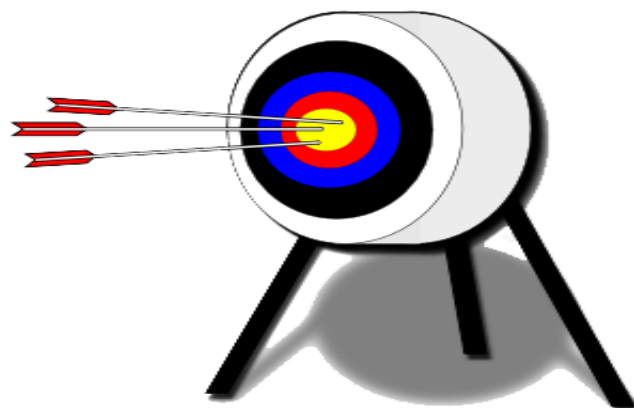
Archery Quarterly Tournament - Beastie Boys

Come seek your fortunes of treasure and fame as we discover who will be our future Champions. We invite all manner of sea going ruffian's, scoundrels, and raiders to come ashore, stretch your land legs, and spend your coin. As you step on the docks of our charming little seaport village, you'll be welcomed by the cool ocean breezes (cough, cough, mountain breezes, cough), blues skies, and shady pine trees. Speaking of shady, we ask that you please ignore those nasty rumors of thieves, assassins, and pickpockets running amok, it is simply hearsay. We have also cut down on the fighting in our streets to one, two, ok perhaps three fights at the most per day. We assure you that you and your crew will be safe!

The adventure all begins at 12 Noon on Friday the 13th (arrgh a fine day indeed!)

The Archery Range will open for practice, followed by the "X marks the Spot" Clout shoot. Who will find the buried Treasure?

There will also be a Youth, Treasure Hunt. Follow the clues and claim your prize.

The day's tournaments promise to be exciting for combatants and onlookers alike. Should your favorite fighter become Master of the Seas you too could benefit. Audience participation for all the days tournaments is needed and encouraged!

*All cutthroats and sharp shooters are invited to try their skills at Thrown Weapons, and Archery taking place on the range. Defend you ship against sea creatures and scallywags who would steal your treasure! Become "Master of the Seas" and you may claim your prize! *Arts and Sciences – All Artisans are invited to enter your handmade treasures of any type along with your documentation into the BGM A&S competition. The Barony will provide slow roasted meats of pork and beef prepared by my first mate HE Master Lutold, you the populace provide side dishes and desserts! Please bring enough to feed a boat load of hungry hooligans. To sweeten the deal, we will be offering a prize to the “Best Side Dish” and “Best Dessert” so impress your friends with a delicious delight and you could be rewarded!

But wait... that’s not all! After your hearty meal join us as we hear maritime stories, sea shanties, and perhaps a few bawdy ballads. *Bards, musicians, and storytellers come join us for our Bardic competition! The theme of our evening Bardic is Tale/Song of the Sea. The talented Bard who moves the crowd and judges will be our “Storyteller of the Seas” and receive a prize. During the course of the weekend activities all are invited to come by the tavern to build yourself a sailing vessel that is fit to go head to head in battle. We will have a collection of various materials on hand or feel free to use materials of your own to fashion a unique sailing ship (one ship per person). You may also build one at home and bring it to the event to race. Sunday will be the moment of truth as we compete to see who has built the fastest ship (like the boy scout raingutter regatta). Many ways to win, first, second, and third place winnings to the captains of the fastest ships!

Champions in the Pines will once again be held in the beautiful Bill Williams Watershed approximately 6.5 miles south of Williams on Hwy 73. Directions: Take your best route to I-40 towards Williams, AZ. Take exit 163 south towards downtown Williams. Turn right (west) on Railroad Ave. then left (south) on 4th St (which becomes Perkinsville Rd and then HWY 73.) Follow HWY 73 for approximately 6.5 miles to the site (at the intersection of Hwy 73 and FR 108.) Follow the SCA signs.

Site will open at 12 Noon on Friday the 13th and close at 4 pm on Sunday Sept. 15th.
Adult registration is \$30 for the weekend, or \$25. with a \$5-member discount. Adult day fee is \$15, or \$10. with a \$5-member discount. Youth 6–17 \$10 for the weekend, Youth day fee \$5. Children 5 & under free.

This site is considered wilderness camping. Please bring plenty of food and water to sustain yourself and your crew during your journey. Also, bring your own garbage bags to pick up trash and carry it out when you leave the site.

Any open fires shall be determined by the National Forest Service. We will keep in touch with them for updates.

All critters are welcome as long as they are leashed, and owners clean up after them. There will be porta potties for everyone else.

For folks wishing to bring your ship into port (RV camping), note that this is will be DRY RV'ing. Please turn off generators at 10:00pm. The closest black water dump will be outside of Williams at Love's Gas station north on exit 163.

When the skull and crossbones flew from the maintopmast of a pirate ship, it was an indication to intended victims that they were willing to give quarter. If they were opposed, it was replaced with the bloody red flag which meant: No mercy.

The French first flew a red flag which they called the JOLI ROUGE, pronouncing the final "e". The name was readily corrupted by the British sea-dogs and applied to their black flag. Another version defines the old English word, ROGER, as a synonym for the devil. Whatever the origin, the PIRATES OF THE CARIBBEAN used it effectively to terrorize their victims. Many versions of the JOLLY ROGER flew from pirate ships. These are but a few: (1) Capt. Jean-David Nau (L'Olonnois), (2) Capt. Edward England, (3) Capt. Emmanuel Wynne, (4) Capt. Edward (Blackbeard) Teach, (5) Capt. Thomas Tew, (6) Capt. Calico Jack Rackham, (7) Capt. Stede Bonnet, (8) Capt. Christopher Moody, (9) Capt. Bartholomew (Black Bart) Roberts, the last of the great pirates.

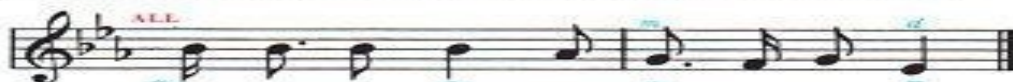

Champions in the Pines - Declaring BGM Champion



Declaring for BGM Champion,

All BGM Champions must reside within the lands of Granite Mountain. There will be (8) Champions that will be decided at Champions in the Pines. These Champions are as follows: Armored Combat, Rapier, Cut & Thrust, Archery Hand bow, Archery Crossbow, Arts & Sciences, Bardic, and Thrown Weapons. Populace members of Granite Mountain wishing to pursue one or more of these titles of Champion must first formally declare your intentions. You may do this in one of two ways. You can send a letter of intent to the Vicar and Vicaress at bgmcoronet@gmail.com or talk to the Vicar and Vicaress personally about your intentions. **The deadline to declare for Champion will be September 7, 2019 prior to the event. No one will be permitted to declare for Champion after that date.**

Duties of a Barony of Granite Mountain Champion:

Important! Anyone who is considering declaring to become a Champion for the barony please read over these words carefully.

As Champion you will be expected to:

- ◆ Be a paid member of the Society.
- ◆ Attend Their Excellencies in Baronial Court (Northern War Practice, May event, BGM Collegium, Champions in the Pines, and Northern Yule). If the Champion attends an event outside of the Barony where the Baron and Baroness are also in attendance, be prepared to stand with them during court.
- ◆ Bring and proudly wear Baronial regalia of your office to events/courts. These items must be kept safe and in good repair (damage/loss will be your responsibility). Champion Regalia is the property of the Barony of Granite Mountain and must be returned at the end of your tenure when a new champion is chosen. If for any reason you must step down as Champion prior to that time you must return the regalia to Their Excellencies.
- ◆ Represent the Barony of Granite Mountain in tournaments, and competitions often! (Kingdom, Baronial, etc.). Be prepared to meet challenges be it with song, bow, or sword as needed.
- ◆ Process with Their Excellencies into court as well as out to the battlefield/range.

Champions in the Pines - Declaring BGM Champion



- ◆ Be prepared to plan, organize and run the following years competition for Champion that you currently represent. This includes making sure you have marshals, lists, securing a prize, etc.
- ◆ Attend Baronial practices and meetings regularly and assist the Baronial officers with instruction.
- ◆ Teach and promote within the Barony the particular field that you represent as Champion. You will advise Their Excellencies on matters relating to your field.

The Baronial Champion will serve a one-year term from Champions in the Pines 2019 to 2020. During that time, they will be the representative in that field for the Barony, Their Excellencies, and the populace of Granite Mountain. A BGM Champion will be expected to conduct themselves in the appropriate manner befitting their title.

Please note*

By making a formal declaration for Champion you are stating that you understand what is expected should you become Baronial Champion and are willing to accept these duties & responsibilities.
