Animals will be known as Flames.

Animals will be given a medallion.

BARONESS/BARON'S DRENGR OF SUNDRAGON

This will be a weekend event full of fun, fighting, and pageantry located in the Barony of Tir Ysgithr.

Saturday: you will witness the most Glorious Tournament of our Kingdom where the heirs of Their Royal Majesties of Atenveldt will rise in victory. Join us as we welcome the new heirs while enjoying companionship and revelry in the beautiful lands of southern Atenveldt in the Barony of Tir Ysgithr.

On Saturday throughout the day - there will also be a Largesse Derby for those who wish to display and donate their art to show how gracious and generous Atenveldt artisans are. We are asking that anyone interested in donating Largesse to our kingdom, bring THREE items to the Largesse Derby Competition. The Derby winner will be allowed to choose one item to keep from the offerings. Have each item labeled with a description and your name, and be suitable to present to Crowns and

Coronets of the known world, and be small enough to fit on a plane. Note: scented items must include an ingredients list and be packaged in sealed bags to allow a screen for allergies and prevent cross contamination of items.

Sunday: the biannual Warlord tournament will be held to reveal the kingdom's most worthy mass weapons fighter that will help lead our armies in war. We will also hold the Queen's Rapier Champion tournament to identify the greatest rapier fighter our kingdom has. This tournament signifies the Atenveldt fighter with the greatest prowess in steel swordsmanship. We look forward to your attendance!

Site Information: Showers are available as well as stone privies! There are 3 shower stalls in each bathroom. There is potable water onsite and dumpsters for trash. The site is a Wet site, glass is allowed, but as always, clean up after yourself. Pets are welcome on a leash, and fires are in designated spots as well as any propane fires elevated from the ground. Quiet Hours are from 10 PM to 7 AM. Please be respectful of the other sites.

RV Campers – Reserve your spot online at <https://azstateparks.com/.../camping.../rv-and-tent-camping>. There are limited RV sites available with electric, sewage, and water hookups. You will have to book your campsite separate from the event. Reservations can be cancelled 60 days prior to the event, though there is a \$3.20 non-refundable reservation fee. Sites are \$35 per night. If you are camping at the park in an RV, please preregister for the event specifying you onsite and in an RV and your event fee will be compensated.

Equestrian – There is camping at the Equestrian Center for an additional \$25 per night, though you do not have to camp with your horse if you choose to stay at the registered group sites. There are 16 corrals for horses at the park available as a first come, first served basis. There will not be any formally organized equestrian activities at the event, however, the park boasts many horse friendly trails, and horses are welcome to attend the event, but cannot stay in the group campgrounds overnight. Please refer any additional questions about equestrian facilities and reservations to the park (520) 628-5798.

Parking: When you arrive at the gate, you do not have to pay for parking, simply explain that you are here for the SCA event, and you will be given a parking pass. If you have a state park pass, we ask that you use that instead to help with event costs. Parking for this event is limited. We ask everyone to please carpool whenever possible. Just across the street, there is an In and Out Burger with a huge parking lot. We strongly recommend that you park there and carpool on the way into the park.

For fighters that choose to sleep in nearby hotels: The Holiday Inn Express Oro Valley- Tucson North is the closest hotel, 3 miles from the park (average rates under \$100/night).




Honor of Sun Dragon

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Commander of the Dragon's Fury of Sundragon. It may be given by the Baron or Baroness to full Companions of the Dragon's Fury of Sundragon who have demonstrated high merit and continued activity in fighting arts within the Barony of Sundragon.



Order of the Dragon's Scale

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Order of the Dragon's Scales. It may be given by the Baron/ess to those persons who have excelled in the Arts in the Barony of Sundragon. The holders of this Award shall be entitled to place after their name CDS; and shall be styled as Companions of the Order of the Dragon's Scales.




Commander of the Dragon's Scale

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Order of the Dragon's Heart. The Order of the Dragon's Heart may be given by the Coronet of Sundragon to individuals who have shown the worthy qualities of courtesy and courtly behavior with such consistency that they are recognized to be an example of gallantry to all.



Commander of the Dragon's Heart

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Commander of the Dragon's Heart of Sundragon which shall be given by the Baron or Baroness to full Companions of the Dragon's Heart of Sundragon who continue to show the qualities of courtesy and courtly behavior with such consistency that they should be recognized as an example of gallantry to all.



Order of the Rainbow's Promise

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Order of the Rainbow's Promise. The Order of the Rainbow's Promise may be given by the Coronet of Sundragon to individuals under sixteen years of age who are a radiant example of the promise of the Dreame by their efforts in the many aspects of the Society, which may include arts, service, the fighting arts, and who display a good knowledge of the courtly graces.

Baroness's Cavaliers

There shall exist, in the Barony of Sundragon, an order known as the Order of the Baroness' Cavaliers which may be given at the pleasure of the Baroness to members of the populace

of Sundragon who have demonstrated all of the following qualities:

- A. Exceptional skill and chivalry in combat with the weapons of the duello. Duello shall be taken to refer to rapier combat.
- B. Knowledge of the Courtly Graces, such as music, dance and other gentle arts.
- C. Obedience to the laws of the Society for Creative Anachronism, the Kingdom of Atenveldt, and the Barony of Sundragon.
- D. Consistent, courteous and noble behavior.
- E. Authenticity in dress, equipment and behavior, in keeping with their chosen "Persona".
- F. Show a willingness to share their knowledge and skills with others.



Order of the Dragon's Eye of Sundragon

Charter

In Anno Societatis LIX (59), during the Reign of Their Royal Majesties Morgan and Elizabeth, under the stewardship of Elizabeth and Duncan, Baroness and Baron of Sundragon there was created an award known as the Order of the Dragon's Eye of Sundragon, was created the Premier of _____, 2025.

1. There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Order of the Dragon's Eye of Sundragon, which will be given by the Baroness and Baron, subject to the pleasure of the Crown, to those persons who have displayed excellence in the performance, promotion and teaching of the chivalrous art of archery.
2. The holders of this award shall be styled as Companions of the Dragon's Eye of Sundragon and shall be entitled to place the initials C.D.E. after their names. The Premier of the Order shall be the first person to receive this award.
3. The insignia of the Order shall consist of a leather medallion presented on a red, white, and blue ribbon, whose design shall be: "(Fieldless) On a set of nesting scale weights Or a lozenge purpure."
4. Companions of the Order shall be listed in the Kingdom Order of Precedence after Kingdom and Principality awards, and after the Awards of Arms.
5. Amendments to this charter shall be made by the Baroness and Baron of the Barony of Sundragon, after due consultation with the Crown of Atenveldt.
6. Companionship of previous recipients of this award is hereby confirmed.
7. The Principal of the Order shall be the Baronial Coronet. The Protector of the Order shall be the Crown of Atenveldt.



Seneschal

The Seneschal's office handles the business side of our dream. These individuals compile monthly reports, run the officer's meeting, sign contracts, maintain warrants, and more.

Here are just a few of their responsibilities:

- Monthly Reports to the Kingdom Seneschal and Baroness and Baron
- Signing contracts for event spaces
- Run the monthly meetings for the officers and populace.
- Be a signer on the bank account for the barony.
- Keep track of the warrants for the officers
- Attend the annual Calendar meeting with the Baroness and Baron.

You must have regular access to a computer, printer and be able to use Google groups and docs.



Deputy Exchequer & Emergency Deputy Exchequer

Often assists the Exchequer by helping to manage gate at baronial events (Mixed Weapons War, Fabric War, Champions, and Solstice) or kingdom events hosted by the barony (e.g., coronation). These positions will require a couple of hours of work at those events.

Being a **deputy** is a great way to get a taste for what responsibilities the office holds without committing to the office fully or to learn the role while the current officer still occupies the position so you could possibly take over for them in the future. If you have held the primary role before but do not want to currently fill the position an **Emergency or "drop dead" deputy** might be the spot for you. These positions are in case the current officer needs to step back from their responsibilities due to any reason they may have and allows the barony to have someone step in while we look for someone new to fill the office. May be asked to help in training the new officers.



Waiver Secretary

The **waiver secretary** ensures that all participants have signed the waiver required for participation at local practices/meetings. You will maintain a membership roster and collect non-member insurance waivers and verify memberships at all baronial events and meetings as well as submit a monthly report. This position is a great way to meet people.



Social Media Officer

Duties include, but are not limited to maintaining the Facebook Groups and Pages for the Barony of SunDragon as outlined by the SCA, Inc. Social Media Policy as published and updated by the

Society Seneschal office (<http://www.sca.org/docs/pdf/SCASocialMediaPolicy.pdf>). You will be responsible for assisting the Kingdom Social Media Officer in monitoring content and updating events, groups and pages as needed. Experience with Facebook is a must and Google Groups is also preferred.

Social Media Officers must be able to:

- Administer the office in a fair and tempered manner remembering you are the voice of your Office, your Barony, and the Kingdom of Atenveldt (responsible use of social media)
- Use proper etiquette and grammar.
- You must have an ability to access the internet and pages from your phone and computer, both during day and evening hours. While we do not expect you to be online at all times, you should be "connected".



Webminister

The Webminister maintains the Baronial website and ensures the timely uploading of content.

Webministers must meet the membership requirements of the office as outlined in Corpora. If a Webminister's membership lapses during the term of office that officer's warrant is considered terminated immediately upon expiration.

This position is very time consuming and working with additional deputies is strongly encouraged. While there are some technical aspects to this position, it is mostly one of managing processes and administration.

The ideal candidate for this position would be a self-motivated individual with strong management and average or better technical skills and a general understanding of web technology such as Hosting, DNS, and HTML. None of us is perfect, but there are some minimum requirements:

- Experience with writing or editing content
- Balance and judgment in matters political
- A computer with reliable, fast internet connection available 24 hours a day
- A working telephone
- Regular contact with Kingdom/Baronial activities
- Ability to meet the ongoing requirements of the Webminister position, primarily but not limited to: Regular updates to Baronial website, Timely responses to inquiries and communications from corporate officers and members of the Board of Directors, as well as other Kingdom/Baronial level officers, Submission of entries/reports to the Kingdom Webminister, Maintaining local website on par with Kingdom policy compliance, Other duties and special projects that may be assigned by the Society /Kingdom Webminister
