



Baronial Champions

Oct 25 – Oct 27

Hear Ye! Hear Ye!

Know all who hear these words that Nudd Baron and Emelyn Baroness of the Barony of Atenveldt will soon host many and varied competitions to choose new Champions suitable for the Barony. Let it be known that Peers of the Chivalry, the Laurels the MOD and the Pelicans are welcome to enter these competitions and are encouraged to enter with intent to become our Baronial Champion. Baronial Champions will be taking place with the Barony of Sundragon on October 25 - 27, 2019 Herein lists the duties of said Champions.



ALL SHOULD:

Be a paid member of the Society (Highly recommended)

- Enjoy the grand show that is Court and have a desire to make it more fun for everyone.
- Be prepared to help plan, organize and host the next Baronial Champions event.
- There are Letters of Intent required.
- There will also be an interview conducted by their Excellencies

Arts and Sciences Champion:

- Regularly represent the Barony of Atenveldt in competitions. This does not mean the champion must enter EVERY available competition, but that they should set and example for the populace with regular activity in the Arts and Sciences. It is encouraged that the champion enter a minimum of 2 competitions outside of the Barony of Atenveldt.
- Create one items of Baronial Regalia during their term of service. The champion will consult with Their Excellencies to determine what items are needed, taking into account the talents and temperament of the champion.
- Teach classes in the Arts and Sciences in their area(s) of expertise. It is expected that the Champion teach classes at an A&S collegium.
- Advise Their Excellencies on matters relating to the Arts and Sciences and seek ways to advance the Arts and Sciences in the Barony.
- Promote Activity in the Arts and Sciences within the Barony of Atenveldt by encouraging and inspiring the artisans and potential artisans to participate in the available competitions, classes, and other events.

Rapier Champions:

- Stand court at Baronial events (Spring, Anniversary, and Yule). If the champion is attending an event where the Baron and Baroness are also in attendance, be prepared to stand with them during courts.

- Expected to enter a minimum of 2 tournaments outside of the borders of the Barony as the representative of the Barony of Atenveldt . These may be Kingdom or Baronial level, preferably smaller tournaments in other Baronies, as well as Queen's Champion, or King's Cut and Thrust (if authorized).
 - Will plan and coordinate any tournaments Their Excellencies wish to have at a Wednesday night fighter practice or at an event (Examples include the Novice Tournaments; Estrella War Novice Tournament)
- Will boldly and often wear the colors and regalia of the position, attend courts whenever possible, and meet challenges as needed.

Hardsuit Champions:

- Stand court at Baronial events (Spring, Anniversary, and Yule). If the champion is attending an event where the Baron and Baroness are also in attendance, be prepared to stand with them during courts.
- Expected to enter a minimum of 2 tournaments outside of the borders of the Barony as the representative of the Barony of Atenveldt . These may be Kingdom or Baronial level, preferably smaller tournaments in other Baronies, as well as King's Champion, Queen's Champion, or Crown Tournament.
- Will plan and coordinate any tournaments Their Excellencies wish to have at a Wednesday night fighter practice or at events (examples include Novice Tournaments; Estrella War Novice Tournaments).
- Will boldly and often wear the colors and regalia of the position, attend courts whenever possible, and meet challenges as needed.

Archery Champion:

- Will submit a minimum of 1 IKAC each quarter, and will encourage others to do the same.
- Attend regular Baronial archery practice a minimum of once per month.
- Will advertise and lead a minimum of 2 introduction classes about "How to get started in Archery in our Barony" at Wednesday fighter practices.
- Organize and plan a minimum of one archery competition at a Baronial event during their tenure.
- Will boldly and often wear the colors and regalia of the position, attend courts whenever possible, and meet challenges as needed.
- Stand court at Baronial events (Spring, Anniversary, and Yule). If the champion is attending an event where the Baron and Baroness are also in attendance, be prepared to stand with them during courts

Bardic Champion:

- Regularly represent the Barony of Atenveldt in competitions. This does not mean the champion must enter EVERY available competition, but that they should set an example for the populace with regular activity in the Bardic Arts It is expected that the champion enter a minimum of 1 competitions outside of the Barony of Atenveldt.
- Teach classes in the Bardic Arts in their area(s) of expertise. It is expected that The Champion teach classe(s) at an A&S collegium.
- Advise Their Excellencies on matters relating to the Bardic Arts and seek ways to advance the Bardic Arts in the Barony.
- Promote Activity in the Bardic Arts within the Barony of Atenveldt by encouraging and inspiring the artisans and potential artisans to participate in the available competitions, classes, and other events.

Thrown Weapons

- Stand Court at Baronial Events (Spring, Anniversary, and Yule). If the Champion is attending an event where the Baron and Baroness are also in attendance, be prepared to stand with them.
- Attend regular Baronial Thrown Weapons practice a minimum of once per month.
- Will advertise and lead an introduction class about Thrown Weapons at a Wednesday night fighter practice.

Organize and plan at least one Thrown Weapons Competition during their tenure.
Will boldly and often wear the colors of the Barony and regalia of the Position, attend courts whenever possible and meet challenges as needed.

Please bring shade and water. Animals permitted but must be on a leash . Campfires must be contained and must be 12 inches off the ground.

Directions: DO NOT FOLLOW A GOOGLE MAPS ROUTE! Take the I-10 West to Perryville Road. Go South about 4.5 miles; past Broadway Rd and the train tracks. Take the gravel road about 100 yards south of the train tracks (on the left). Travel towards the end of the road and the event will be on the left hand side. There will be SCA signs to follow.

----- FROM THE SITE OWNER:

1. Cross streets are Perryville and Roeser (/Atlanta)
2. Take I-10 to the Perryville Exit
3. Go South on Perryville for four miles
4. Stay on Perryville and go through the Broadway Road stop sign
5. Turn left (East) on Roeser: Roeser is a dead end, narrow gravel road (with some potholes). Roeser is accessed via a one lane bridge under the large power poles and next to the mailboxes, between the railroad tracks and the canal
6. Drive 3/4 of a mile, though the white gates

You CANNOT access the farm from MC 85. Atlanta Avenue will take you onto restricted Private Property. In addition, there is a barrier on Atlanta Avenue preventing you from reaching the farm.

Also, you CANNOT access the farm from roads leading South which intersect Broadway (183rd, 181st, 1810th, Citrus). They will lead you to an impassable irrigation ditch.

From the south: once you find the best route to AZ-87 (Beeline Highway). Follow that North. Make a Right (head west) on E Shea Blvd, then make a right on N Saguaro Blvd, a left E El Lago Blvd and then finally a right on N La Montana Dr. The destination will be on the right.

From the North: once you find your best route to the AZ-101 Loop E, follow that east Exit 41; E Shea Blvd. Make a left (still heading East) onto E Shea Blvd. Make a left (head North) onto N Fountain Hills Blvd. Make a right on E Arroyo Vista Dr and then finally a Left on La Montana Dr. The destination will be on the right.

Commander of the Purpure Clarion



Order of the Dog's Jambe





Sisterhood of the Black Swan






Service



Order of the Roots of the Barony of Atenveldt

The Root of Atenveldt is given by the Baron and Baroness, to those persons who have given years and years of outstanding and faithful service, far above that normally expected of Baronial subjects. In as much as they continually serve the Barony and share their talents, they deserve to receive the highest of praise. All recipients of the award must have previously received the rank of Commander in one of the following Orders; the Palm, the Azure Chalice, the Purpure Clarion, the Sable Axe, or the Vert Glove.



Order of the Palm Leaf

Given by the Baron and Baroness, to those persons who have demonstrated a willingness to give ongoing service to the Barony of Atenveldt.
