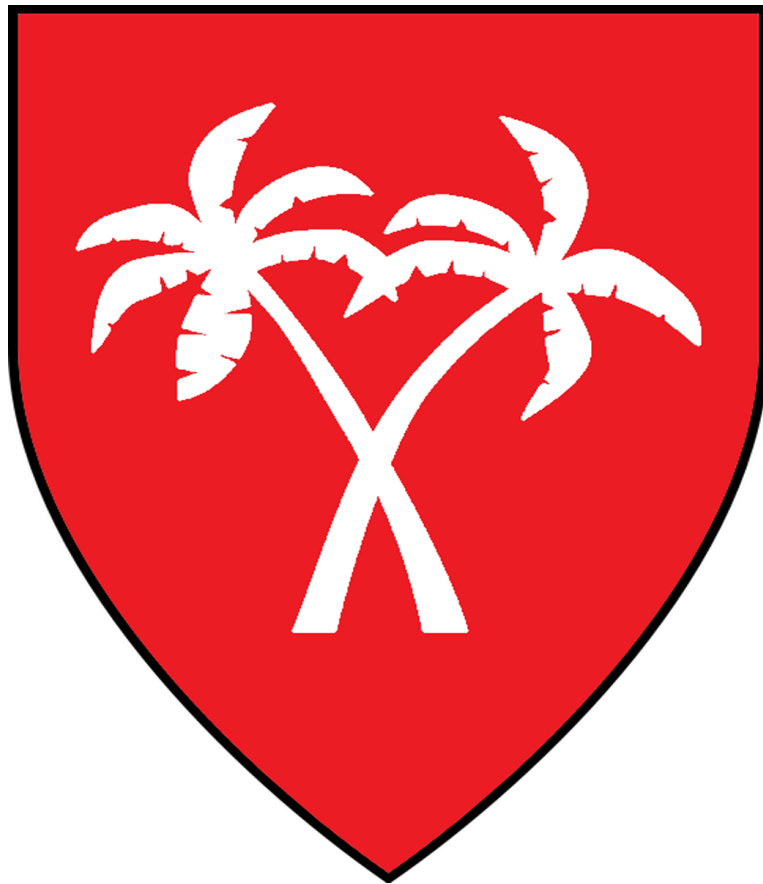

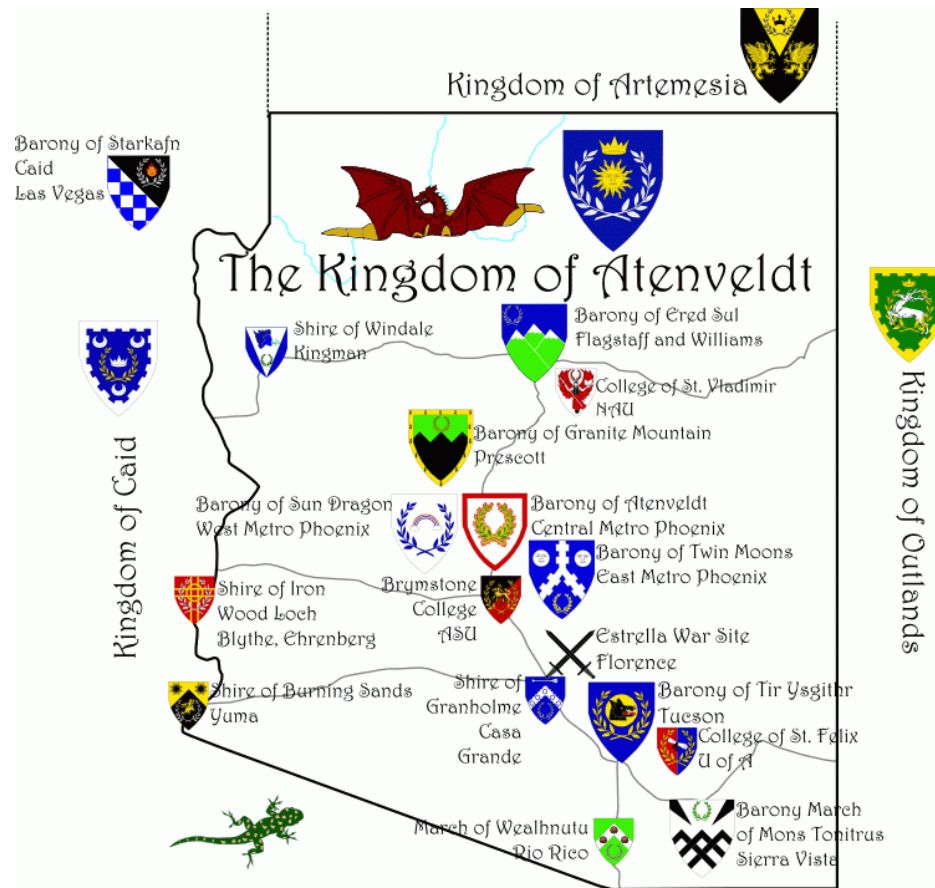

Fighters, this is a great opportunity to fight someone other than the usual suspects at your regular practices and to show your mettle. 5. Tournament format will be determined by the Marshals on-site based on the number of participants
6. All bids for items must be paid at the time of the close of the bid with the Baronial Exchequer (Ld. Jorgen) , Deputy Exchequer (M'lady Jackie).

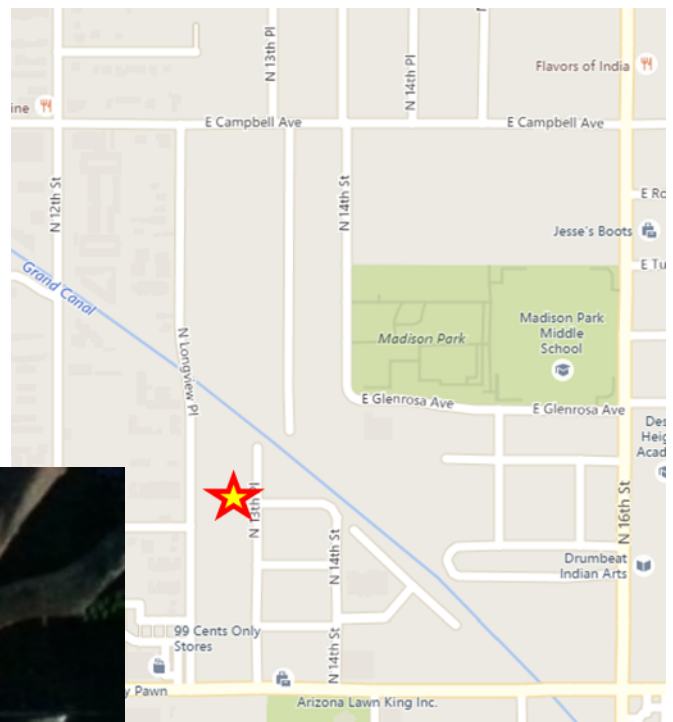

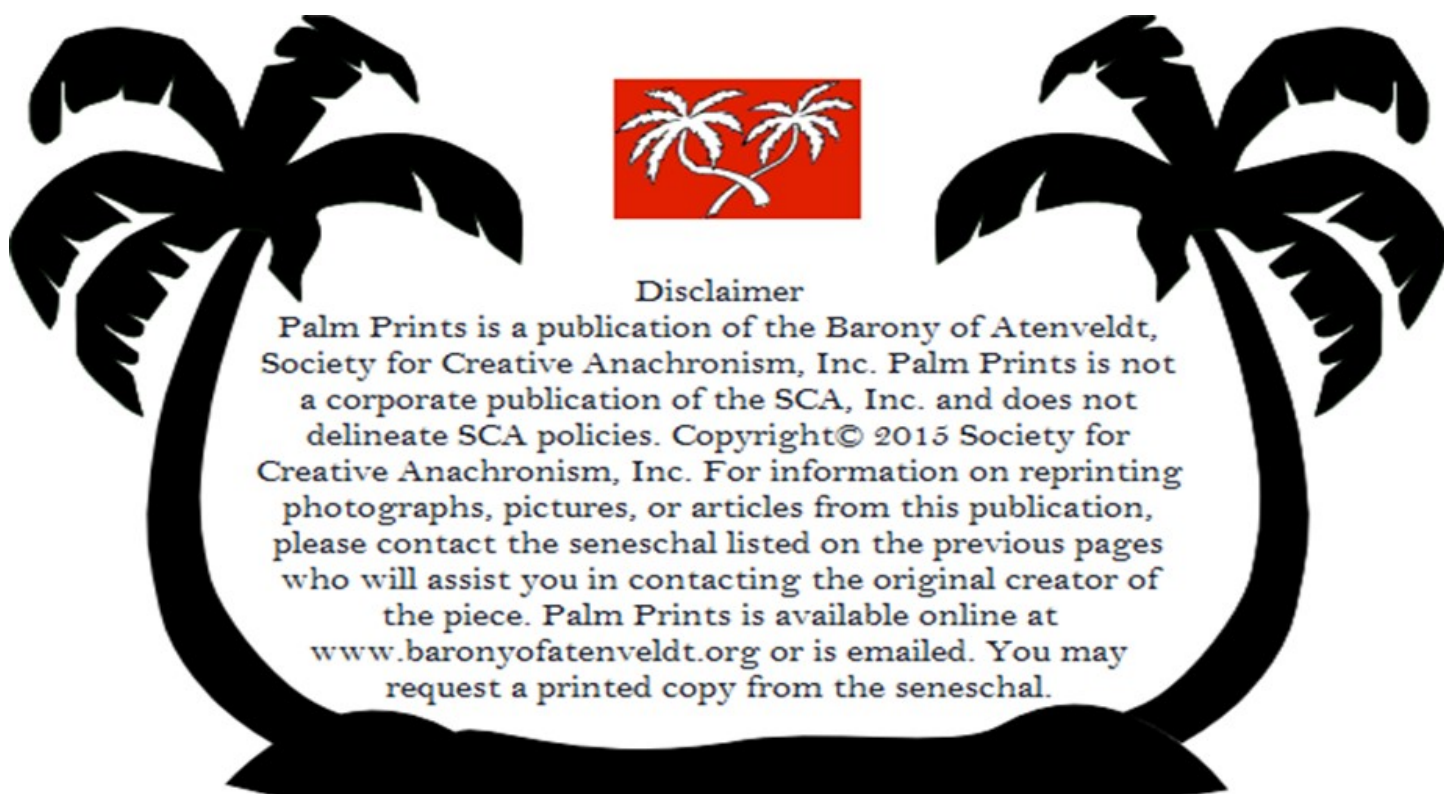
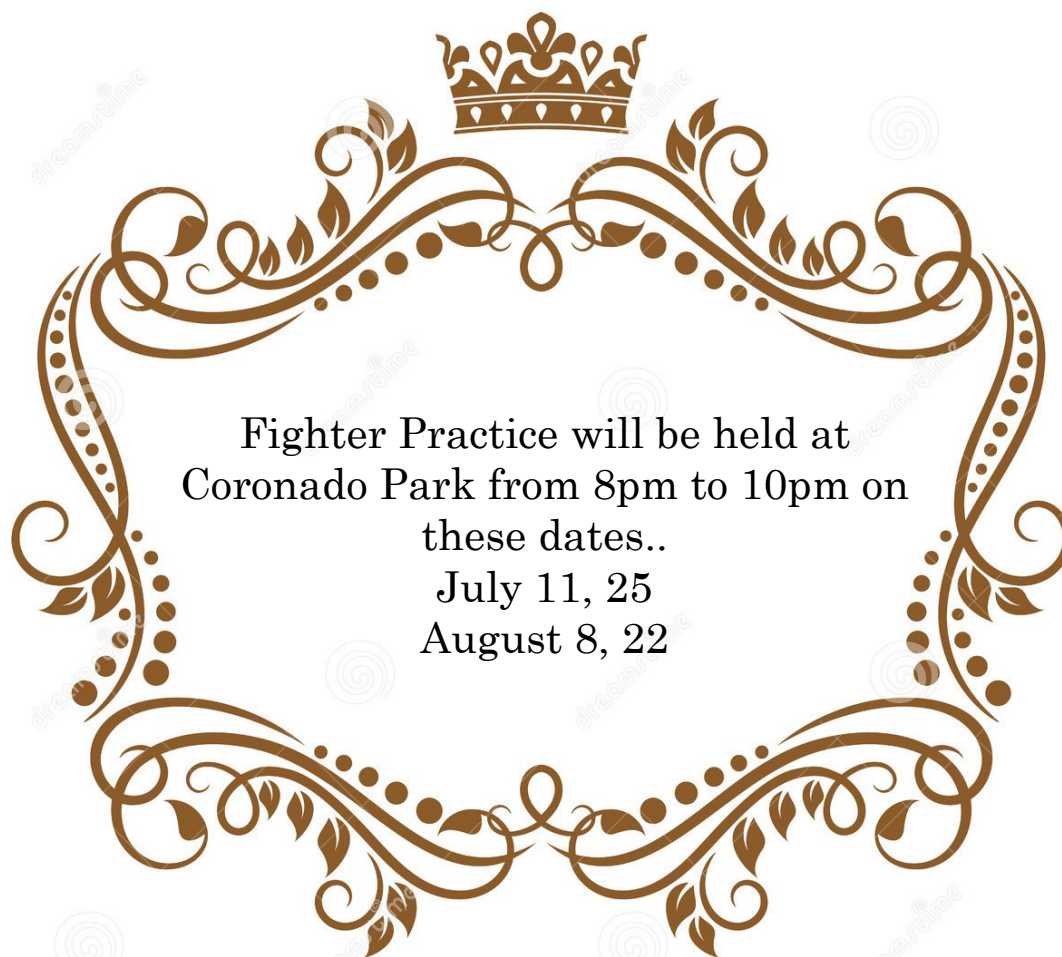

Commander of the Purpure Clarion

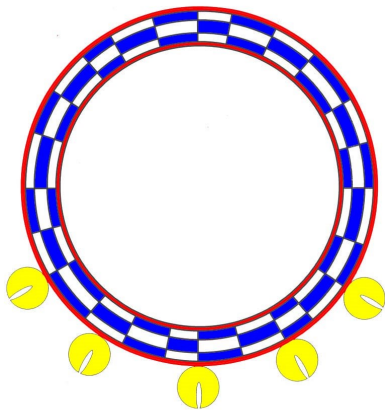
