Emergency Deputy Herald - assist with field heraldry, court heraldry and possible book heraldry. Position open till filled


Emergency Deputy Rapier Marshall - assist the marshal as needed, may need to become qualified as an authorizing marshal. Position open till filled

There will be both hard-suit and rapier tournaments to determine The Captains of the Guard on Saturday, March 19th. The hard-suit Great Helm Tournament is standard single opponent, double elimination sword and shield.

The rapier Captain of the Guard tournament style will be a Round Robin, giving all fighters a chance to battle every other fighter. The final round will be fought between the two highest scoring fighters from the day. Cut and Thrust will be permitted at fighter discretion.








Thrown Weapons


