Atenveldt Crown Tournament & Coronation



When: Saturday April 9th 9 am - 7 pm Sunday April 10th 10 am - 4 pm

Location: Prospector Park in Apache Junction, in the field at the Northeastern corner of the park. (3015 N Idaho Rd, Apache Junction, AZ)

Archery will take place at Paseo Vista Archery Range (3850 S McQueen Rd, Chandler, AZ 85286)

The time has come for Heirs to be found for the glorious Kingdom of the Sun! With the state of the world being unsure, we need to secure the future of our shared dream in every way we can. Keeping that in mind, this Crown Tournament has

a very special addition. Coronation will occur the same day, the mantle of power being transferred as the sun sets on the tournament field. Sunday will be a day dedicated to finding Champions for our new Crown so their reign may be well attended.

This is a wet site. Pets on leashes are welcome. There is no overnight camping or shade provided, but individual day shades may be staked onsite and left, we will have an overnight watch onsite. There is no block of hotel rooms reserved and people are encouraged to arrange their own local overnight accommodations. Parking is available in the main lot near the field and overflow parking is directly west of the field. The main lot has several ADA accessible spots and ramps. There are playgrounds nearby. Masks are NOT required for this outdoor event.

The format of the tournament will be a bear pit, but after you have been defeated by your opponent you must use a different weapon when fighting your next round. If you wish to participate, please bring your preferred weapons, shield, and any other weapons you might consider using. We all hope to see you there!

Cooking with the Baron

Savory Tart: Heidenische küchen (Heathen cakes), from Ein Buch von gutter spise, c. 1350 hosted online at MedievalCookery.com. Recipe #5 (http://www.medievalcookery.com/etexts/buch.html)

Original Recipe: Diz heizzent heidenische kuchen. Man sol nemen einen teye und sol (den) dünne breiten und nim ein gesoten fleisch und spec gehacket und epfele und pfeffer und eyer dar in und backe daz und gives hin und versirtez niht.

Translation from Medieval Cookery: These are called heathen cakes. One should take a dough and should spread it thin and take a boiled meat and chopped fatty bacon and apples and pepper and eggs therein and bake that and give out and do not damage.

As with any medieval recipe, how the cook chooses to interpret the translated recipe varies. The following method is what I have used at SCA feasts in the past. One common theme I have noticed with medieval recipes is a lack of instruction when it comes to "dough" or a "pie crust". When in doubt, I use the pie crust recipe from the Betty Crocker cookbook. This recipe uses a basic double crust (or double batch)

Modern Recipe:

Ingredients:

- 1 beef roast (whichever cut fits your budget)
- ❖ 1 medium sized yellow onion, peeled and quartered
- ❖ 2 stalks celery, cut into 1 inch pieces
- ❖ 2 carrots, cut into 1 inch pieces
- Cardamom
- Rosemary
- **❖** Salt
- Pepper
- ❖ 5 slices Bacon
- ❖ 1 tart apple (such as a Granny Smith apple) diced (leave the peel on)
- Cinnamon
- 4 eggs
- ❖ 1 double batch pastry dough (to line a pie tin, and place a lid on top of the pie).

Step One – The meat.

Take one beef roast (whichever cut fits your budget), and rub all sides with a mixture of the dry spices (approx. 1 tsp each of cardamom, rosemary, salt and pepper). Set aside.

In a slow cooker (crockpot), add the onion, celery, and carrots, and approx. $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of water. Then place your beef roast on top of the vegetables, and cook slowly for 6-8 hours.

Once the beef has cooked, remove the beef from the crockpot and set aside. You can discard the broth and vegetables, or save the broth for a future use.

Once the beef has cooled, use forks (or your hands) to shred the beef.

Cooking with the Baron

Step Two – The Apple

First, in a skillet, cook the bacon on low heat. You want to render the fat from the bacon. Once cooked, remove and set aside the cooked bacon, but leave the bacon fat in the skillet.

Next, dice one apple (removing the stem and seeds). You do not need to peel the apple. Put the diced apple into the skillet with the bacon fat and cook on medium high heat until the apples are soft. While cooking the apples, add 1 tablespoon cinnamon to the apples, and incorporate the cinnamon into the apples and bacon fat.

Step Three – Mixing everything together

Once cooked, pour the apple and cinnamon mixture into a large mixing bowl. Take the bacon you cooked earlier and crumble it up and add it to the mixture. Take approx. 1 and 1/2 cups of shredded beef and add that to the mixture. Using a spoon (or your hands) mix all ingredients together until they are all mixed together.

The mixture should be cooled to room temperature for the next part.

Add 3 raw scrambled eggs to the mixture, and mix everything together.

Step Foure - The Pie

Take the pastry crust and line one pie tin with pastry dough. Then scoop as much of the apple and beef mixture into the pie tin as possible. Roll out the remaining pastry dough into a sheet and put on top of the pie, making sure to cut off any extra pie crust. Use a knife to slice 4 or 5 holes in the top pie crust to allow steam to release.


Take your remaining egg, and whip it with about ¼ cup water, to form an egg wash. Using a basting brush, brush the egg wash on the top of the pie.

Step Five - Baking

Pre-heat your oven to 400 degrees. Once the oven is hot, place your pie on the middle rack and back for approx. 30 minutes, or until the top of the pie turns a light brown. Remove and cool.

This dish can be served hot or cold.

One variation I have used in the past is to use precooked meat from a store instead of cooking a beef roast. Costco has cooked pork carnitas which work out quite well for this recipe. Costco also has a smoked pulled pork that I have also used in this dish at SCA feasts.

Fighter Practice Encanto Soccer Field is 7:30 -10:00 PM




Fighters: Start arriving early to get armored up, lights will come on at 8, and we will start practice as close to that time as possible.
