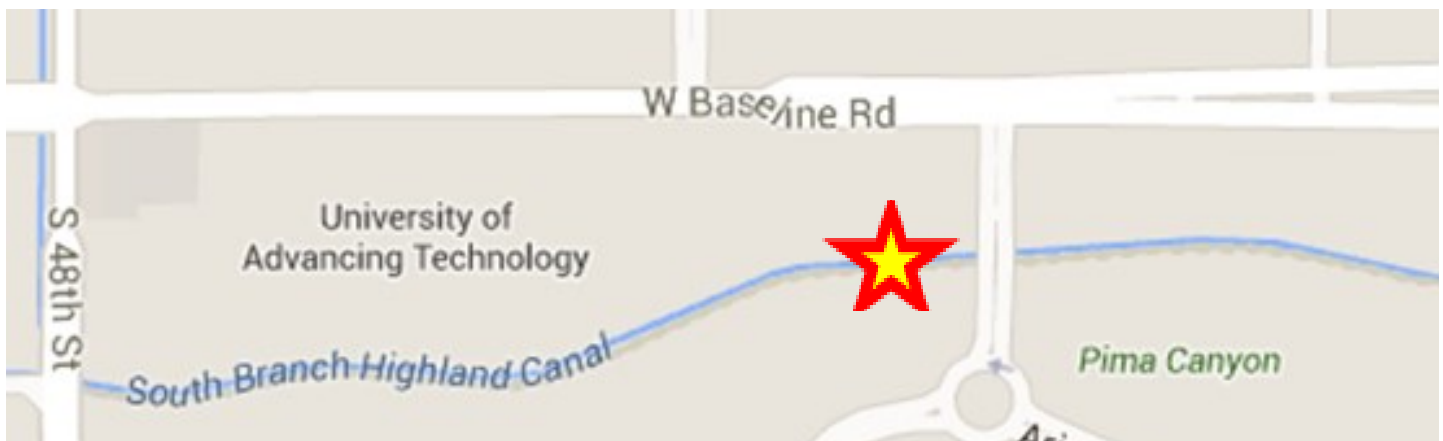

The A & S competition is open to all artisans; you do not have to declare for champion to enter and you are not required to submit a minimum of three items. Documentation, however, is required of all items submitted.

This year, the competition will be judged on October 15, the week before the actual Champions event (location TBD). The reason for this change is to allow the judges to take their time with the judging and to allow them to enjoy the actual event instead of spending the whole day sequestered in a tent. Once the judging is completed, the items will be held and then displayed at the event for a populace choice vote. The competition winner, populace choice winner and the new champion will be announced in the final Court of the event.

Site location is Horseshoe Lake in the northeast area beyond Phoenix. Please take your best route up Cave creek Road through or around the town of Cave Creek till you are at the Intersection of Cave Creek Rd. and Pima, From there take Cave Creek Road to the Bartlett Dam Road and turn right on Bartlett Dam Road. From Bartlett Dam Road take it until the Horseshoe Dam Road and turn Left on Horseshoe Dam Road. Take Horseshoe Dam Road, past the campgrounds, till you see the site on the right. (Continue past the site and end up in the lake).

Site Opens 12pm Friday Oct 21st, 2016 and Closes 5pm on Sunday Oct. 23rd, 2016.

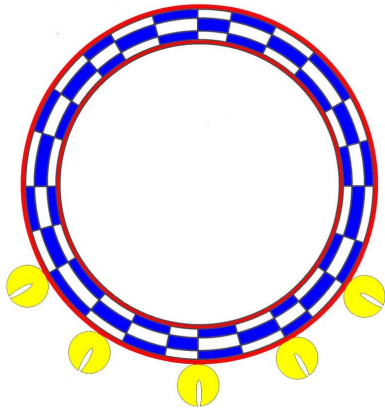

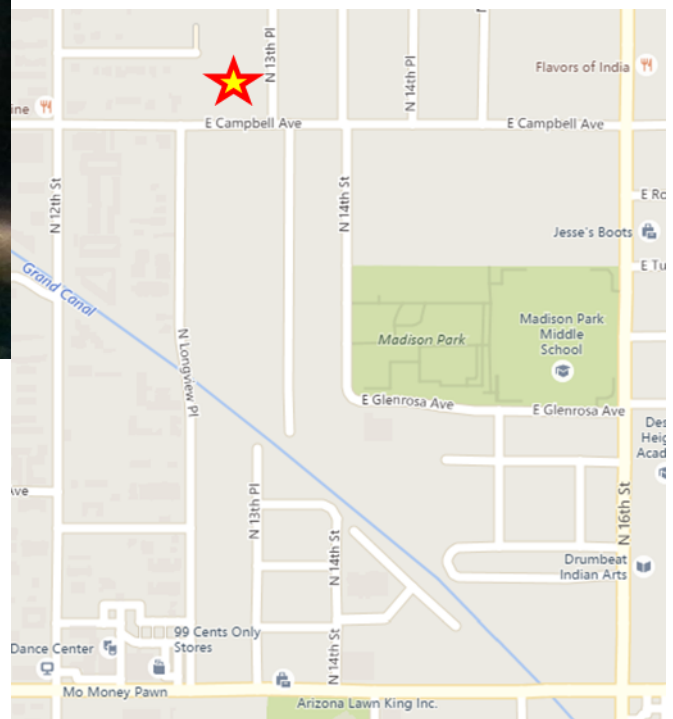
thrown weapons
