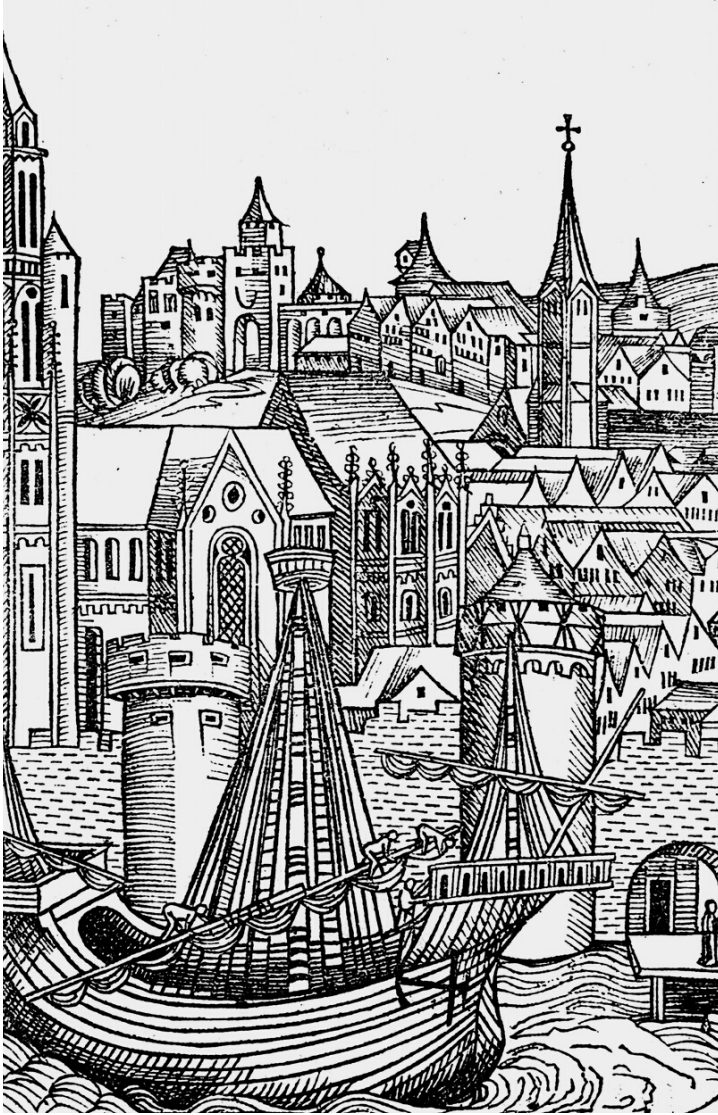

Baronial Knight Marshal

SCA combatants wear real armor and use swords and spears made of rattan wrapped with duct tape. Similar to bamboo, but with a solid core, rattan is springy enough to absorb some of the force of the blow without snapping, and light enough to approximate the weight of a steel sword. Building armor is more complex – a complete suit has many parts, which can be made from hammered steel, rivets, leather, padded fabric, even rigid plastic (if well-disguised). Novice fighters are trained by the more experienced fighters. They are taught how to use their weapons, how to defend themselves, and how to judge blows received in combat. Every fighter on the field is on their honor to accept a blow they judge sufficient to “wound” or “kill”. At the end of training, if the marshals (our safety officers) decide that the fighter is safe – not necessarily good, but unlikely to hurt themselves, or an opponent – then they are authorized to fight. The process of becoming authorized can take from a few weeks to several months. The Baronial Knight Marshal is required to interpret and maintain the marshallate standards and regulations of the Kingdom of Atenveldt. Duties include authorizing fighters, maintaining Kingdom safety standards, managing marshal activities at baronial events, and providing a monthly report to the Kingdom Knight Marshal. A polling of the current paid members of the Barony of SunDragon will be conducted at Fighter Practice held on October 6th 2022 to determine their support of candidates for Baroness and Baron. The populace should be aware that if the first polling does not show a clear preference of the populace, a second polling will be held immediately following the closing and tabulation of ballots for the first poll. Members are encouraged to plan to remain onsite to participate should a second poll be necessary.

To participate in all pollings held that day, you must be a Sustaining, Associate, or Family member who is 18 years old or older, and must receive a Southwind or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of SunDragon.

- Current paid memberships will be verified on a membership list at the polling site, or you may present an online membership renewal dated after the date the membership list was generated by the Milpitas Registry. The Kingdom Seneschal recommends you bring proof of membership with you to ensure participation in the poll.
- You must reside in zip codes belonging to the Barony of SunDragon, and this will be verified on the membership list at the polling site.
- NOTE: Paid members who play in the Barony of SunDragon, but do not reside in the zip codes belonging to the Barony, may not cast ballots. However, they are encouraged to make their views on candidates known to the Crown by sending personal letters to the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal expressing their candidate selections and preferences. The Crown will consider such letters when reviewing the polling results.
- You must be 18 years old or older and present a picture ID at the polling site that shows your date of birth or age.

Cooking with the Guild

Torten von Epffel (Apple Tarts)

by Nicholo de Santi

20-24 Individual Servings

- Cinnamon Pie Crust:
- 1 Cup Flour
- ½ Cup Butter
- 2 Egg yolks
- 1 tsp Cinnamon



Instructions:

1. PREHEAT OVEN to 400 Degrees
2. Combine Flower and Cinnamon (Mixture), then Cut butter and egg yolks into the mixture until it forms a ball of dough. Roll out dough then place a MINI cupcake pan upside down then on the back of a MINI cupcake pan place dough over the humps of the pan. Cut the crust and form bowels with dough.
3. Place Upside down MINI cupcake pan in the oven and cook for 8-15 Minutes or until Golden Brown.
4. Set Mini Pies aside to cool on rack till room temp
5. Cinnamon Apple Slaw Filling:
6. 3 lbs Cooking Apples (Granny Smith Green Apples)
7. ½ Cup of Sugar
8. 2 tsp ground cinnamon
9. Core and Finely chop Apples (Use Food Processor for better results) Toss Apples, Cinnamon, and Sugar in a bowl. Place mixture in saucepan on the stove with medium heat until slow boil starts. Reduce heat and simmer for 5 minutes.
10. Remove mixture from Heat, and Strain excess liquid from the pan into an airtight jar/bottle (DO NOT TOSS LIQUID) place Apple Slaw into a container and chill for 30 minutes.
11. BONUS ITEM Cinnamon Apple Simple Syrup:
12. Liquid from Apple Slaw + Water (approx 2oz)
13. Take the Liquid that was placed in an airtight jar/bottle from apple slaw, and mix with water until desired syrup consistency.
14. Place in refrigerator to cool.

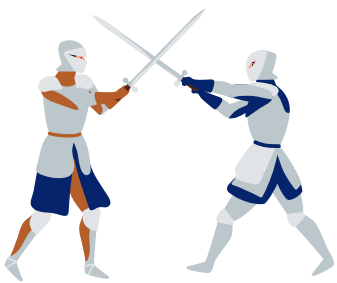

Fighter Practice Encanto Soccer Field is 7:30 -10:00 PM



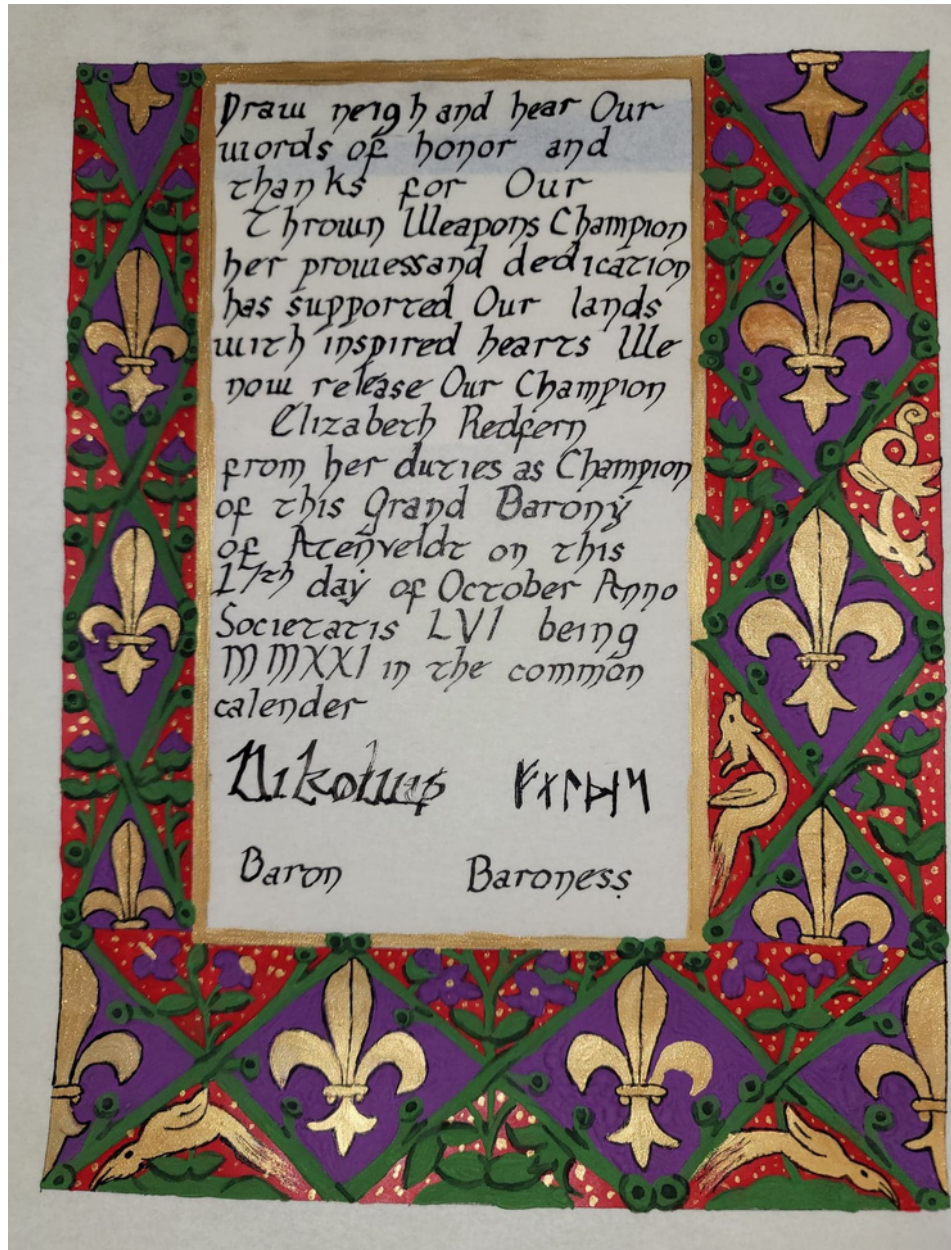
Fighters: Start arriving early to get armored up, lights will come on at 8, and we will start practice as close to that time as possible.
