They are charged with the responsibility to ensure that the barony's rules remain within the boundaries of Federal, State and local laws, and to suggest changes when necessary. GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION AS A BARONIAL CANDIDATE:

Baronial candidates must be current paid members, and must receive their Southwind or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt.

Candidates must be at least 18 years old.

Candidates must have **Letters of Intent** in the hands of the Crown, the Kingdom Seneschal, and the Baron and Baroness no later than **October 28, 2016**. Letters should be written with the understanding that (if accepted by the Crown), the letters will be published in The Palm Prints for the populace to review prior to the polling.

Candidates must include the below information in their Letter of Intent:

- Full contact information, including SCA and modern names, addresses, phone numbers, email, and membership numbers and expiration date

- Their reasons for seeking the position

- Their history of participation in the SCA and the Barony of Atenveldt

- Their plans for the future of the group

- Their understanding of the responsibilities of the position of Baron and Baroness.

- Their statement that they are willing to be installed with a three-year warrant in the position, and understand their Letter of Intent will be published in The Palm Prints if their candidacy is accepted by the Crown.

BARONY OF ATENVELDT BARONIAL POLLING

A polling of the current paid members of the Barony of Atenveldt will be conducted at Encanto Park, 1201 W. Encanto Blvd., Phoenix, AZ 85004, to determine their support of candidates for Baron and Baroness. The polling will be held **Sunday, January 22, 2017, from Noon to 1:30 p.m.** The populace should be aware that if the first polling does not show a clear preference of the populace, a second polling will be held immediately following the closing and tabulation of ballots for the first poll. Members are encouraged to plan to remain onsite to participate should a second poll be necessary.

To participate in all pollings held that day, you must be a Sustaining, Associate, or Family member who is 18 years old or older, and must receive a Southwind or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt.

Current paid memberships will be verified on a membership list at the polling site, or you may present an online membership renewal dated after the date the membership list was generated by the Milpitas Registry. The Kingdom Seneschal recommends you bring proof of membership with you to ensure participation in the poll.

You must reside in zip codes belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt, and this will be verified on the membership list at the polling site.

NOTE: Paid members who play in the Barony of Atenveldt, but do not reside in the zip codes belonging to the Barony, may not cast ballots. However, they are encouraged to make their views on candidates known to the Crown by sending personal letters to the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal expressing their candidate selections and preferences. The Crown will consider such letters when reviewing the polling results.

You must be 18 years old or older and present a picture ID at the polling site that shows your date of birth or age.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR BARONIAL POLLING

If you are unable to attend the polling to cast a ballot, you may follow the below procedures to submit an Absentee Ballot for the polling. Please understand that **NO EXCEPTIONS** will be made to the timeline or contents required for an Absentee Ballot to be counted. So please review the requirements carefully, and send your letters in as soon as the candidates are announced by the Crown.

IF YOU WISH TO SUBMIT AN ABSENTEE BALLOT:

Write to the Kingdom Seneschal (email or a mailed letter) stating your preference in the poll. Emailed letters will be acknowledged by email. Mailed letters must include a self-addressed, stamped envelope so receipt of the ballot can be acknowledged.

Your letter must ***in the hands of the Kingdom Seneschal*** no later than **Sunday, January 15, 2017**. Please mail ballots early enough to arrive by that date, and allow for delays in the mail. ***Do not send ballots with signature required at delivery, as that may delay their receipt.***

Your letter must include **ALL** of the following:

Your candidate preference
SCA and modern name, and full mailing address for your membership
Proof of membership (membership number and membership expiration date)
A scanned or hard copy of a picture ID showing you are 18 years old (or older).

Absentee ballots will be counted in the first polling. If a second or subsequent polling is conducted, and your ballot was for one of the candidates included in that poll, it will also be counted in that subsequent. If your ballot was for a candidate NOT included in the subsequent polling, it will not be counted.

****** SPECIAL ZIP CODE EXCEPTION ******

If you DO NOT HAVE a membership address in a zip code assigned to the Barony of Barony of Atenveldt, but your membership is current in a zip code in metropolitan Phoenix, you will be asked to sign a Pledge Form before you can receive a ballot. The Pledge Form shows your agreement with this statement:

"I consider myself a member of the populace of the Barony of Barony of Atenveldt, and promise the Crown of Atenveldt that I will not cast a ballot in any Pollings held in the Barony of Sun Dragon, the Barony of Twin Moons, or the College of Brymstonne for 3 years following the date of this polling."

A list of the members who sign this Pledge Form will be kept by the Kingdom Seneschal's office, and by the Seneschals of the three Baronies in the Phoenix metropolitan area and the College of Brymstonne. After signing the Pledge Form, you will be given a different color ballot to indicate your preference for Baron and Baroness.

In addition to his Baronial service, he has served the Kingdom as Deputy Signet and Deputy Seneschal. Ritchyrd has served the Kingdom of Atenveldt's inter-Kingdom relations in the following Estrella War positions: Main, Deputy Site, Collegium Coordinator, Showcase Coordinator, and Royal Liaison. He has also served the SCA as a whole as a Deputy Society Seneschal.

Kirsten has served the Barony as Book Reeve, Chronicler, Waiver Secretary, Deputy Seneschal (Business Meeting Notetaker), Deputy List Minister, Arts & Sciences Champion, Youth Minister, Hardsuit Field Marshal, and is soon to be a Thrown Weapons Field Marshal. Furthermore, she has served the Kingdom as Arts & Sciences Minister and Chronicler. Kirsten's contribution to inter-Kingdom relations extends to these Estrella War positions: Deputy Merchant, Deputy Gate, and Arts & Science Competition Coordinator.

We have both been active for some time in the Arts community. We have both taught classes at various Collegiums, practices, and events, as well as allowing others to share their skills by coordinating collegiums. We make a unified team that is capable of inspiring others to greatness. We have the ability to turn on light bulbs in people's thoughts, just by suggesting a different way of thinking about something. We work hard to further knowledge of these current Middle Ages within the Barony and beyond. We have both coordinated events and projects with people

from around the Kingdom and even inter-Kingdom.

In an effort to improve the retention of youth in our Society, we were both involved in the Youth and Family Achievement (YAFA) test program. Although young people may grow up within our group, it does not mean they will stay. We welcome ideas and volunteers that would like to champion the retention of the youth of our Barony. A young person without a goal can be a detriment, however, with a goal they become useful, productive, and long term contributors to our Society.

Our vision for the Barony is many-fold. Firstly, we feel that a part of “the Dream” is slowly re-kindling due to many efforts throughout the Kingdom. We believe the stardust is mostly inspired by get-togethers, such as armor sessions, garbed outings, or just socializing. As previous heads of households, we understand how much the households in our Barony have contributed to this endeavor. Within the Barony, there are a multitude of activities: scriptoriums, archery practices, garb making sessions, thrown weapons practice and mini hardsuit practices and we wish to encourage sharing the information about these gatherings. Getting these activities known to the populace is a huge step in getting people more involved on a personal level and the continuation of bringing a family feeling back to our Barony.

Secondly, the SCA is aging, which cannot be denied. The results of the most recent SCA census have shown a distinct lack of newcomers and therefore new ideas are needed to refresh the Dream. Recruitment needs to be supported by the Barony, and as such, demos need to occur more frequently. Along with these demos, making resources available to newcomers can help retention, such as loaner gear for those that want to try fighting, looms for those with interest, and even “crash space” during events to encourage attendance. The Barony needs to continue to be more supportive of the newcomers so that, eventually, they can become old-timers. To this end, we have a desire to encourage the growth of our Barony by adding to the award system. We wish to see beginner components added to each of the Baronial awards. In the same way that the Palm Leaf is the first step in recognition of service, there also can be a first step to our other awards as well.

Atenveldt is full of amazing individuals and the Baron and Baroness are nothing without them. We will rely on everyone to help make our vision a reality. We want to encourage all who live within the Barony of Atenveldt, whether they participate in the SCA through a large or small household or as individuals to view the Barony as theirs. We want to set hearts afire with the joy of combat, arts, pageantry, wars, and all other facets of the SCA. We hope to be the local focus of a Kingdom of enthusiasm and even without a Coronet upon our heads, we will always be servants of the Crown. Atenveldt is our Home.

I also understand that I would also need to rely on the peers to give advice and counsel.

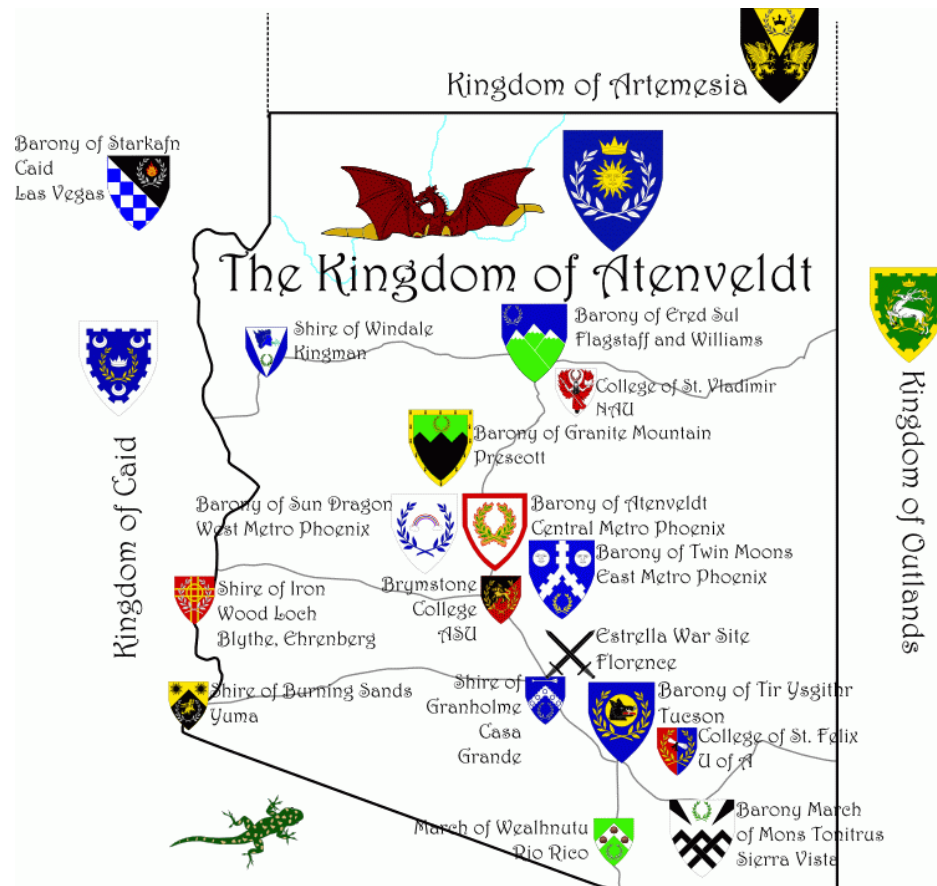

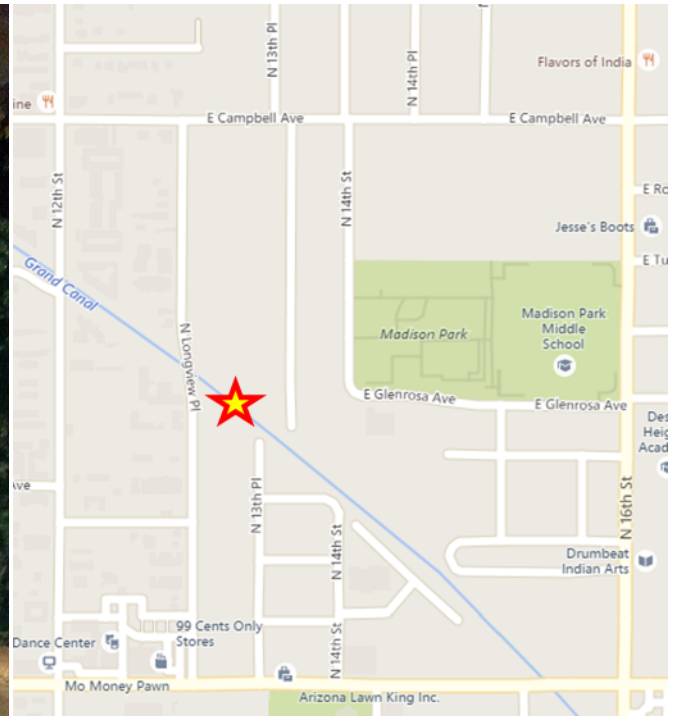


Thrown Weapons

Thrown Weapons Practice will be on January 14th and 28th from 6pm to 9pm



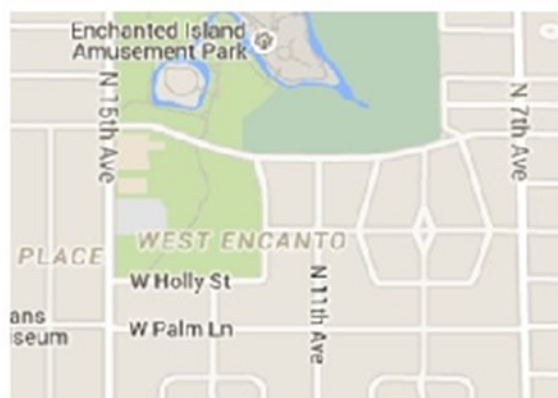
