There will be three or four crock-pots full of delicious food. Grazing foods are gratefully accepted.



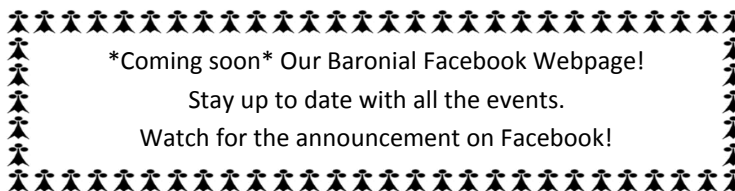

Unto Our Beloved Populace of The Barony of Granite Mountain Do We, Brian and Lia, Send Greetings:

During the past two years, Crown Officers have been investigating and working to resolve a troubling incident. A large sum of money was stolen from Our Barony of Granite Mountain, and was never recovered. In keeping with Society protocols, the Kingdom Seneschal and Exchequer provided relevant evidence to the local police, an investigation was begun and charges were filed.

The process in the criminal courts was monitored by Our Kingdom High Chancellor's Office, and the Crown was kept abreast of all events. Ultimately, the local prosecutor declined to proceed to trial because he believed there was insufficient evidence available to obtain a conviction upon proof beyond a reasonable doubt. Therefore, the case was dismissed from the criminal court.

In keeping with Seneschal protocols, the Kingdom will forward it's report to the Society Seneschal. The Society may or may not take further action. We regard the matter of this theft as closed, though regrettably unsolved.

This incident arose because those involved were careless or dishonest, and both failed to follow proper procedures for transfer of Kingdom funds. Those who were involved in the handling of the missing funds have been advised and appropriately dealt with. Again, We regard the matter as closed at the Kingdom level.

As for those who were the subject of Our investigation, their implication in the matter has been vetted through the due process of the courts and Our Kingdom. No further sanctions are being contemplated by the Crown at this time.

We ask that the People of the Mountain once again embrace and accept those who were involved in this unfortunate incident. We shall move forward as One.

# SCA World News



## CREATION OF THE ORDER OF DEFENSE

Due to the large amount of information surrounding the additional peerage for rapier and cut and thrust, the Board of Directors decided to participate in a conference call on February 2, 2015. The Board received a large amount of additional comments and suggestions in the two weeks following the January 17 quarterly meeting. This was considered in addition to the first Board call for commentary on this issue.

At the February 2, 2015 special conference call meeting of the Board of Directors, the Board discussed the history of the APEC proposal process, the commentary received from the membership, and the various options available to the Board. The Order of Defense proposal was the result of many years of effort, and while the commentary from the membership opened the Board's eyes to other options and possibilities, the Board decided at this time to reconsider the proposal to change Corpora to create the Order of Defense. During the call a motion was made and seconded to approve the changes to Corpora, and such motion passed 6 votes for and 1 against.

Motion to approve the proposed changes to Corpora that will create the new peerage, Order of Defense, and direct Laurel Sovereign of Arms to submit such name and heraldry to the heraldic comment process, with the intention of opening the Order on May 1, 2015. Voted in favor of the motion: Arthur Donadio, Andrew Coleman, John Fulton, David Keen and Lisa May. Voted against the motion: Lisa Czudnochowsky. Chairman Scott Berk exercised his option to vote and did so in favor of the motion. Motion passed.

Motion in the matter of the Order of Defense to waive the requirements of Corpora Section IV.G that the Crown consult the members of a peerage order prior to inducting new members of that order, but only in the case of the first three (3) members of the Order of Defense. Once there are three members of the Order of Defense in a kingdom, the Crown must consult the Order per Corpora prior to adding members. Voted in favor of the motion: Arthur Donadio, Andrew Coleman, Lisa Czudnochowsky John Fulton, David Keen and Lisa May. Opposed: none. Chairman Scott Berk exercised his option to vote and did so in favor of the motion. Motion passed.

No candidate may be inducted into the Order of Defense before May 1, 2015. All candidates inducted into the Order of Defense on May 1, 2015, will carry equal precedence, regardless of the time of day each such candidate was inducted.

Five years ago, the enormous response in favor of a path to peerage was specifically focused on rapier and cut and thrust combat. When and if another martial activity engenders the response from the membership at large that rapier and cut and thrust did, when another martial activity has the depth, breadth and community as exists for rapier and cut and thrust, then the Board of Directors may investigate the possibility of facilitating a path to peerage for such martial activity.

# Meet the Kingdoms



## Sept. 7th, 1969:

A preliminary meeting was held at Mike Reynold's house, to organize a chapter of the Society for Creative Anachronism in the Phoenix area. In attendance were Rick Cook (Richard Ironstead), Mike Reynolds, then called "Michael the Inebriated" (but soon to become "Michael of Moria," as the powers that be, in California, were not thrilled about having their legal agent in Arizona, called "The Inebriated"), and his wife Judy (Lady Ann of the Golden Rose).

## Sept. 24, 1969:

The first official meeting of the S.C.A. was held in Phoenix.

The name "Atenvel(d)t" was chosen. The name came from the combination of an Egyptian sun god, known as Aton, and the German word for land.

***Atenveldt became the first Barony in the Known World  
and the first Principality!***

Atenveldt was the first Barony of the West Kingdom (and the SCA) -- November, 1969 (AS IV)

The first tournament in Atenveldt was held December 7, 1969 (AS IV)

As there was no Baron and Baroness, January, 1970, the Barony became a Province instead.

Atenveldt became the first Principality of the West Kingdom (and the SCA) February 22, 1970 (AS IV).

Atenveldt's first Coronet Tournament and Investiture was held April 12, 1970 (AS IV), the victor of the tournament was Robert Roundpounder, fighting for Angela of the Meadows.

## Jan. 16th, 1971:

The first Crown Tournament and the first Coronation were held at McCormick Park, Scottsdale, AZ.

Duke Henrik of Havn was the emissary from King Jean. At this tourney Atenveldt became a Kingdom. Prince Robert and Princess Kathleen presided. The first Crown lists were held.

Sir Richard Ironsteed was the winner, defeating Timothy the Traveler (now Sir Ton the Traveler). Felicia MacChlurain was Sir Richard's lady.

Duke Henrik presented Sir Richard with the Crown of Atenveldt, along with the title of the Principality of Atenveldt, the Barony of Caerthe, the Barony of New Mexico, and all lands between the West and the East and below the Middle.

King Richard then crowned himself and his lady Felicia as the first King and Queen of the Kingdom of Atenveldt.

Man first walked on the moon.

Senator Edward Kennedy drove a car off a bridge at Chappaquiddick and a campaign aide, Mary Jo Kopechke died.

A quarter of a million people met in New York to attend a three day rock concert called Woodstock.

The Chicago Seven went on trial in Chicago, facing charges of inciting to riot from incidents surrounding the 1968 Democratic National Convention.

The U.S. had more than 480,000 soldiers in Vietnam and in October, there was a national moratorium to protest this war.

Top grossing movies were; "Goodbye Columbus", "The Wild Bunch" and "Midnight Cowboy."

Top rated TV shows included; "Mission: Impossible", "The Newlywed Game" and "Hee Haw".

Top record albums included the soundtracks to the movie "Romeo and Juliet" and "Hair."

Top musical groups included Cream and Blood Sweat and Tears.

Top selling books included; Mario Puzo's "The Godfather" and Michael Crichton's "Andromeda Strain"

and 2,000 fans in New York greeted a new professional football player, named O.J. Simpson, when he arrived for training with the Buffalo Bills!
