E-Newsletter Announcement

The Board policy on kingdom electronic newsletters (e-newsletters) is scheduled to take effect on January 1, 2012, with the first e-newsletter available being the March, 2012 issue. Here are some of the important details of this policy.

- All paid Sustaining and International members will have access to all SCA, Inc. kingdom e-newsletters via a password-protected website, even if they choose to continue receiving paper newsletters.
- All kingdom newsletters will be 8.5"x11" with a uniform page count to allow all the paper newsletters to be sent in one bulk mailing.
- Within each kingdom, the paper and electronic newsletters will contain the same information, but the kingdom will have the option of including a supplemental PDF of articles, photo essays, art, etc. for the newsletters website.
- Once the link to the e-newsletter website is available on www.sca.org (after January 1, 2012), you may discontinue your paper newsletter, no matter where you are in your membership cycle. However, please be aware that no refunds can be issued if you choose to do so.
- An e-newsletter will not constitute proof of membership.

As always, we encourage your comments and questions at comments@sca.org and will try to answer any question you may have. Your kingdom or officer ombudsman is always available to you to answer these questions directly and those assignments are listed in your newsletter and on the www.sca.org website. Land Allotment - Please remember that land allotment will depend on Pre-Registration numbers only. Make sure to Pre-Reg and indicate which group you plan to camp with so that they will be allotted the appropriate amount of land.

Family Cap - There is a new family cap rate of Members = \$150.00 (2 adults, 1 youth), Non-Members = \$160.00. Additional qualifying youth would be considered "free". You **must pre-register** to take advantage of this offer as it is not available at the Front Gate. For more information see the Estrella War website www.estrellawar.org

Deposit – The Deposit option is back this year. Pre-registered attendees can choose to pay their site fees in full or make a **one-time** deposit. The minimum for this deposit is \$20 for each youth and adult being registered, but more can be deposited in \$20 increments up to the full site fee. No further payments will be accepted online or via mail. The **one-time** deposit reserves your pre-registration and any balance due must be paid upon arrival to the War. **Your arrival date is dependent on the amount of money you deposit.** Only those who have **paid in full their pre-registration** will be allowed on site before general admission (Wednesday, March 28th, 2012 - 8:00 am).

For those Heroes who do not wish to compete we offer a helm auction so you may choose a fighter who will battle in your honor.

For those who may not have heard of Rett Syndrome here is a brief description of this syndrome and how it affects these Angels.

Rett Syndrome is a severe neurological disorder that primarily affects girls. Rett Syndrome is the most physically disabling of the autism spectrum disorders. Rett Syndrome is caused by a mutation in the gene MECP2 –a protein that regulates the expression of other genes by turning them off at the appropriate time. The mutation is spontaneous and the effects are seen in early childhood between 6 to 18 months of age. The disorder destroys speech, movement, and functional hand use. Many children lose the ability to walk, they struggle daily with severe seizures, scoliosis, breathing abnormalities, and often the child becomes dependent on others for a lifetime of care. These children's normal life expectancy is to the age of 14 to 17.
