Greetings to the Populace of Granite Mountain!

As you are aware, Covid-19 has brought some changes to our Kingdom regarding the holding of events. At this time Baronial Polling is due to occur on July 25, 2020. However the Crown and Heirs, for the safety of the Kingdom, have requested that in-person events not be held until on/before August 1st, 2020. As such, a back up plan has been approved by the Society, for the polling procedure. Below are the guidelines we will follow to allow for the polling; We will be keeping everyone up to date on whether or not there are any changes to this process for any reason. - 4. Your vote must state the full name of the couple you are supporting OR you may state NO CONFIDENCE, should you oppose both couples entirely.


