

TIPS AND TRICKS: GARB EDITION

Last month, I used this space to give you some ideas about how to get started with the SCA, and hopefully you were able to take that advice and start coming to events! If you have, you have probably noticed that just about everyone who attends an SCA event does so in some form of period clothing. These outfits are commonly referred to as "garb" and dressing the part is a core aspect to our Society. For those eager to immerse themselves in medieval culture but unsure where to begin, fear not! This guide is your key to unlocking the magic of SCA garb with ease and confidence.

Let's start with the basics. SCA garb typically consists of tunics, dresses, pants, skirts, and overdresses. These simple garments serve as the foundation of your medieval wardrobe, allowing for endless combinations and customization. Additionally, these garments are not limited by gender identity, feel free to wear the garb that makes you feel comfortable and confident.

Whether you want to buy or make your own garb, here are some guidelines for where to start.

For those with sewing skills, there are plenty of beginner-friendly patterns available to help you create your own garb. Websites like Pinterest, Reddit, moodfabrics.com, and gathered.how offer a variety of free and inexpensive patterns for tunics, dresses, and more. Don't be afraid to start with something basic and work your way up as you gain confidence, and check YouTube or ask someone at an event for tutorials and advice. A good, easy place to start is with a T-shaped tunic of your desired length over a pair of neutral colored pants or under a Norse-style apron dress or simple kirtle.

Not handy with a needle and thread? No problem! There are plenty of nosew options for creating SCA garb. Consider repurposing existing clothing by adding medieval-inspired accessories like belts, hats, or scarves or embellishments such as trim, beading, or embroidery. Fabric glue and safety pins can also be used to create simple garments without any sewing required.

Choosing the right fabric is crucial for authentic-looking garb. Opt for natural fibers such as cotton, linen, or wool, which were commonly used in medieval times. Not only are these materials historically accurate, but they are also affordable and readily available at most fabric stores..


Garb-making doesn't have to break the bank. Thrift stores, fabric sales, and online marketplaces are great places to find affordable materials. Don't be afraid to get creative and think outside the box when sourcing materials for your garb. Remember, it's not about how much you spend, but the love and care you put into creating something uniquely yours.

As you embark on your garb-making adventure, remember that the journey is just as rewarding as the destination. When you do take your garb out for its first spin at an SCA event, be proud! You've taken a step that is brave and exciting and by showing off your creativity, you are enhancing the game for everyone. And don't forget, when you're at an event, look for people wearing garb that you admire and ask them about it! You'll walk away with some inspiration, tips, and maybe even a new friend.
