Order of the Purpure Clarion

Commander of the Purpure Clarion

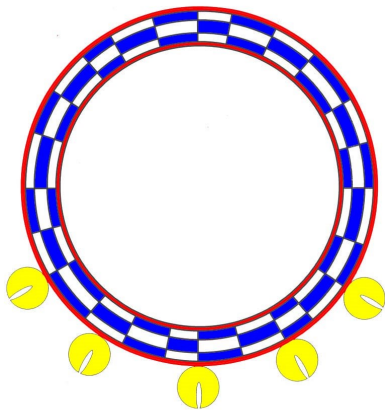
