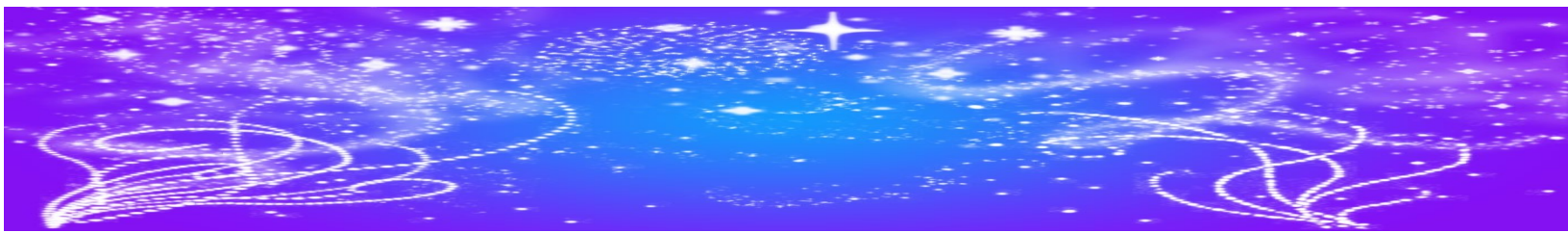

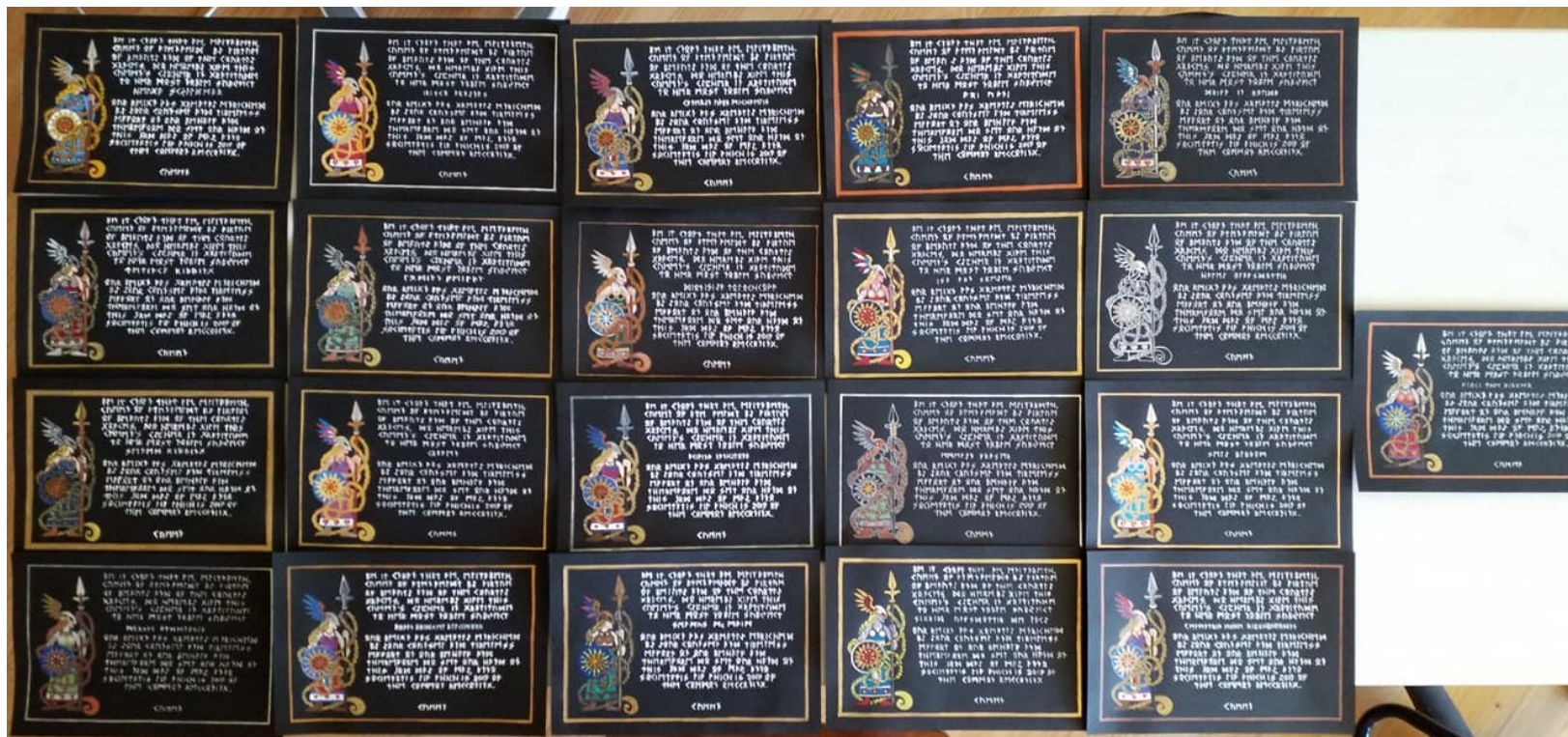

Come join us in the North when we celebrate the coming of summer and warmer weather. Now is the time to find out who will be the Best in the North for archery, combat fighting, rapier, A&S and more.

May 17, 18, 19 Opens at noon Friday

This is considered wilderness camping. Please bring plenty of food and water to sustain yourself and your crew during your journey. Also, bring your own garbage bags to pick up trash and carry it out when you leave the site.

Any open fires shall be determined by the National Forest Service. We will keep in touch with them for updates.

All critters are welcome as long as they are leashed and owners clean up after them. There will be porta potties for everyone else.

For folks wishing to bring their Rolling Castles, note that this is will be DRY RVing. Please turn off generators at 10:00pm. The closest black water dump will be outside of Williams at Love's Gas station north on exit 163.

Adult Non-member fee: \$20 Adult Fee: \$15 (\$5 discount for members) Youth fee: \$5

This Northern Prize event is approximately 6.5 miles south of Williams on Hwy 73

Directions: Take I-40 To Williams, Az. Take exit 163 south into town. Turn right (west) on Railroad Avenue to 4th street. Turn left (south) and drive for approximately 6.5 miles to FR 108. Then, turn right and follow the signs. The site will be on/near the SW corner of Hwy 73 and FR 108 as it was last year.

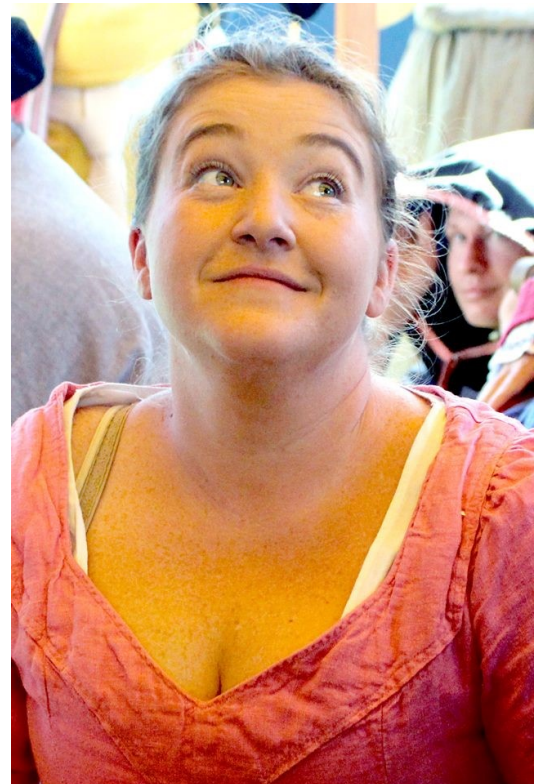

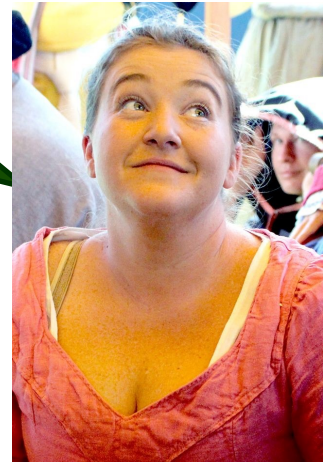
