Words from the Coronet

Unto the populace of the Barony of Ered Sul:

Their Excellencies Robert and Kolfinna will soon complete their warrant. Therefore, in accordance with Kingdom Law, The Crown is accepting Letters of Intent, from qualified couples, who wish to be considered as candidates for the position of Baron and Baroness. To be eligible for this position, candidates must be paid members of the SCA and reside within the zip codes assigned to the Barony of Ered Sul. Letters of Intent should be sent to the Crown with copies to the Kingdom Seneschal and the current Baron and Baroness of Ered Sul. Letters may be sent by either US Mail or email.

Letters of intent must be received by 1/31/2020.

The following information must be included in your Letter of Intent:

- Full contact information that includes both modern and SCA names, complete mailing address, phone number(s), and email addresses
- Proof of current membership
- A statement of your reasons for seeking the position
- A statement of your plans and dreams for the future of the Barony
- A brief statement of your history of participation in the Barony and within the SCA
- A statement that you fully understand the responsibilities of the positions of Baron and Baroness and that you are willing to commit to a three year term of office
- A statement that you understand that, if accepted as a candidate by the Crown, your Letter of Intent will be published in your baronial newsletter.

Staking is permitted. Site is discreetly wet (no glass bottles), pets allowed on leashes only, plenty of parking, grass fields and pavilions. A children's playground is nearby. Potable water and rest rooms are also close by.

Nearby Amenities: There are over a dozen hotels/motels and numerous food establishments. (Look for more detailed information as we get closer to the event). Davis-Monthan AFB is within 5 miles for military members Tucson International Airport is about 10 miles from site.

Directions:

From the North: Take I-10 East towards Tucson to exit 248 (Broadway Blvd/Congress Street). Use the left 2 lanes to take a left onto Congress Street. Continue straight through downtown Tucson for 1 mile. Once out of downtown stay to the right on AZ-210 (Aviation Highway). Continue on Aviation Highway, will turn into Golf Links Road, for 9 miles. Continued Turn right onto S. Pantano Road, continue for 0.5 miles. Turn left onto E. Stella Rd, continue for 0.5 miles. The park will be on your left.

Chronicler



Publishes a monthly newsletter (The Higher Word!). Ensures official Barony publications comply with copywrite and use creative works guidelines (e.g. collecting waivers to use photos). Assisting with baronial printing needs as required. Time commitment: Moderate

Herald



Announce opening and closing of Their Excellency's court, announce the presentation of awards, archives awards and submits record of awards to kingdom order of precedence, and consults populace on designing personal devices as needed. Time commitment: Moderate

Regalia Officer



Maintains list of baronial inventory, responsible for storage of equipment (trailer & storage unit). Arranges for transportation of equipment to events. Time commitment: Low

List Minister



The List Minister sets up and hosts tournaments throughout the year, organizes the fighters, and keeps track of wins and losses. The list minister must be impartial in all fights. Time commitment: Low (can be high commitment during events)

Gold Key



The Gold Key / Chatelaine welcomes newcomers to the SCA and our barony. This position is best filled by someone who is friendly and passionate about SCA and who can approach curious strangers. Time commitment: Low

Knight Marshall & Deputy



Duties include knowing and understanding combat rules and to teach them to combat participants. The deputy assists the Knight Marshall in enforcing safety rules, training and authorizing combatants, and ensuring participants and spectators remain safe. Time commitment: Moderate

Waiver Secretary

The Waiver Secretary manages and oversees the collections of various liability waivers. This position collaborates with the Exchequer(s) and Combat Marshals on maintaining waivers for event consent forms and fighter practice liability, as examples. Time commitment: Low

Sheriff & Deputy Sheriff



Organizing volunteers at baronial events, performs patrols, provides general help to event attendees, and assist event autocrats as needed. Time commitment: Low (can be high commitment during events)
