

Cooking with the Baron

Bagna Cauda by Baron Nikolaus

A few years ago I stopped for lunch at the Flagstaff Brewing Company where they had this amazing garlic appetizer called Bagna Cauda. They would use a small cast iron skillet, fill it with hot olive oil, toss in a handful of frozen garlic, and would walk the hot skillet to your table, sizzling and crackling, and gathering the attention of everyone in the bar and restaurant. By the time the sizzling stopped, the garlic was ready to be spread on bread.

The origins of this dish can be traced to medieval Italy where it was a peasant dish meant to be served warm as a dipping sauce for vegetables, made from anchovies, garlic and olive oil. Bagna cauda itself is a variation on a French dish known as an Anchioade, a dish made from anchovies, garlic, and oil, served cold and used as a spread for bread.

You may ask why anchovies are central to both of these recipes, and interestingly enough it is due to salt. As you may know, salt was a precious commodity in the middle ages, heavily taxed, and not everyone could afford salt on their table. Enterprising merchants would pack salt under layers of anchovies to avoid the salt tax. One of the interesting things about anchovies is its ability to melt into a sauce with proper preparation. Because of the saltiness of anchovies, garlic is a great addition to the dish due to its pungent flavors.

My version of bagna cauda can be served warm or cold, can be served as a dipping sauce or spread on bread, and is very easy to make. This dish uses a lot of garlic. Seriously, you would not believe how much garlic you need to make for this dish. For this recipe you should get approximately two cups of bagna cauda, though your friends may ask why you didn't make more.

Ingredients:

- Garlic At least 10 heads of garlic
- Anchovies 10 ounces
- Olive Oil 1 cup
- Optional 1/4 cup butter if you like a creamier spread



Cooking with the Baron

• Step One – The garlic.

You will need at least 10 heads of fresh garlic. When I make this, I found that one package of garlic heads from Costco works well. You will need to peel all of the garlic cloves. Use whichever method you like to peel, including smashing the garlic, it is going to get pureed later, so you do not need to keep the garlic cloves whole.

You can also purchase pre-peeled garlic, though the pre-peeled garlic loses some of its flavor. If you purchase the pre-peeled garlic from your local grocery store, you will need five to seven packages (each package should have 4 or 5 smaller packets of garlic).

Once the garlic is peeled, place the garlic in a pot or large skillet and add olive oil. You want enough oil to coat the garlic, about 1 cup of oil. Place the stove on medium-low heat and let simmer for about an hour. The goal is to have fully cooked garlic that is soft to the touch, browned but not burnt.

• Step Two – The Anchovies.

Traditionally this dish calls for anchovies for that salty flavor. When I have made this in the past, I have taken it easy on the anchovies and most people cannot tell that there are any anchovies in the dish.

Anchovies packed in oil usually have been washed of salt and deboned, while anchovies packed in salt will need to be cleaned of salt and deboned. I recommend getting the anchovies packed in oil. You will need at least 10 ounces of anchovies


If you have an aversion to anchovies or fish, you can substitute capers for anchovies.


• Step Three – Making the bagna cauda.

In a food processor, combine the cooked garlic, olive oil, and anchovies. Pulse/chop the mixture until it is pureed into a chunky paste. If you want a creamier spread, use, add butter sliced into pieces, and puree until smooth.

Pour into your favorite bowl or serving dish and serve warm with bread and vegetables. Enjoy!
