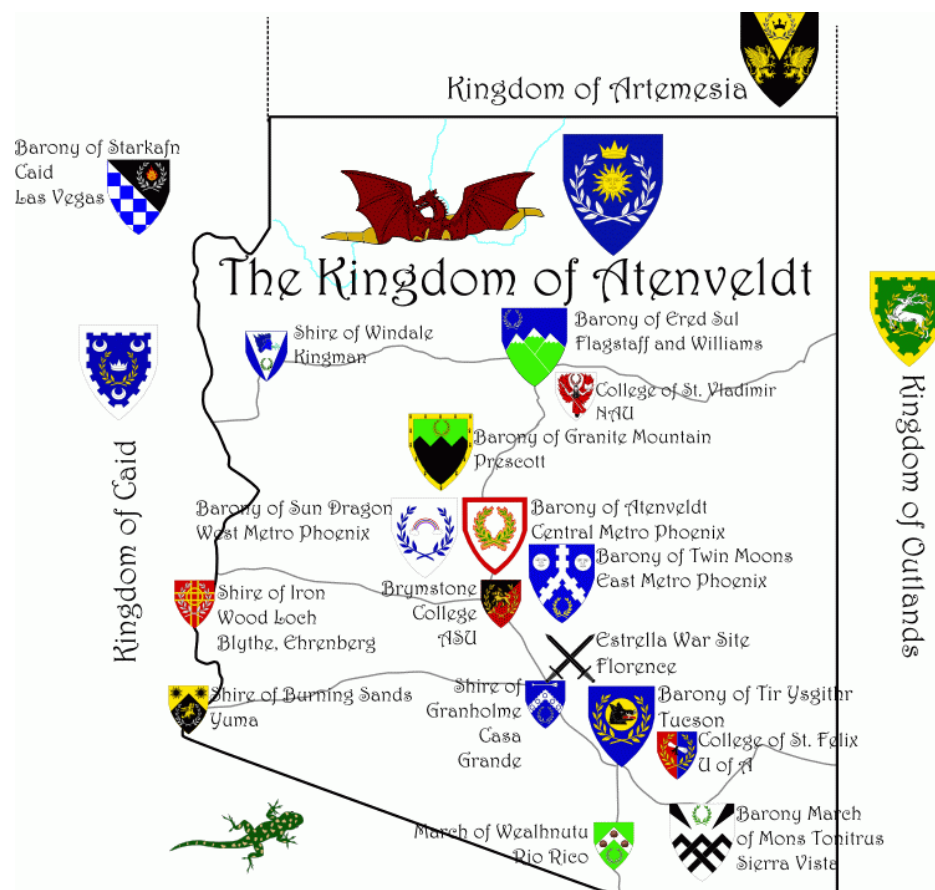

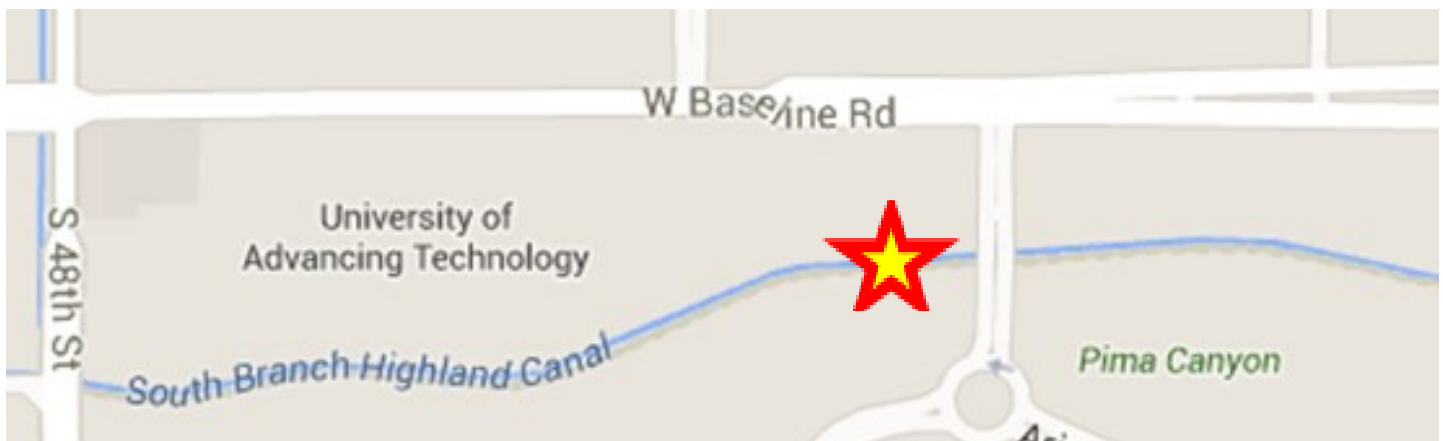

Commander of the Purpure Clarion

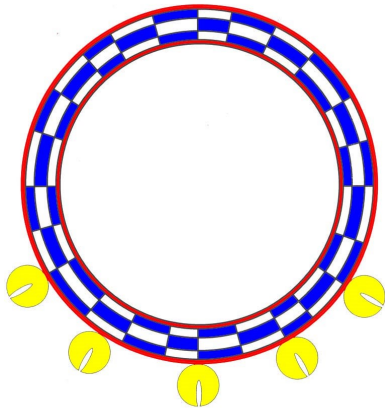

Order of the Palm of Atenveldt

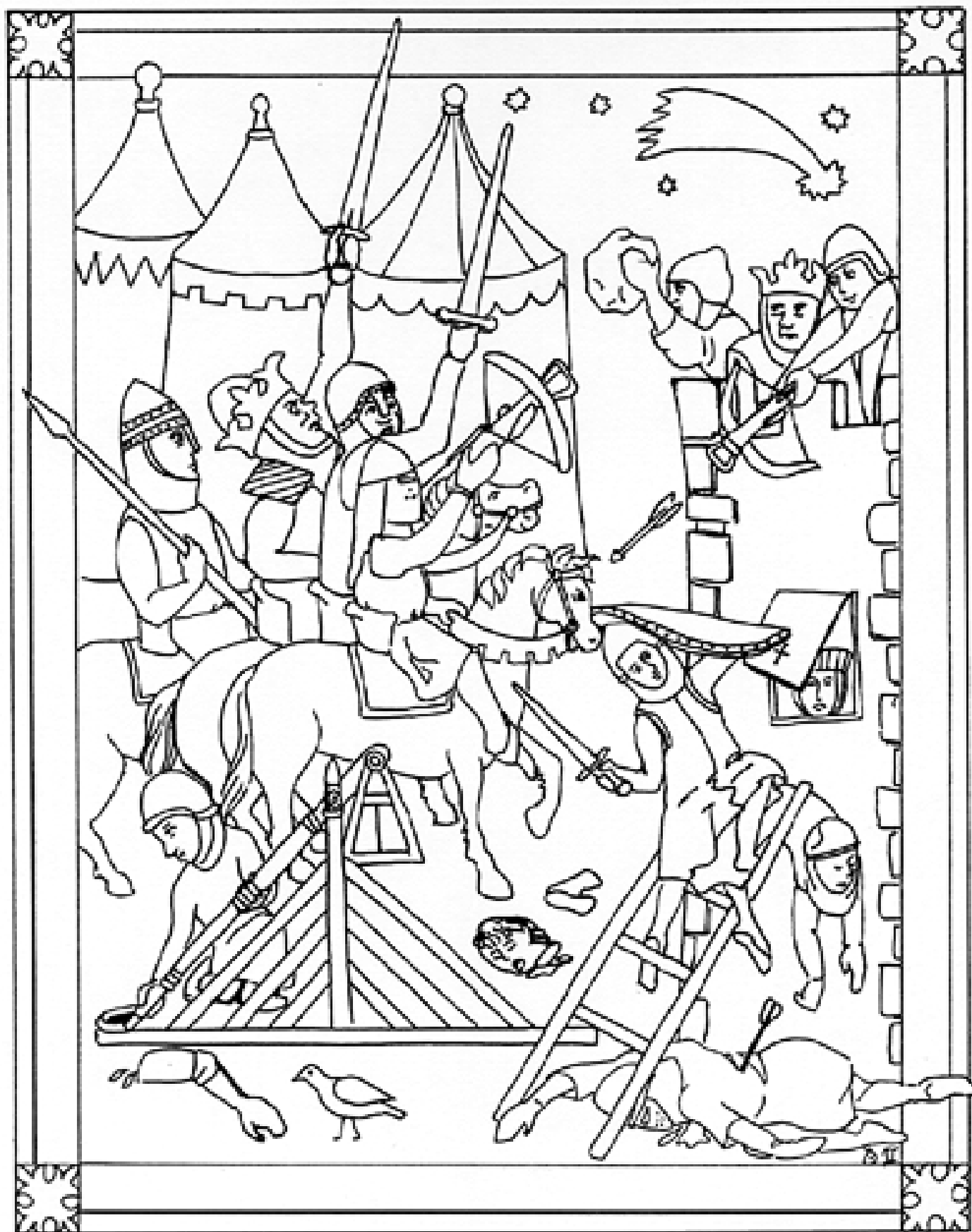

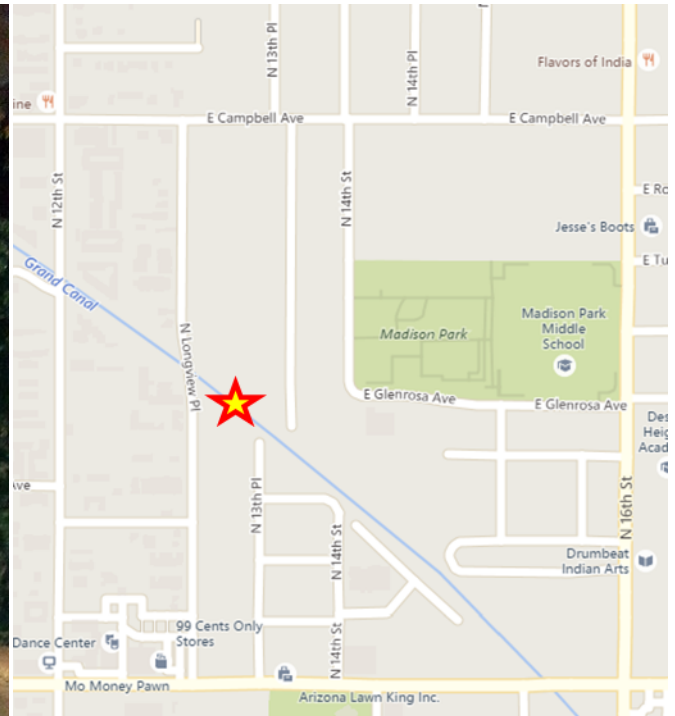
