Changes to LEX ATENVELDTUS published in the May 2017 Southwind

Additions

## II. Royalty

Definition:

The Crown is the office of Sovereign and Consort held by the King and Queen.

Duties and Privileges:

It is the responsibility of the Crown to fulfill their duties as outlined in Corpora.

### 1. Awards:

The Crown may only grant awards according to the requirements or charters of those awards.

A. The Crown may grant the authority to bestow awards that have been previously approved by the Crown to a duly appointed noble representative.

## IV. Lesser Officers and Offices of State

### D. Specific Duties (Report to Seneschal)

#### 2. Kingdom Calendar Officer:

- A. Be warranted by, and report directly to, the Kingdom Seneschal and the Crown.
- B. Publish and maintain an accurate Kingdom Calendar showing all events planned by official SCA groups in Atenveldt for the current calendar year and the next calendar year as follows:
- C. Ensure the calendar for the current month, and the 5 months following the current month, shall be published in the Kingdom Newsletter and on the Kingdom Website each month.
- D. Ensure that all Kingdom Events bid that have been accepted by the Kingdom Financial Committee are updated and shown on the calendar.
- E. By March of each year, open the calendar for the following calendar year, and schedule any
- F. Kingdom Calendar meeting(s) required to define the calendar. These meetings shall be jointly run by the Kingdom Seneschal and the Kingdom Calendar Officer.

**A. Baronies shall be limited to a maximum of three Kingdom Calendar events per year.**

**Shires and Colleges may each schedule up to two Kingdom Calendar events per year.**

**B. Baronies that combine an event with another Barony may schedule a maximum of one combined event plus three independent events on the Kingdom Calendar per year.**

g. Work with the Kingdom Seneschal and Kingdom Chronicler to ensure the submission of Event Forms for all calendared events, and maintain a current file of those forms.

h. Establish guidelines, timelines, and requirements for adding, removing and changing Official events on the Kingdom Calendar. These guidelines will be published to Royalty, the Territorial Barons and Baronesses, and Seneschals of all official groups in the Kingdom following each coronation, and shall be published and maintained on the Kingdom website.

i. Maintain an annual report of the number of official events scheduled and held by each official group in the Kingdom during the year, and publish that report annually to the Kingdom Seneschal (for inclusion in a Domesday Report), and on the Kingdom Website.

V. Territorial Baron and Baroness

H. Calendar and Events:

Attending, or designating representatives to attend, the annual Kingdom Calendar meeting held by the Kingdom Seneschal and Kingdom Calendar Officer and:

1. Negotiating with other SCA groups in the Kingdom to establish Kingdom Calendar Events to be held by the Barony during the next calendar year.

**A. Baronies shall be limited to a maximum of three Kingdom Calendar events per year. Shires and Colleges may each schedule up to two Kingdom Calendar Events per year.**

**B. Baronies that combine an event with another Barony may schedule a maximum of one combined event plus three independent events on the Kingdom Calendar per year.**

2. Sponsoring the solicitation of bids for **a minimum** of one Kingdom Event per year, as assigned during the annual Kingdom Calendar meeting. This sponsorship shall include both soliciting bids from either the Baronial populace or the populace of surrounding Shires, Cantons, or Colleges, and ensuring that a viable bid for that Kingdom Event is submitted and approved by the Kingdom Financial Committee at least six months prior to the date of the assigned Kingdom event.

3. Having the right to request reimbursement from Baronial funds for qualified travel expenses as outlined in section XII FINANCIAL GUIDELINES.

## **BARONY OF GRANITE MOUNTAIN BARONIAL POLLING**

A POLLING OF THE CURRENT PAID MEMBERS OF THE Barony of Granite Mountain will be conducted at Memory Park, 1020 W. Palomino Road, Chino Valley, AZ. 86323, to determine their support of candidates for Baron and Baroness. The polling will be held Sunday, July 9, 2017, from Noon to 1:30 p.m. The populace should be aware that if the first polling does not show a clear preference of the populace, a second polling will be held immediately following the closing and tabulation of ballots for the first poll. Members are encouraged to plan to remain onsite to participate should a second poll be necessary.

To participate in all polling's held that day, you must be a Sustaining, Associate, or Family member who is 18 years or older and must receive a Southwind or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Granite Mountain.

- A. Current paid memberships will be verified on a membership list at the polling site, or you may present an online membership renewal dated after the date the membership list was generated by the Milpitas Registry. The Kingdom Seneschal recommends you bring proof of membership with you to ensure participation in the poll.
- B. You must reside in zip codes belonging to the Barony of Granite Mountain, and this will be verified on the membership list at the polling site.

NOTE: Paid members who play in the Barony of Granite Mountain, but do not reside in the zip codes belonging to the Barony, may not cast ballots. However, they are encouraged to make their views on candidates known to the Crown by sending personal letters to the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal expressing their candidate selections and preferences. The Crown will consider such letters when reviewing the polling results.

- C. You must be 18 years old or older and present a picture ID at the polling site that shows your date of birth or age.

## BARONY OF GRANITE MOUNTAIN BARONIAL POLLING

### ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR BARONIAL POLLING

If you are unable to attend the polling to cast a ballot, you may follow the below procedures to submit an Absentee Ballot for the polling. Please understand that NO EXCEPTIONS will be made to the timeline or contents required for an Absentee Ballot to be counted. So please review the requirements carefully, and send your letters in as soon as the candidates are announced by the Crown.

#### **IF YOU WISH TO SUBMIT AN ABSENTEE BALLOT:**

- A. Write to the Kingdom Seneschal (email or a mailed letter) stating your preference in the poll. Emailed letters will be acknowledged by email. Mailed letters must include a self addressed, stamped envelope so receipt of the ballot can be acknowledged.
- B. Your letter must be **in the hands of the Kingdom Seneschal** no later than **Sunday, July 2, 2017**. Please mail ballots early enough to arrive by that date, and allow for delays in the mail. **Do not send ballots with signature required at delivery, as that may delay their receipt.**
- C. Your letter must include **ALL** of the following:
  - 1. Your candidate preference.
  - 2. SCA and modern name, and full mailing address for your membership.
  - 3. Proof of membership (membership number and membership expiration date)
  - 4. A scanned or hard copy of a picture ID showing you are 18 years old (or older).

Absentee ballots will be counted in the first polling. If a second or subsequent polling is conducted, and your ballot was for one of the candidates included in that poll, it will also be counted in the subsequent. If your ballot was for a candidate NOT included in the subsequent polling, it will not be counted.

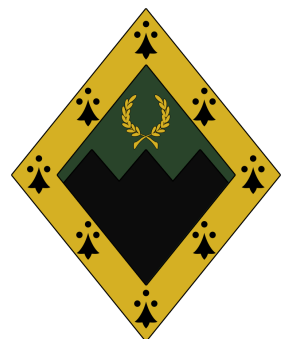
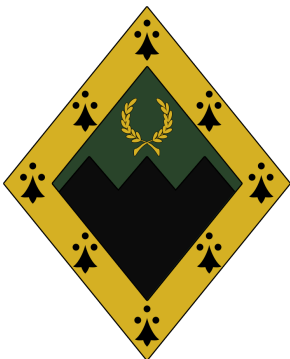

## **BARONY OF GRANITE MOUNTAIN POLLING AND QUARTERLY PRIZE TOURNAMENT**

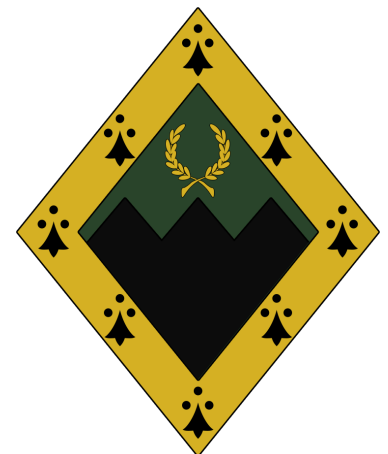
