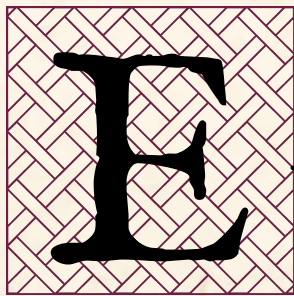

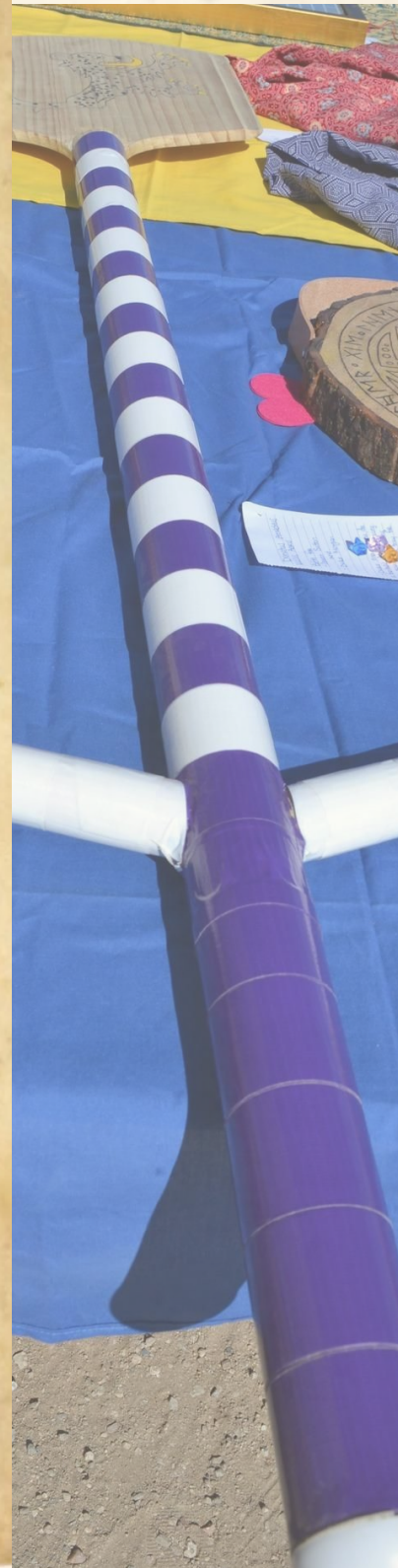

This is a wet site, but no glass is allowed. Feel free to bring shades that do not require staking.

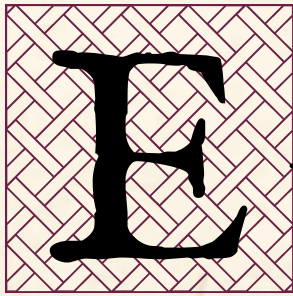

Sustenance will be available at midday in the form of handmade sausage quiche lunchboxes.

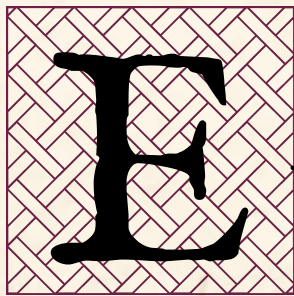
Lunches may be pre-purchased or purchased on the day of the event for \$7, first-come, first-served.

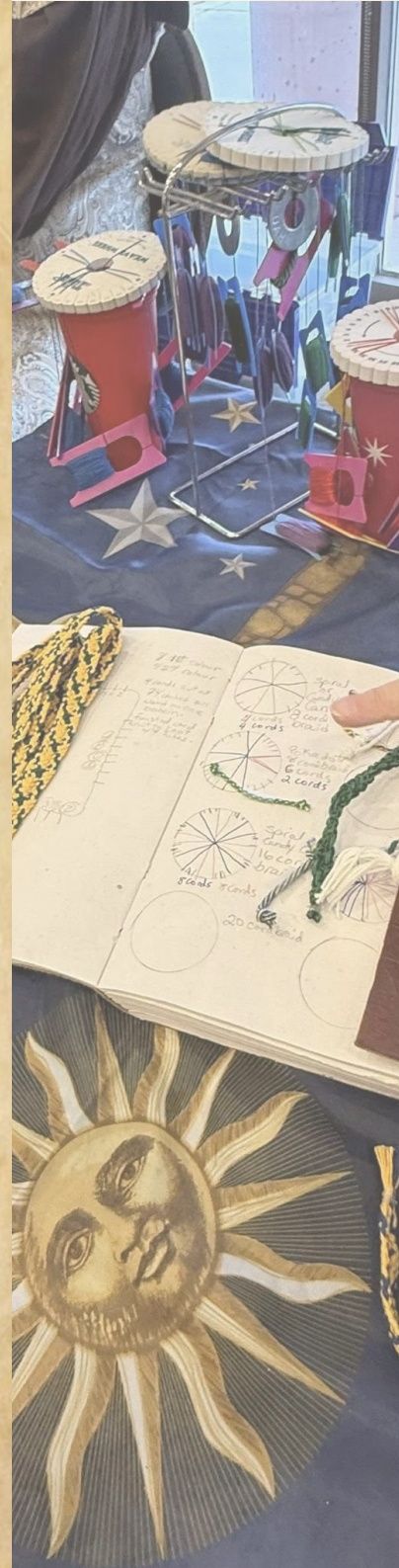
The Kingdom Arts & Sciences office and the Barony of Atenveldt invite you to the Spring 2026 A&S: Meet the Masters!!

Don't forget your Wacky Weapons! We look forward to seeing you there!

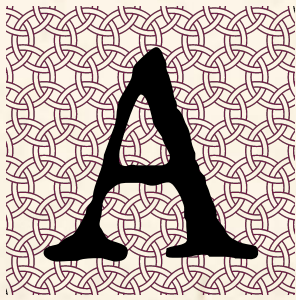
Note:

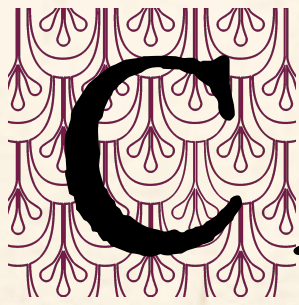

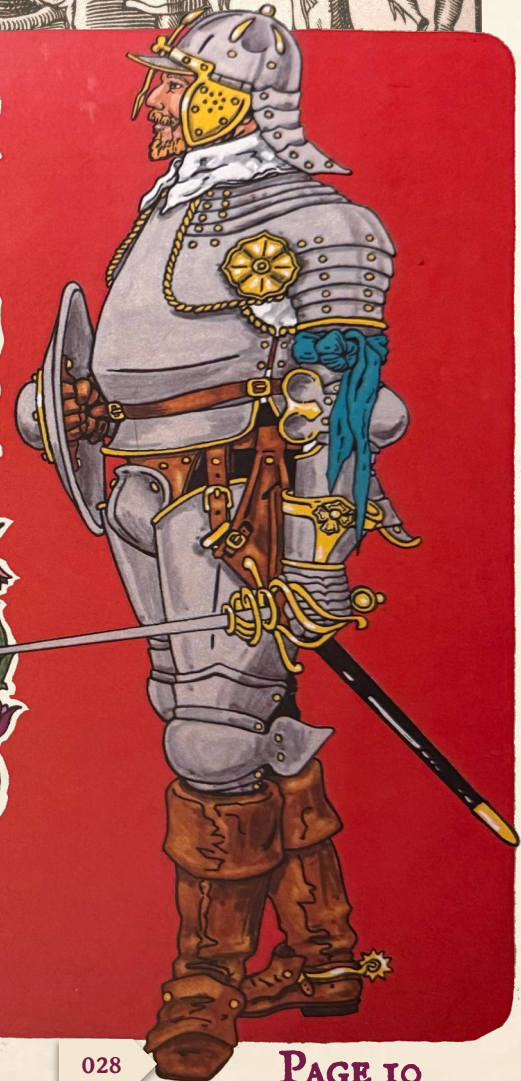
SunDragon only functions due to the service of its populace. The Barony needs your creative and logistical efforts to pave the way for pageantry and celebration in the future.

SOCIAL MEDIA OFFICER

If you have held the primary role before but do not want to currently fill the position an Emergency or "drop dead" deputy might be the spot for you.

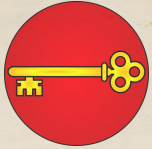
These positions are in case the current officer needs to step back from their responsibilities due to any reason they may have and allows the barony to have someone step in while we look for someone new to fill the office.

REGALIA OFFICER

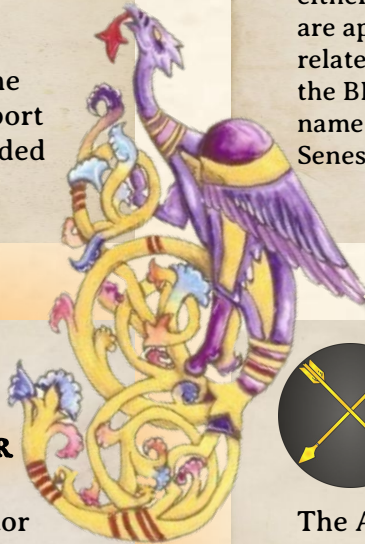
The Regalia officer is the keeper of all the things (equipment and shiny objects) that make our events and courts a pleasure to behold.

This individual is responsible for maintaining the Regalia, keeping the inventory, and arranging for transport of necessary regalia to events attended by the Baron and Baroness.

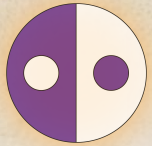


BARONIAL FINANCIAL COMMITTEE MEMBER

DEPUTY YOUTH ACTIVITIES OFFICER

Assist the Youth Activity Coordinator during all official or "published" SCA Youth Activities.

- Must be at or above the age of legal majority in the state, province or country in which the activity occurs.
- Must be unrelated to the warranted baronial youth officer by blood, marriage or personal relationship.
- Provide/obtain valid background check (completed through the kingdom seneschal's office).

ARCHERY LIEUTENANTS

The Archery Lieutenant assists the Archery Captain, who is responsible for running weekly archery practices and tournaments, ensures safety, maintains loaner gear, and files monthly reports.

If you are interested in being a lieutenant you should most certainly speak to the current captain about the role. Being a deputy is a great way to get a taste for what responsibilities the office holds without committing to the office fully or to learn the role while the current officer still occupies the position so you could possibly take over for them in the future.

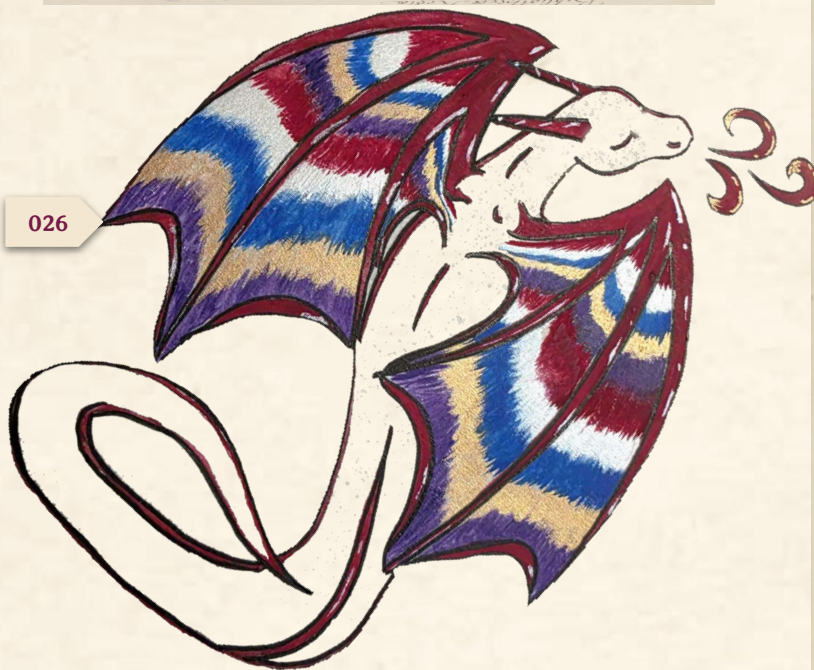

Minister of Arts and Sciences helps with the scheduling of SCA classes, running monthly A&S displays, assisting the populace with finding the Arts and Sciences help that they need, and filing monthly reports.



TRAINING FOR ARTS AND SCIENCES (A&S) MINISTER FOR THE BARONY OF SUNDRAGON By Her Ladyship Aurora Faw

Expectations and Roles

Main Roles:

- Bring classes to the Barony
- Coordinate workshops for the Barony
- Assist the Arts and Sciences Champion with displays or competitions
- Maintain the budget and supplies needed
- Submit numbers to the Seneschal monthly and the A&S Minister Quarterly
- Attend monthly Populace and Officers meetings

Submitting Reports

For the Barony:

At the end of each month, you need to submit the number of attendees at classes or workshops that the Barony sponsored that month to the Seneschal at seneschal@baronyofsundragon.org. You may include the teacher in addition to the students in your headcount.

Example:

For the Kingdom:

There is a form that the Kingdom officer may have you complete quarterly. They will send you a link to the form and then you can complete the form as requested.

Attend Monthly Populace and Officers Meeting

The monthly Populace and Officer's Meeting is typically the first Monday of the Month and usually at the Peoria Community Center, but is also available to participate on-line if you can't make it.

If there is a holiday that day or an event ending, it sometimes gets moved to the following week.

You will be asked to report out on your office.

Talk about the classes from the prior month (if any) and what classes are coming up.

Answer any questions regarding the office.

Classes for the Barony

How to Determine Classes:

Determining classes can depend on many factors. There is no right or wrong answers here.

1. Has someone offered to teach a particular class? If yes, always take them up on it. Find a time and space that works for that person.
2. Has someone in the barony mentioned they'd like to see something in particular? That's a great way to decide to set up a class. Try to find a teacher that teaches it and offer to make a class.
3. Create a Poll. You can go into the Facebook group and create a poll to see what classes people would like to see.
4. See a need, fill a need. If you see we have a bunch of newcomers, maybe offer a simple t-tunic class. If it's hot and summer time, maybe it's time for a hat making class or Greek attire! Maybe someone donated some heavy fabric to the class, you can do a cloak making session.
5. Something you would like to learn. Offer classes on something you find interesting.

How Often:

Wouldn't it be great if we could offer classes every week? However that's not always feasible. So I recommend offer one class a month for the Barony. In months where we are really busy, you can skip offering a class.

Where classes are held:

Often we hold classes at people's houses. Other ideas could be library rooms, community centers, or even at Fighter Practice if the topic allows.

How to Set Up a Class:

1. Decide on a topic.
2. Find a teacher.
3. Determine a space and time to do the class.
4. Ask the teacher for a "write up" about the class.
5. Obtain a photo that pertains to the class topic. You can ask the teacher for a photo of their topic or you can google search a photo. I like to type in "Medieval Manuscript" and then the topic for a photo that can be generically used, but use whatever photo you like.
6. Reach out to the Social Media Officer to ask them to set up an event on Facebook for you. Include, date, times, location, and photo for the event. Submit to them either via FB messenger or email at socialmedia@baronyofsundragon.org.
7. The Social Media officer may make you an admin on the event so you can change or post in the event.

Workshops for the Barony

Workshops are often different from a class in that we don't necessarily have a "teacher." Workshops could include different things that we are trying to accomplish as a barony.

Examples:

- General sewing or arts days
- Making baronial belt favors
- Wall painting
- Shield painting
- Armor repair
- Largess

How to Determine Workshops:

Look at the needs of the barony. Are we coming up to a big War and people need time to prep? Are we low on favors and need more? Did the Barony ask for a specific project to get done? Does the Barony need more largess? Also, if we don't have a class set up for that month, it would be a great month for a sewing day.

How Often:

This is going to depend on what else is going on. A sewing day in January to prep for the War of the Phoenix might be a good idea. In the summer months when it is hot out, might be another good time. But it is also going to be based on needs.

Where Workshops are held:

Often we hold workshops at people's houses. Other ideas could be library rooms, community centers, or even at Fighter Practice if the topic allows.

How to Set Up a Workshop:

1. Decide on what is needed.
2. Determine a space and time to do the workshop.
3. Create a "write up" about the workshop.
4. Obtain a photo that pertains to the workshop. If you have a photo that you want to use or you can google search a photo. I like to type in "Medieval Manuscript" and then the topic for a photo that can be generically used, but use whatever photo you like.
5. Reach out to the Social Media Officer to ask them to set up an event on Facebook for you. Include, date, times, location, and photo for the event. Submit to them either via FB messenger or email at socialmedia@baronyofsundragon.org.
6. The Social Media officer may make you an admin on the event so you can change or post in the event.

Assisting the Arts and Sciences (A&S) Champion

Champions are chosen every October. The A&S Champion is responsible for promoting A&S displays or competitions in the Barony.

They at the very least are supposed to put on the A&S Champions competition the following year. If the A&S Champion is unable to fulfill these duties the A&S Minister is the back up to this person.

How to Determine Displays or Competitions:

The A&S Champion is able to decide what type of display or competition they want to do. The A&S Minister is there to encourage and remind them of the type.

Examples:

- Display only (no winner, no documentation)
- Display with general voting (no documentation needed, but add a note)
- Display with Baroness or Baron's choice (with or without documentation)
- Display with voting separated by Laurel's choice and Populace Choice (with or without documentation)
- Competition with documentation (usually at champions)

Topic:

Again there is no right or wrong answer. If a display is done at an event, it can relate to the event that is going on such as a tournament that is being held. Or it could be "a work in progress," "something where you learned something," "art that you are thankful for," etc.

How Often:

It is recommended no more than once a month. These can be done in conjunction with Baronial tournaments since that is when you will get the best turnout. Also it could be done at Baronial sponsored events such as Solstice, Fabric War, or Border Wars. However, at these events the A&S Champion or Minister should check with the Autocrats as they may have already determined what they want to do for those events.

Where Displays or Competitions are Held

Usually at events or fighter practices, specifically at tournaments or court nights are encouraged.

How to Set Up a Display or Competition:

1. Work with the Champion on what type of display or competition they want to do.
2. Encourage the Champion to post a write up about the display or competition on the Facebook group or in the Facebook event.
3. If there is a winner, ask the champion if they have a prize. Often champions bring their own gift for the winner (if there is one) or largess can be asked for from the Baroness and Baron.
4. Find out if you need to bring tables or request someone to bring tables.
5. Find out if you need to bring A&S table cloths, voting boxes, display assistance, pens, 3x5 cards (all in the A&S box)
6. Ask the A&S Champion if they need anything else.
7. Assist the Champion to set up at the event.

Budget and Supplies

The Arts and Science Minister gets a set budget every year. Currently the budget is set at \$200. The budget can be used to help buy supplies for the office, supplies for the classes, or supplies for workshops. You should plan to buy supplies in advance of classes or workshops.

Budget Amount and Spending:

It is currently set at \$200 a year. You do not have to get permission to spend this money, but you do need to complete a reimbursement form and submit receipts. Keep your personal purchases separate from baronial supplies for the receipts.

Submitting for Reimbursement:

1. Complete the reimbursement form found at <https://drive.google.com/file/d/1GeUPrHvk18nSzj1EE8SU151MFFu-xBwr/view?usp=sharing>.
2. Submit reimbursement form with scanned copies or photos of receipts to the exchequer at exchequer@baronyofsundragon.org and copy the Baroness and Baron at coronets@baronyofsundragon.org
3. Wait for your check.

Setting the Budget:

The Baronial Exchequer will ask in about September or October for budget requests for the following year. Send the Exchequer an email at exchequer@baronyofsundragon.org for what you want the budget to be set at for the following year before December. If you want more budget for some reason, you should explain it in the email so that the Baronial Financial Committee will know prior to voting on it.

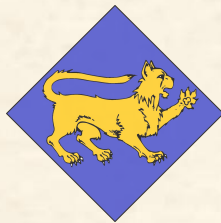
ORDER OF THE PRISMA DRAGONIS OF SUNDRAGON

Given to those who continue to give **years of faithful service** to the barony. This award may be given at any Barony of SunDragon event. This carries the highest precedence of all baronial awards.



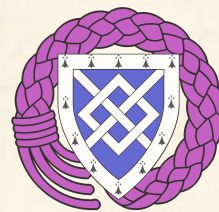

Given to full Companions of the Honor of SunDragon who have demonstrated **high merit** and continued **service and duty** within the Barony of SunDragon.



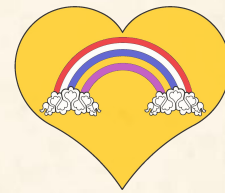
