





King & Queen's Royal Arms

Awards and Their Charters (A Summary)

1. [Blood of Fenris](#) Given by the Crown to individuals who demonstrate skill and enthusiasm in the fighting arts.

Blazon: *Fieldless, a wolf passant argent goutty de sang.*

2. [Golden Blade](#) Given by the Crown to individuals who have shown skill in the art of defense with the rapier.

Blazon: *Azure, two rapiers inverted crossed in saltire and in base a rose Or.*

3. [Hawk's Lure](#) Given by the Crown to individuals who show excellence in the fighting arts through teaching and use of traditional SCA style weaponry.

Blazon: *Insignia is a handmade hawk's lure, to be worn suspended from the belt.*

4. [Beacon of the Desert](#) Given by the Crown to individuals who have given service to the Kingdom of Atenveldt.

Blazon: *Argent, a sun in splendor per saltire Or and azure and a bordure indented azure.*

Block Printing at Aurora's

Block printing on Fabric! It was all the rage in the middle ages. Well, at least it was something that was done in ancient China, & later in India, but also found in parts of Europe in the medieval times. Block printing is a fabulous way to decorate your SCA attire that's different from trim or embroidery. Aurora of the Horny Horses has done several block printing projects & others in the Barony were interested in learning more about block printing on fabrics. So we held a collaboration at her home & used various types of blocks, paint, & techniques. Attendees were **Aurora, Isabelle, HE Jacqueline, & Kolfina.**

The paints we used were a combination of paints from Jacquard and Speedball. Using the regular Tulip or fabric paints from your local craft stores are typically don't work well for block printing. The Jacquard paints require heat setting. The Speedball block printing inks do not, but the Speedball screen printing inks do. There are several techniques that we collaboratively have done. Originally when Aurora started doing it, she was using a small paint roller with which you would paint wall trim. However, this uses a lot of paint and these paints aren't cheap. So, Aurora had used a stippling sponge to apply the paint to the block. This works well if you don't have a large block to do because otherwise the paint gets dry. The technique most of us like the best was using a rubber roller to apply the paint. First you put the paint onto a piece of glass (in this case we used every bit of Aurora's Pyrex cake pans in her house), then roll it out to cover the roller. Once the roller has a consistency that looks a little like stucco, you roll it both directions on your block stamp .

Blocks can be purchased at craft stores or online. However, you may purchase a linoleum block & carve it yourself or have your favorite artist make you a custom block. This is a great option if you have a device you'd like to replicate. A recommendation, if you get a custom block is to cut the extra surfaces off so that you have less risk of getting paint on your fabric where you don't want it. Isabelle shared that she had used several large foam stamps on her tent with fleur de lis.



“Watch for another block printing class at Mixed Weapons War!”

We primarily block printed on linen scraps, but you block print on any fabric. It's highly recommended that you test your block printing on scrap fabric of the same kind that you are using for your project.

Since you are working with fabric paint/ink, you want to be sure you have an appropriate backing or surface you are working on. Aurora covers her sewing cardboard cutting board with a flocked plastic table cloth that she doesn't mind if it gets paint on it. Isabelle brought specially made boards that have some give in them. If you attempt to press your block down on the fabric without having something with a little give behind it, your print may not come out very well. In addition, if you have a piece of clothing that is already sewn, you will need to consider putting something between the layers so that you will prevent bleed through onto sections you don't want paint.

We had a lot of fun with the colors & different blocks. There were small ones that would make great trim. The larger ones could be used as an overall pattern. We really liked how the black & gold colors popped on the black linen. We even combined the blue & the pearlescent white to have a shiny blue dragon. We had a great time playing & learning from each other.

Non-gmail account holders can be added but you will have an inhibited experience (option B). Creating a Gmail account is recommended but not required in any way (option A).



If you want to continue to receive emailed announcements and calendar updates for SunDragon, you will need to use one of the following processes:

The Baronial Exchequer is like the treasurer for our local chapter of the SCA.

General requirements for this position:

- Must be a current paid member of the SCA in good standing, & must remain so for the length of the warrant (a minimum of 2 years).
- Must have a computer capable of running Excel & Word.
- Must have experience using Excel, including familiarity with formulas & working in large work-books.
- Must have dependable access to the internet, the ability to regularly check & respond to email, the ability to send & receive emailed reports & attachments, & the ability to communicate with other SCA Officers using email & mail groups.
- Must have knowledge of, or willingness to learn (fast), double entry accounting on a “cash” basis.
- Must be familiar with Society & Kingdom Financial Policies & the administration of SCA financial guidelines.
- Must be willing to be a signer on all bank accounts in the Kingdom (your SSN may be required as part of the information given to banking institution), review bank statements for numerous Kingdom/Baronial Accounts, & reconcile bank accounts for the Kingdom/Barony.
- Must manage & track SCA warranting, reporting, & compliance with SCA financial guidelines by Exchequers & Regalia Officers throughout the Kingdom.
- Must be willing to be responsible to the Society for all assets held by the Barony.
- Must create & manage a budget for the Barony of SunDragon, & serve as a Chairperson or member on several financial committees.

This position requires regular communication between Society officers, Kingdom of Atenveldt officers, & officers in local groups throughout the Kingdom. Must be available to work with & manage Exchequer Deputies for the barony & manage & coordinate running of the front gate for Baronial & some Kingdom events hosted by the Barony of SunDragon.



