


You can support the Shire of Burning Sands by participating in our silent auction. Bid on as many goods as you desire! Just know that all proceed go toward helping refill the shire coffers.

Have you been purging your closets this New Years? If you have items needing a new home, please consider donating to our auction.



The site is an open field with plenty of room for Heavy and Rapier scenarios with the capability of combat archery and RBG at the marshals' discretion. Don't miss out!



For those interested in thrown weapons, a tournament will be held, along with classes.



Archery Summit is open to all skill levels and is a great opportunity to refine your abilities, try something new, and connect with others who share a passion for the missile arts.



Heavy fighters can complete their authorizations on site, and there will be heavy melee battles, including combat archery.


Rapier fighters will also take to the field in melee scenarios.




It will be our last practice before we show everyone that Atenveldt is stronger when we stand as one!

We have open officer positions available! If you are looking for a way to get more involved in SunDragon, are service-oriented, or want to invest your time into your hobby, consider submitting a Letter of Intent to Their Excellencies to start your journey as an officer of SunDragon. It takes several people to run a Barony well. We need you to make that happen. If you have any questions, please ask a current or past officer. We would be happy to answer any questions you have.

To submit a letter of intent simply email the Baroness & Baron (coronets@baronyofsundragon.org) and BSD Seneschal (seneschal@baronyofsundragon.org) stating that you would like to be considered for the position. Be sure also to include both your SCA and mundane names, membership ID number, a working phone number, and your local address.

ARCHERY LIEUTENANTS

The Archery Lieutenant assists the Archery Captain, who is responsible for running weekly archery practices and tournaments, ensures safety, maintains loaner gear, and files monthly reports.

If you are interested in being a lieutenant you should most certainly speak to the current captain about the role. Being a deputy is a great way to get a taste for what responsibilities the office holds without committing to the office fully or to learn the role while the current officer still occupies the position so you could possibly take over for them in the future.



EMERGENCY DEPUTY EXCQUEUR

If you have held the primary role before but do not want to currently fill the position an Emergency or "drop dead" deputy might be the spot for you.

These positions are in case the current officer needs to step back from their responsibilities due to any reason they may have and allows the barony to have someone step in while we look for someone new to fill the office.



REGALIA OFFICER

The Regalia officer is the keeper of all the things (equipment and shiny objects) that make our events and courts a pleasure to behold.

This individual is responsible for maintaining the Regalia, keeping the inventory, and arranging for transport of necessary regalia to events attended by the Baron and Baroness.



SHERIFF

The Baronial Sheriff has the main following duties:

- Send monthly reports to kingdom sheriff
- Keeper of baronial lost and found
- Run our watch day at War of the Phoenix or our baronial hosted events



DEPUTY YOUTH ACTIVITIES OFFICER

Assist the Youth Activity Coordinator during all official or "published" SCA Youth Activities.

- Must be at or above the age of legal majority in the state, province or country in which the activity occurs.
- Must be unrelated to the warranted baronial youth officer by blood, marriage or personal relationship.
- Provide/obtain valid background check (completed through the kingdom seneschal's office).

Deputy Social Media officer assists the Social Media officer by making social media postings and virtual meetings.



CHRONICLER

The baronial chronicler is the formal messenger for the barony and creates the Chronus Draconum, a quarterly newsletter (or monthly/semi-monthly at the request of the B&B), for the Barony of SunDragon. The "cover story" in the Chronus is the Baronial Missive, a letter from the B&B to Their populace. Collect announcements from the fellow officers and tournament/event coordinators at the baronial populace meetings (each month) and place them in a newsletter format to be shared with the baronial and kingdom populace members. Please also encourage the populace to contribute stories, poems, songs, A&S project progress/recipes, or drawings & photos. Collect "release to use" forms alongside in order to publish and share on their behalf. The chronicler also posts the letters of intent for the candidates running for baroness and baron (etc.) during the polling season. Maintain copies of releases and newsletters on the baronial flash drive & chronicler Google drive.

Important skills: Use an appropriate electronic program (e.g., Microsoft Word) to create the newsletter. Most files (e.g., Microsoft Word .docx, Microsoft Publisher .pub) can easily be converted to PDF for uploading/ sharing purposes. Use of proper grammar and editing skills is a must. Be sure to publish and send the copies to the parties listed below in a timely manner (Quarterly= January, April, July, & October). Administer the office in a fair and tempered manner remembering you are the voice of your Office and when using pages, the voice of Atenveldt. Use appropriate spelling, grammar, and punctuation.

Recognitions and Awards for the Barony of SunDragon




ORDER OF THE PRISMA DRAGONIS OF SUNDRAGON

Given to those who continue to give **years of faithful service** to the barony. This award may be given at any Barony of SunDragon event. This carries the highest precedence of all baronial awards.




COMMANDER OF THE HONOR OF SUNDRAGON

Given to full Companions of the Honor of SunDragon who have demonstrated **high merit** and continued **service and duty** within the Barony of SunDragon.




