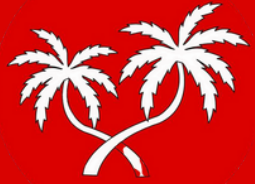

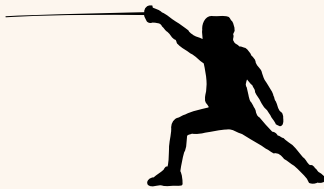

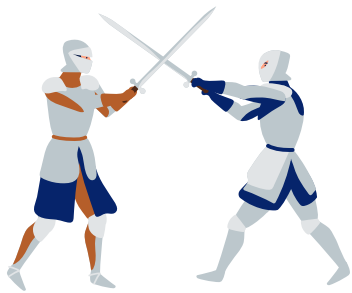

Fighter Practice at Encanto Soccer Field is 7:30 -10:00 PM on Wednesdays

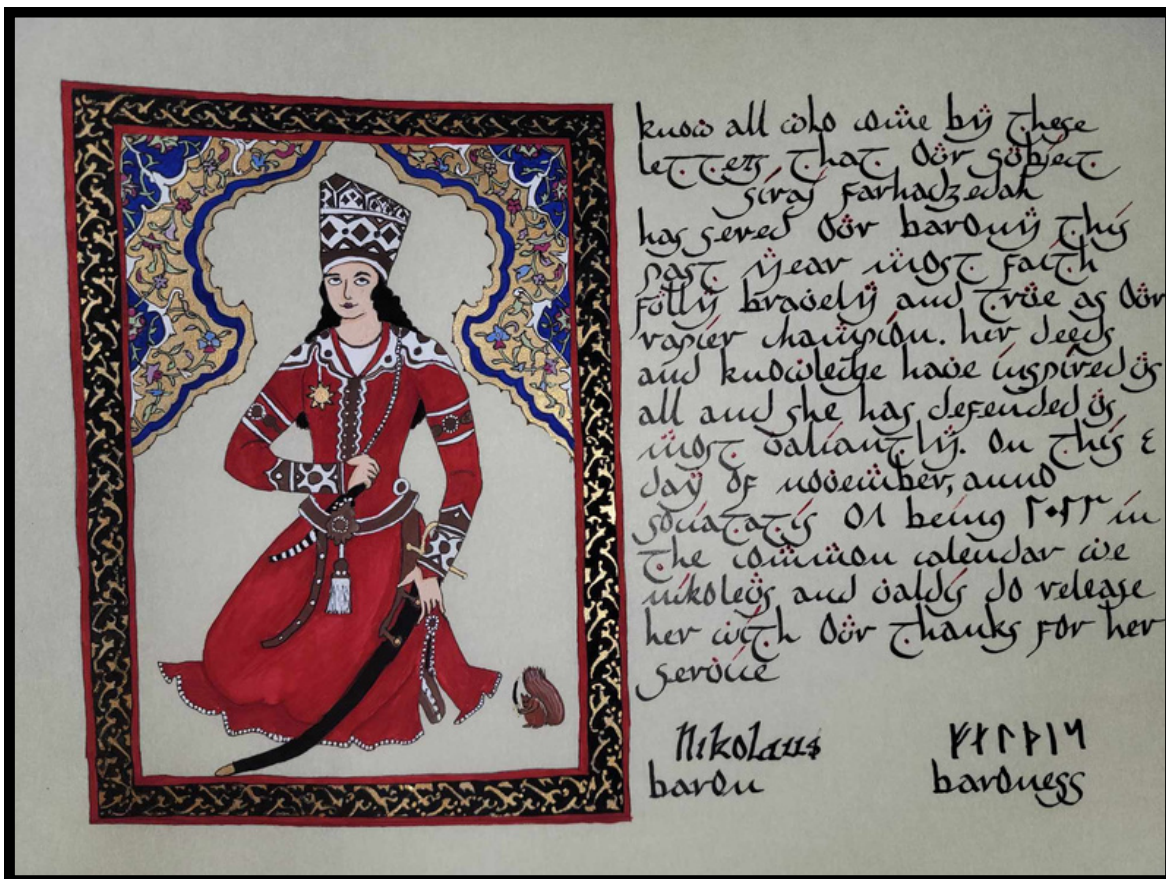


Fighters: Start arriving early to get armored up, lights will come on at 8, and we will start practice as close to that time as possible.
