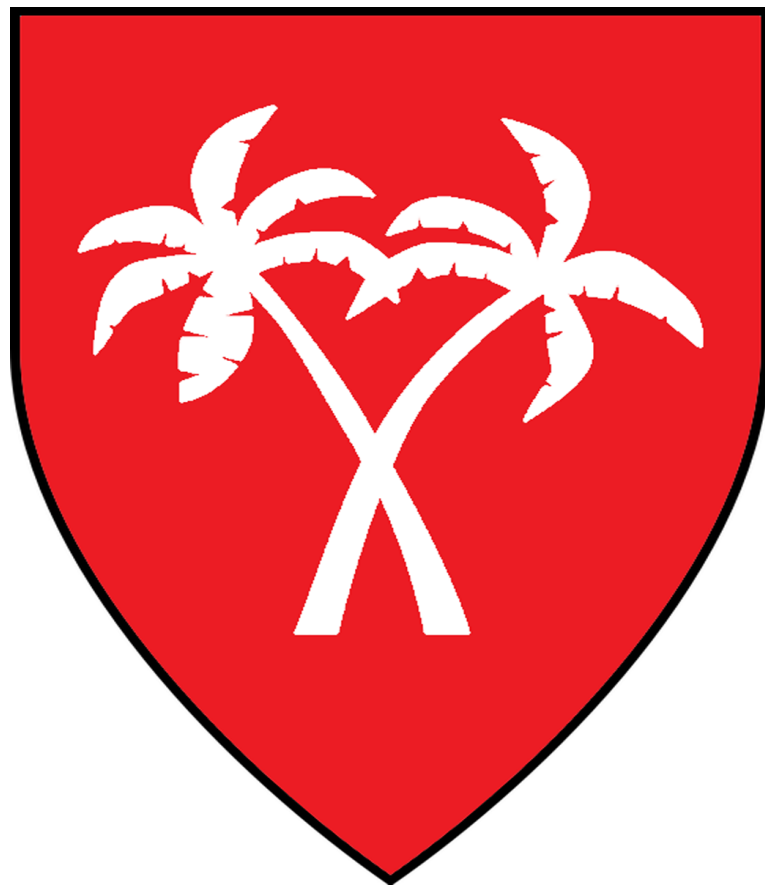

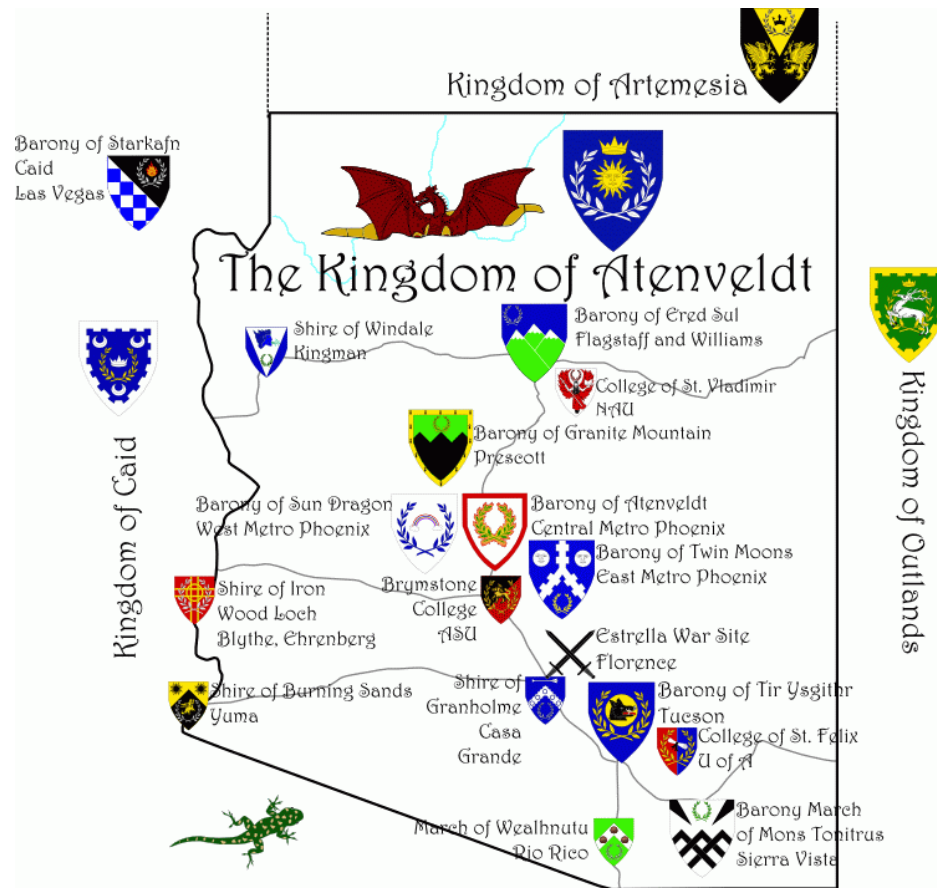

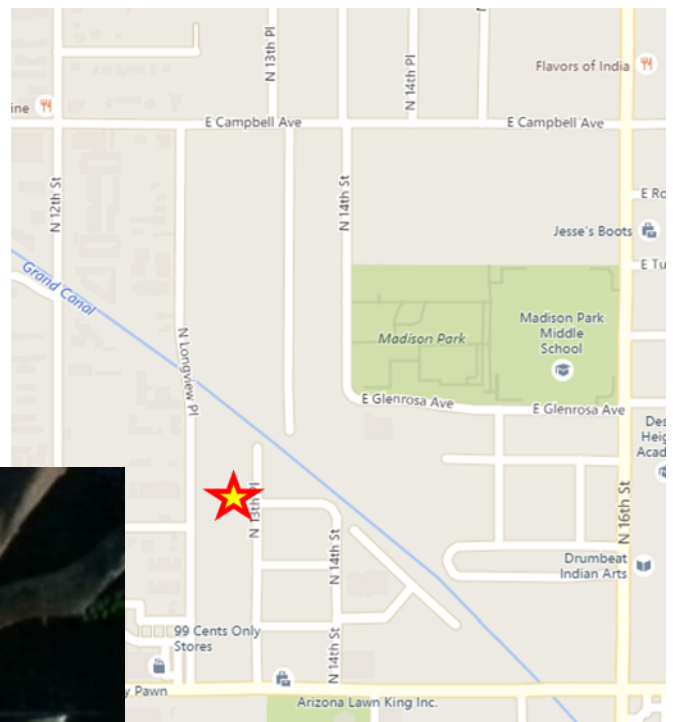

### Commander of the Purpure Clarion

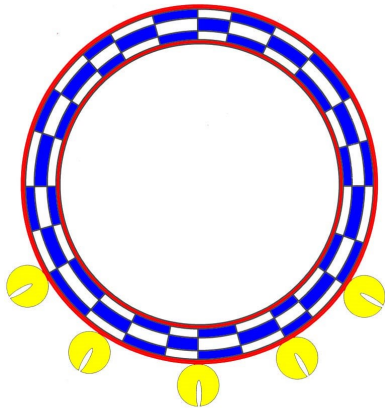
