Highlands War XXII July 7th, 2016 to July 10, 2016

Greetings unto the Knowne World! The Barony of Ered Sul, in the glorious Kingdom of Atenveldt, invites you to the cool pines of the mountains where we are very proud to host HIGHLANDS WAR XXII, March on the Silk Road, ROMA v PARTHIA.

We invite all from East and West, North and South, to march on the Silk Road (Rt 66) for the glory of war, revelry, and companionship. In history, 53 BC the city of Carrhae and a small region of Parthia along the Silk Road, were liberated from Roman occupation, allowing trade to flow across the land once more.

The Silk Road had many traders and travelers, but had its share of dangers along the way.

Protection from bandits and mercenaries were needed and caravans often had armed soldiers guarding the journey. Since ancient times this historic route has helped travelers transport goods across many lands, has allowed trade between distant cultures, and had made the world a smaller place.

On July 7--10th, 2016, these cultures will meet in celebration, in war, and in friendship in the Barony of Ered Sul; the most northern Barony in the glorious Kingdom of Atenveldt! There will be something for everyone at Highlands War, scheduled activities will include:

Hardsuit and Rapier/Light fighting scenarios including two different battle pits and a functioning castle

There will be No Food Vendors; This site does not have water spigots on site or electrical outlets. Coconino County has very specific requirements for Food Vendors who are preparing food to sell to the public. One can't use coolers (Yeti, Coleman, Igloo, etc.) to keep food in, so that would require a refrigeration source (constant temperature) to store food in, which would either be run by a generator, solar/battery setup, or electrical source. Food Vendors must also use a three sink washing system with water source for washing dishes and food prep. We are working on some other options, but would suggest people provide their own food sources (maybe ask if anyone is doing a kitchen you could buy into, etc.). Thank you for your understanding.

There will be areas available for RVs and grey water disposal containers. This is National Forest land and a primitive, forested site. Forest rules must be observed at all times. Failure to do so may result in your removal from site with no refund. The forests are everyone's responsibility and we know that our SCA family will help in our efforts to protect them. Land/Camping space will be 'first come, first serve', however, we wish to insure those traveling from far away lands to have quality camp experience. A section of land will be reserved for our out of state guests. Please note that campers, trailers, and pop-ups are considered RVs for this event and the autocrats require them to be set up with the RVs. Vardos can camp with tents.

Where: Ashurst Lake in Flagstaff, AZ. From Phoenix, take the I-17 North to Flagstaff. Exit onto Lake Mary Road. Go East on Lake Mary road about 19 miles. Turn North at the Ashurst Lake turnoff and follow signs about 1 mile to the site.

Dates/Time: 7 – 10 July 2016 Thursday 8 am through 4pm on Sunday

Fees: Adults \$35 (Member Discount \$5), \$25 Sat/Sun

Children (0--12) Free

Saturday ONLY day trip fee: \$10

Bring your sommelier cup and a clean pallet. Crews will be working together to share period pottages, breads, and brews all while bending your ear with stories of inspiration and artisanship.

Two fully equipped ramadas await you, complete with drinking water, six huge charcoal barbecues w/ pole for lantern, electricity, bear proof food and trash container and tables with seating. Paved road right up to the site!

Cast your voting token into the box of the crew that best makes their impression on you. Perhaps it was how well they please your pallet. Perhaps their pageantry and décor pushes them over the top. Perhaps it was their bard that boasts best

for them in the toast. It will be up to you to decide who has best demonstrated their prowess of the arts this day. Bring your feast gear and help clean-up the left-overs.

Feeling tough? Think you got what it takes to fight uphill, in hard suit, in high altitude (8000 feet)? Then this unique king of the hill battle is for you! Gather at Ramada #5 at 10 AM. Fighters will be divided into two teams. Team #1 defends the top of the hill and Team #2 charges up the hill to claim it for their own. Point goes to the team that claims the top of the hill. Team # 2 then becomes the defenders and Team #1 assaults the hill. The winner is two out of three. Bragging and brews to the winning team!

Not to be denied, the above scenario will play out again, at 4 PM, except this time for the Rapier community.

Location: Sites 4 & 5 of the Whitetail loop on Mount Lemon.

Parking & Carpooling

On-site parking is very limited. Carpooling is a must in order to allow for the maximum people to attend. One parking permit, for one parking space, can be obtained through pre-registration. Permits are on a first come- first issued basis while parking spaces are available and you must carpool with at least two other people, to qualify.

Pre-registration begins on June 14, 2016. Permits can be obtained by contacting Lady Maria Isobel Falcon de la Sierra, either by phone or email (see contact information listed below) and will be made available at Tir Ysgithr's Tuesday night's fighter practice.

Parking in any other area on the mountain, in order to attend this event is not allowed by the Forest Service. Violators will be fined and their vehicles towed by the Sheriff's office.

Should you not be able to obtain a parking space, and wish to attend, please contact the Site Steward on or before July 1st. Arrangements can be made with Her Excellency for shuttle service.

Camping

There is space for modern tents for the night of Saturday the 16th, on a first-come first-serve basis. There are a number of 15 FT wide X 24 FT long designated flat camping surfaces, which will typically hold three to four modern tents each. You may also use any other space within sites Four and Five.

Come early to claim your spot!

Monsoon activity is possible, prepare for wet weather and possible cooler nighttime temperatures.

The altitude is 8000 feet. If you have breathing problems please bring needed medication/equipment.
