

Cooking with the Baroness

Baroness' Italian Sausage & Lentil Soup

Ingredients & Notes:

- ❖ 1 garlic clove-minced
- ❖ 2 Tbsp olive oil
- 1 cup onion-chopped
- ❖ 3/4 cup carrot-minced or shredded
- ❖ 2 LB sausage

Use the Italian sausage you like best: mild, sweet, or hot. Since the sausage usually comes in 1-pound packages I usually will pick 2 separate kinds. For group cooking I don't usually use hot, so that it doesn't get too spicy. Same with the pepper flake-you can use more if you want it spicier.

- ❖ 1/2 cup ham (optional)
- 7 cups water

For the liquid, it just has to be 12 cups. If I have a couple of boxes of broth (4 cups each) I might use both, for 8 cups broth then only add 4 cups water. Anything to equal 12.

- ❖ 5 cups vegetarian broth
- ❖ 1 LB lentils
- ❖ 1 can (approx. 15 oz) diced tomato
- 2 Tbsp cider vinegar
- ❖ 1 Tbsp fresh basil-minced Although the recipe calls for fresh basil & parsley, I usually use dried herbs, adjusting amount for tasted.
- ❖ 1 Tbsp fresh parsley-minced Although the recipe calls for fresh basil & parsley, I usually use dried herbs, adjusting amount for tasted.
- 2 bay leaves
- ❖ 1 1/2 tsp salt
- ❖ 1/2 tsp black pepper
- ❖ 1/2 tsp dried thyme
- ❖ 1/2 tsp dried oregano
- ❖ 1/2 tsp red pepper flakes

Instructions:

- 1. Heat oil. Then add onion, carrot, garlic & sausage. Sauté for 8 minutes. If making a double batch, sauté time is longer.
- 2. Add ham & cook for an additional minute
- 3. Add everything else. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat and simmer 1 hour. If making a double batch, simmer time is longer.

Disclaimer: This is not a period recipe, but I like it a lot because it focuses on lentils which is a very period ingredient. I have revised this recipe quite a bit from the original and this is how I make it now. I hope you enjoy it!

Fighter Practice Encanto Soccer Field is 7:30 -10:00 PM




Fighters: Start arriving early to get armored up, lights will come on at 8, and we will start practice as close to that time as possible.
