Help is always appreciated and gratefully accepted. If you want more details about any of these positions either contact the principal officer if there is one or the Seneschal's office.

Knight Marshal – authorizes fighters, makes sure all rules are followed and armor is safe, reports incidents, files monthly reports to the seneschal and kingdom marshal. Position open till filled.

Emergency Deputy Marshal - assist the marshal as needed, may need to become qualified as an authorizing marshal for hard-suit. Position open till filled.

Emergency Deputy Sheriff - assist sheriff as needed, works with lost and found, organizes and runs a watch at all baronial events, files monthly reports with the Kingdom Sheriff and the baronial seneschal - Position open till filled

Regalia - maintains baronial regalia and is responsible for making sure it gets to events - we currently have 2 deputies. Position open till filled

Emergency Deputy Herald - assist with field heraldry, court heraldry and possible book heraldry. Position open till filled

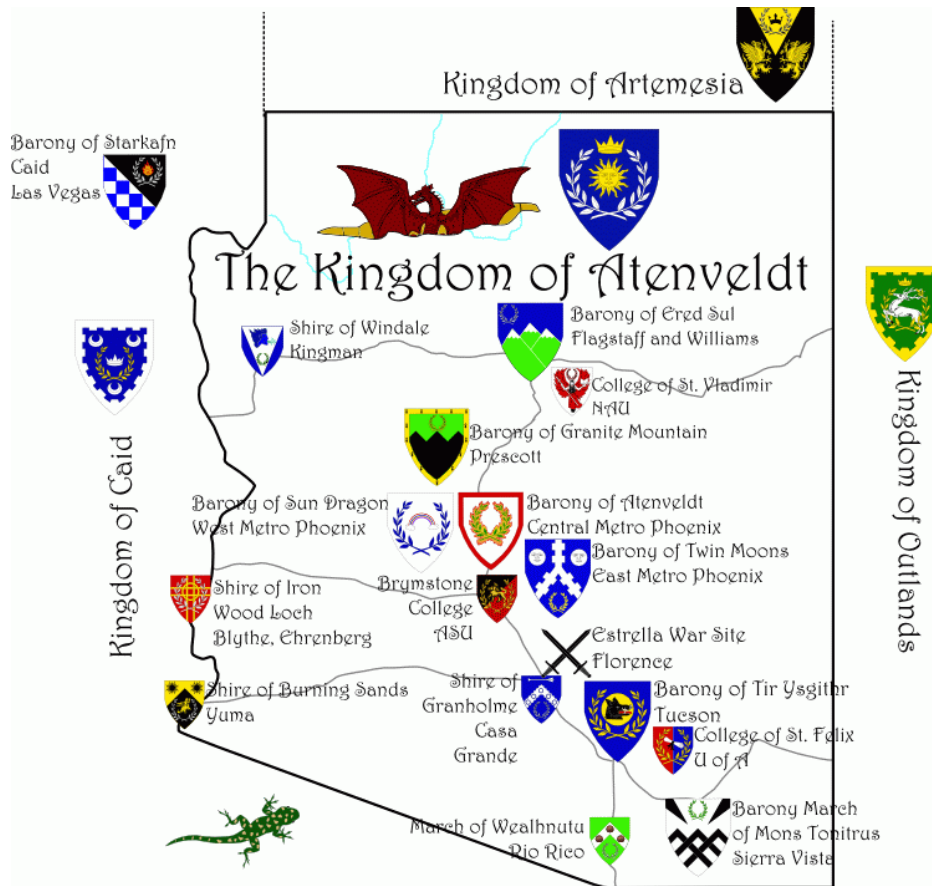
Emergency Deputy Rapier Marshall - assist the marshal as needed, may need to become qualified as an authorizing marshal. Position open till filled

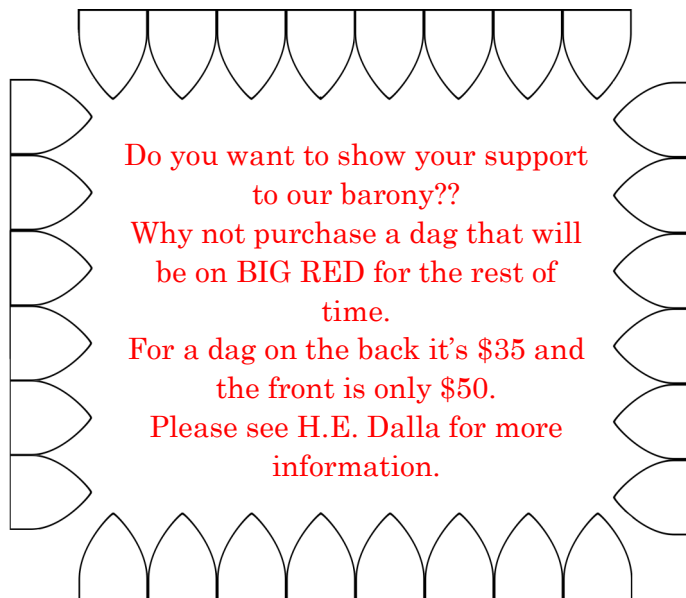

Submissions will be accepted at artsy@baronyofatenveldt.org or to a member of the arts department at a Barony of Atenveldt event or practice until November 15, 2016.

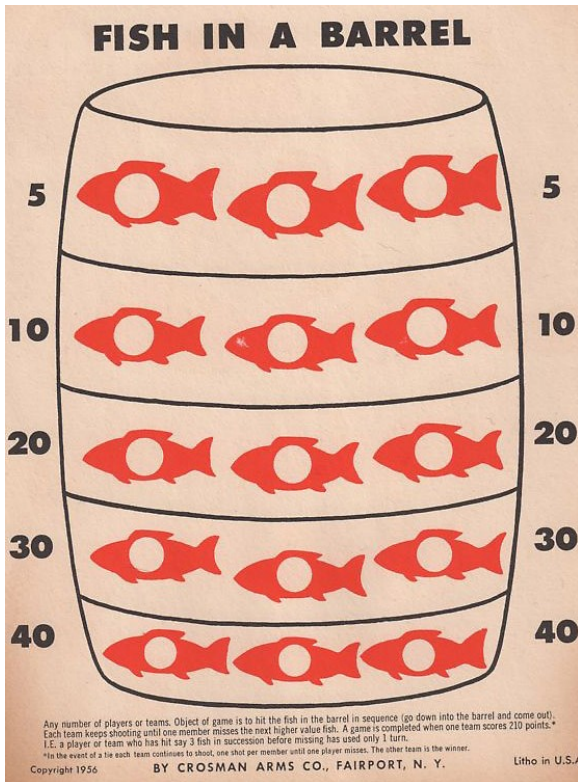

Archery 2nd Annual Carl Boteler Memorial Fish Shoot & Tournament

June 19th, 2016



Well folks June is not too far away, so it's time for the first announcement for the 2nd Annual Carl Boteler Memorial Fish Shoot and Tournament. June 19th, Father's Day at El Oso Park Phoenix. We will be shooting for the cool Fish Badges. While shooting for the badges we will also be scoring for the tournament. The scoring has changed for this year's shoot. For the Gold Badge round (1 arrow) a hit on the fish (badge earned) will count as 20 points, a hit on the mounting pad of the fish will count as 5 points and a hit on the target butt will count as 2 points. For the Black badge round (5 arrows) a fish hit (badge earned) will count as 20 points, a hit on the mounting pad will count as 3 points and a hit on the butt will count as 1 point. There will also be a clout round this year (6 arrows). If you hit a fish in the "pond" you will get a special fish badge and 25 points. Any arrow inside the pond without a fish kill will be worth 10 points. Prizes this year will include one fishing themed prize and two other prizes (the all fishing related prizes were not well received last year, so going to mix it up a little this year.) This will not be a garbed shoot as the temperatures are creeping up there and will be down right hot by June 19th. We will start at 7:30 AM. More announcements to follow, but mark your calendars now.

Highlands WAR XXII

July 7th to July 10th, 2016

Greetings unto the Knowne World! The Barony of Ered Sul, in the glorious Kingdom of Atenveldt, invites you to the cool pines of the mountains where we are very proud to host HIGHLANDS WAR XXII, March on the Silk Road, ROMA v PARTHIA.

We invite all from East and West, North and South, to march on the Silk Road (Rt 66) for the glory of war, revelry, and companionship. In history, 53 BC the city of Carrhae and a small region of Parthia along the Silk Road, were liberated from Roman occupation, allowing trade to flow across the land once more.

The Silk Road had many traders and travelers, but had its share of dangers along the way. Protection from bandits and mercenaries were needed and caravans often had armed soldiers guarding the journey. Since ancient times this historic

route has helped travelers transport goods across many lands, has allowed trade between distant cultures, and had made the world a smaller place.



On July 7--10th, 2016, these cultures will meet in celebration, in war, and in friendship in the Barony of Ered Sul; the most northern Barony in the glorious Kingdom of Atenveldt! There will be something for everyone at Highlands War, scheduled activities will include:

Hardsuit and Rapier/Light fighting scenarios including two different battle pits and a functioning castle

 Arts and Sciences, including silk banner competition by Barwn Meistr Gwylm ab Owain, OP, OL

 Siege weapons, war scenarios, and competitions

There will be No Food Vendors; This site does not have water spigots on site or electrical outlets. Coconino County has very specific requirements for Food Vendors who are preparing food to sell to the public. One can't use coolers (Yeti, Coleman, Igloo, etc.) to keep food in, so that would require a refrigeration source (constant temperature) to store food in, which would either be run by a generator, solar/battery setup, or electrical source. Food Vendors must also use a three sink washing system with water source for washing dishes and food prep. We are working on some other options, but would suggest people provide their own food sources (maybe ask if anyone is doing a kitchen you could buy into, etc.). Thank you for your understanding.

Performance Art

There will be areas available for RVs and grey water disposal containers. This is National Forest land and a primitive, forested site. Forest rules must be observed at all times.

Failure to do so may result in your removal from site with no refund. The forests are everyone's responsibility and we know that our SCA family will help in our efforts to protect them.

Land/Camping space will be 'first come, first serve', however, we wish to insure those traveling from far away lands to have quality camp experience. A section of land will be reserved for our out of state guests.

Where: Ashurst Lake in Flagstaff, AZ. From Phoenix, take the I-17 North to Flagstaff. Exit onto Lake Mary Road. Go East on Lake Mary road about 19 miles. Turn North at the Ashurst Lake turnoff and follow signs about 1 mile to the site.

Dates/Time: 7 – 10 July 2016 Thursday 8 am through 4pm on Sunday

Fees: Adults \$35 (Member Discount \$5), \$25 Sat/Sun

Youth (13--17) \$10

Children (0--12) Free

Saturday ONLY day trip fee: \$10

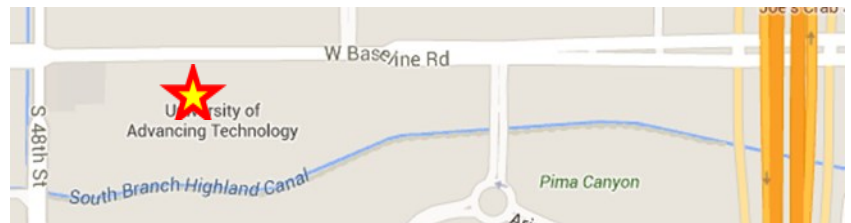

Thrown Weapons

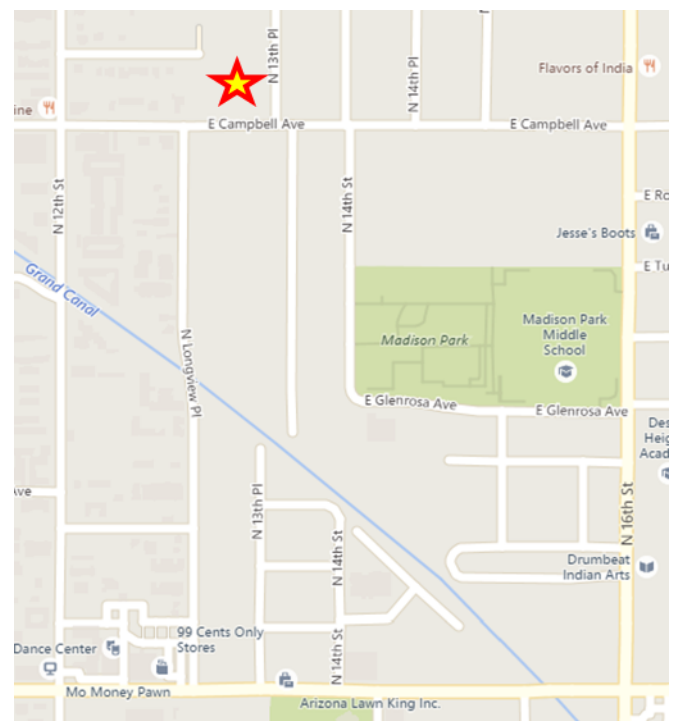

Thrown Weapons Practice is held at 4500 N. 13th Pl in Central Phoenix. We have a heater and plenty of room for watching.

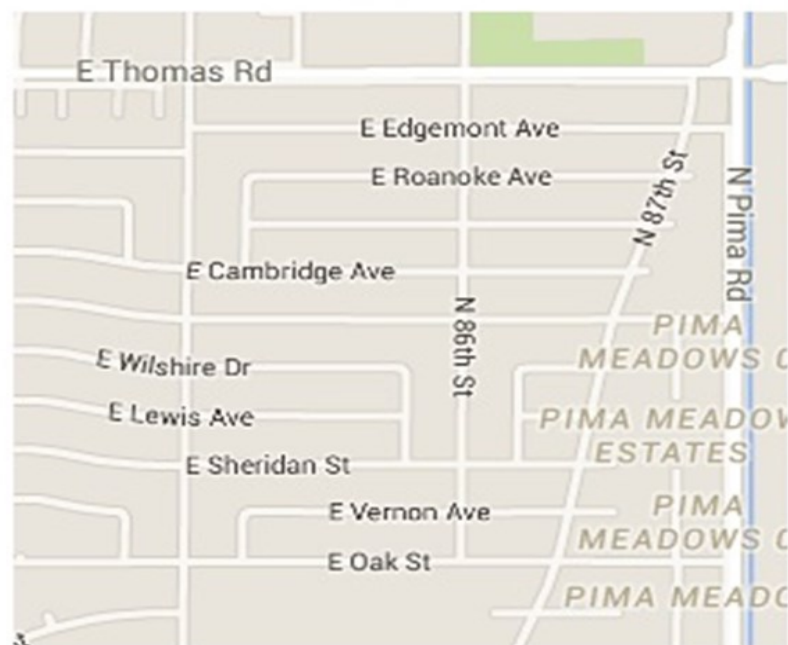


Thrown Weapons Practice is on 25th.
