Spring Coronation (BMMT) May 2nd-4th, 2025

When: Friday, May 2nd-Sunday, May 4th, 2025; Site opens at 2:00pm on Friday and closes at 4:00pm on Sunday

Location: Holy Trinity Monastery Center, 1605 S St Marys Way, Saint David, AZ 85630 Event Fees:

- Full Event Preregistered: \$25 for members, \$35 for non-members, youth 17 and under are free
- Day Trip Preregistered: \$20 for members, \$30 for non-members, youth 17 and under are free

Come witness the coronation of the next Crowns of Atenveldt at the Holy Trinity Monastery Center in St. David, Arizona!

The ceremony will take place Saturday, May 3rd in the great hall, and on Sunday, tournaments will take place on the Monastery grounds to help their Royal Majesties' Heirs choose their champions for the Kingdom. Champion competitions are at Their Royal Highness' discretion and preference.

On the property are an auditorium, adobe chapel, library, and several artesian-fed ponds. The monastery's accommodations include a gift and coffee shop that is welcome to the public, usually on Friday and Saturday. There are also shade trees, several ponds, a pecan grove (pecans sold in the gift shop), stone privies, and on-site water spigots.

Parking and privies are generally easily accessible and within a short walking distance from anywhere on the site. For ADA accommodation questions concerning parking, camping, and restrooms, please contact our main autocrat, Lady Ysolde.

Staying on Site

Early planning with on-site rv, room, and trailer accommodations is greatly encouraged. All on-site rv and room fees are paid directly to the Holy Trinity Monastery Center. The ability to camp on site, RV camp (free dry and paid hookups), or rent a room on site is available - but space and occupancy is limited! Staking is allowed. Discreetly wet. Above ground fire pits in designated areas are permitted (with fire extinguisher).

Please be aware that this event occurs in the month of May, after minimal rain. There are fewer weeds, but there is more dust. There are also ants and gopher holes; these will try to be managed prior to the event, but they will still be a potential issue.

Camping on Site Camping is free, and only requires filling out the Pre-Registration form to indicate you are interested in camping so that we can make sure there is space to accommodate you. Camping will be an open land grab, with first come first served. Staking is allowed. Each tent and pavilion should have a fire extinguisher in a readily available area. Please be aware that we MAY NOT be using the same camping area as we previously did.

Rooms and Rental Trailers on Site: Accommodations on site are available for rent through and paid to the Monastery. Most have single beds with AC and access to a restroom and shower. Some trailers and cottages with multiple rooms are also available. Space is limited so contact them early for details and to make reservations. More options are available since construction has been completed on many rooms. RVs

The site accommodates RVs with either full, partial, or dry hookups and accommodations. Space is limited. RV hookups are \$35 for full hookups and \$25 for partial hookups, payable to the site. Dry RV camping is free.

The Barony of SunDragon is soliciting applications for the following positions:



Seneschal

The Seneschal's office handles the business side of our dream. These individuals compile monthly reports, run the officer's meeting, sign contracts, maintain warrants, and more.

Here are just a few of their responsibilities:

- Monthly Reports to the Kingdom Seneschal and Baroness and Baron
- Signing contracts for event spaces
- Run the monthly meetings for the officers and populace.
- Be a signer on the bank account for the barony.

- Keep track of the warrants for the officers
- Attend the annual Calendar meeting with the Baroness and Baron.

You must have regular access to a computer, printer and be able to use Google groups and docs.



Deputy Exchequer & Emergency Deputy Exchequer

Often assists the Exchequer by helping to manage gate at baronial events (Mixed Weapons War, Fabric War, Champions, and Solstice) or kingdom events hosted by the barony (e.g., coronation). These positions will require a couple of hours of work at those events.

Being a **deputy** is a great way to get a taste for what responsibilities the office holds without committing to the office fully or to learn the role while the current officer still occupies the position so you could possibly take over for them in the future. If you have held the primary role before but do not want to currently fill the position an **Emergency or "drop dead" deputy** might be the spot for you. These positions are in case the current officer needs to step back from their responsibilities due to any reason they may have and allows the barony to have someone step in while we look for someone new to fill the office. May be asked to help in training the new officers.



Waiver Secretary

The **waiver secretary** ensures that all participants have signed the waiver required for participation at local practices/meetings. You will maintain a membership roster and collect non-member insurance waivers and verify memberships at all baronial events and meetings as well as submit a monthly report. This position is a great way to meet people.



Social Media Officer

Duties include, but are not limited to maintaining the Facebook Groups and Pages for the Barony of SunDragon as outlined by the SCA, Inc. Social Media Policy as published and updated by the Society Seneschal office (<u>http://www.sca.org/docs/pdf/SCASocialMediaPolicy.pdf</u>). You will be responsible for assisting the Kingdom Social Media Officer in monitoring content and updating

events, groups and pages as needed. Experience with Facebook is a must and Google Groups is also preferred.

Social Media Officers must be able to:

- Administer the office in a fair and tempered manner remembering you are the voice of your Office, your Barony, and the Kingdom of Atenveldt (responsible use of social media)
- Use proper etiquette and grammar.
- You must have an ability to access the internet and pages from your phone and computer, both during day and evening hours. While we do not expect you to be online at all times, you should be "connected".



Webminister

The Webminister maintains the Baronial website and ensures the timely uploading of content.

Webministers must meet the membership requirements of the office as outlined in Corpora. If a Webminister's membership lapses during the term of office that officer's warrant is considered terminated immediately upon expiration.

This position is very time consuming and working with additional deputies is strongly encouraged. While there are some technical aspects to this position, it is mostly one of managing processes and administration.

The ideal candidate for this position would be a self-motivated individual with strong management and average

or better technical skills and a general understanding of web technology such as Hosting, DNS, and HTML. None of us is perfect, but there are some minimum requirements:

- Experience with writing or editing content
- Balance and judgment in matters political
- A computer with reliable, fast internet connection available 24 hours a day
- A working telephone
- Regular contact with Kingdom/Baronial activities
- Ability to meet the ongoing requirements of the Webminister position, primarily but not limited to: Regular updates to Baronial website, Timely responses to inquiries and communications from corporate officers and members of the Board of Directors, as well as other Kingdom/Baronial level officers, Submission of entries/reports to the Kingdom Webminister, Maintaining local website on par with Kingdom policy compliance, Other duties and special projects that may be assigned by the Society /Kingdom Webminister

Regalia Officer

The Regalia officer is the keeper of all the things (equipment and shiny objects) that make our events and courts a pleasure to behold. This individual is responsible for maintaining the Regalia, keeping the inventory, and arranging for transport of necessary regalia to events attended by the Baron and Baroness.
