Winter is Coming!

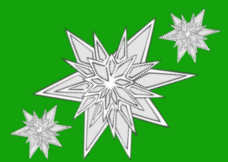

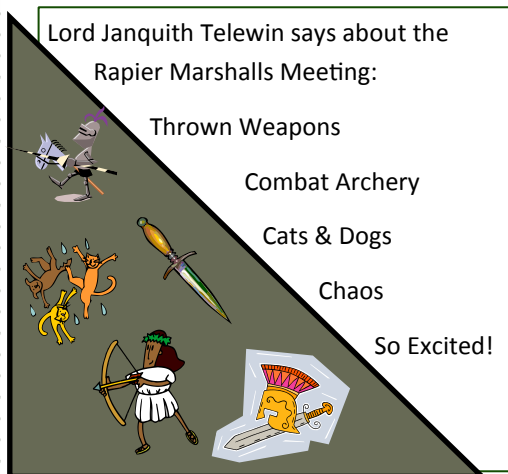
